SUBJECT: Request for NCIS Investigation into Circumstances Surrounding the Detainee Suicides on 9/10 June 2006

1. In a telephone conference call conducted on 21 June 2006, between representatives of JTF-GTMO ((b)(3)-10), USSOUTHCOM ((b)(3)-10 USC), DoD Office of General Counsel ((b)(3)-10), the Acting Navy General Counsel ((b)(3)-1), the Director of NCIS ((b)(3)-10), the Deputy Navy JAG ((b)(3)-10 USC), and representatives of the Department of Justice ((b)(3)-10 USC), NCIS indicated that their suicide investigation was largely complete. They indicated that in keeping with their traditional investigative mandate, they had concluded that the three deaths were suicides as a result of hanging undertaken solely by the victims themselves.

2. ((b)(3)-1) Acting General Counsel of the Navy, and ((b)(3)-10) Director of NCIS, stated that if requested by Commander, JTF-GTMO through Commander, USSOUTHCOM, they are willing for NCIS to investigate whether the suicides were in furtherance of a larger plot or had been encouraged or ordered by other detainees and whether there is any evidence of other suicide plans.

3. Request that NCIS be formally asked to include within their investigation: (1) whether the suicides on 9/10 June were related to a plot by detainees to commit suicide, or were otherwise encouraged, ordered, or assisted by other detainees or third persons; and, (2) whether there exists any evidence of past, ongoing or future plots for detainees to commit suicide.
