(C) On 10Jun06, (b)(6) Internment Serial Number (ISN) (b)(2) who will be referred to as (b)(6) was interviewed by (b)(7)(C), Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF) Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. (b)(3) (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) provided Farsi translation during the interview. The interview was conducted in reference to the recent deaths of three detainees: Yasser Talal AL ZHRANI; (b)(2) 00093DP, Mana Shaman Allsbard AL TABI; (b)(2) 00588DP, and Ali Abdullah AHMED; (b)(2) 00693DP. The interview commenced at approximately 1430, and concluded at about 1440. (b)(6) cell block is identified as being located at Camp Delta, Camp 1, Block (b)(2) (b)(2) 00693DP.

(FOUO/LES) Prior to conducting the interview, agents introduced themselves to (b)(6) and told him of the deaths of the above individuals. (b)(6) stated he did not know why he was here. (b)(6) further stated "nothing happened in my cell" and that he "didn't see anything." Reporting Agents explained to (b)(6) they were trying to find out what happened so this would not happen in the future. (b)(6) replied he really didn't know what happened and that he was in his room. (b)(6) continued by saying that you have to ask the guard what happened. (b)(6) again stated he really doesn't know anything that happened in the cell.

(FOUO/LES) (b)(6) was asked if he got along with the Arabs in his cell block. (b)(6) replied that really doesn't matter. (b)(6) said he would try to help in any way he can. (b)(6) then requested the interview be terminated.

(C//) On 10JUN06 (b)(6) Internment Serial Number (ISN) (b)(2) was interviewed at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The interview was conducted by (b)(7)(C) (b)(7)(C) Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF), Guantanamo Bay Cuba. The interview was conducted in Farsi as translated by, (b)(3) (b)(6) Department of Defense, Contract Linguist.

(FOUO/LES) At approximately 1218, RA and PA entered the interview room and greeted (b)(6) PA asked (b)(6) if he knew why he was being interviewed. (b)(6) stated, "no". PA stated, "you can't even speculate". (b)(6) then stated, "because of what happened last night?". PA asked (b)(6) to describe his day up until the death of the detainee's. (b)(6) stated, "it was like any other day. There wasn't anything going on. We said our prayers; we slept until I awoke to the guards whistle. The guards were calling out number eight. The guards saw someone hanging himself. They took the guy to the hospital so basically I went back to sleep. Sometime pasted and we heard him calling number twelve.

(FOUO/LES) PA inquired about the singing that took place on the cell block. (b)(6) stated, "every Friday night we sing". (b)(6) explained the guards then went to cell number five and called for the detainee to show himself. (b)(6) claimed cell number five was close to his cell. PA asked (b)(6) how the detainee hanged themselves. (b)(6) stated "I don't know how he hanged himself". RA asked (b)(6) why the detainee's killed themselves (b)(6) explained he was not sure as to the cause of the suicide. (b)(6) then stated, "I think it is because some people have been here for over five years or it could be the interaction between the detainee's and the guards. (b)(6) described how the guards would disrespect the Koran. (b)(6) continued to describe how the guards would disrespect the Koran at the camps. RA asked (b)(6) what his country would do if they caught an American on terrorism charges. (b)(6) explained he did not know because it has been a long time since he has been back home. RA state, "I think we can all agree they would kill me correct?" (b)(6) stated, "maybe you should go there and find out".

(C//) PA asked (b)(6) who was assigned to cell block eight. (b)(6) stated, "he was an Arab guy". PA further asked (b)(6) who was in cell number five and twelve. (b)(6) explained both were Arabs but he did not know them. "they don't talk to me". PA inquired if any other Farsi speakers were on his block. (b)(6) explained one other Farsi speaker was on his block but this individual does not talk to (b)(6) explained the deceased detainee's were normal guys and had nothing out of the ordinary.

(FOUO/LES) PA explained to (b)(6) that he had a responsibility to his brothers to do something to prevent these suicides. (b)(6) became agitated and said "what do you want me to do behind bars?". (b)(6) became more agitated and explained how the guards lied to him and told him the detainee's were fine and they are going to the hospital. PA again reiterated (b)(6) had a responsibility to do something about the suicides. (b)(6) stated, "go away, go away, I have no information about them. If you don't want something to happen then you shouldn't oppress us. Those three people were not trouble makers or instigators. (b)(6) explained how the three deaths were not good for the United States image. At approximately 1314 both PA and RA thanked (b)(6) for his cooperation and left the interview room.

(FOUO//LES) On 10 Jun 06, (b)(6) Internment Serial Number (ISN) (b)(2) was interviewed by (b)(7)(C) Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF), Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The interview was conducted in Arabic with translation provided by (b)(3) (b)(6) (b)(7)(C). The interview began at 1320 and lasted thirty minutes.

(C) BACKGROUND: In the early morning hours of 10 Jun 06, Joint Task Force Guards assigned to Alpha Block, Camp Delta, located three detainees hanging by the neck in their assigned cells. The three detainees were identified as: YASSER TALAL AL ZAHRANI, ISN (b)(2) 000093DP; MANA SHAMAN ALLABARD AL TABI, ISN (b)(2) 000588DP; and ALI ABDULLAH AHMED, ISN (b)(2) 000693DP.

(FOUO//LES) The purpose of the meeting was to determine the extent of (b)(6) knowledge regarding three detainee deaths on his cell block. (b)(6) reported he was in satisfactory physical and mental condition. (b)(6) expressed extreme displeasure for having his afternoon prayer disrupted. (b)(6) movement to the interview room conflicted with the afternoon prayer.

(FOUO//LES) (b)(6) is housed at the opposite end of the tier away from ISN's 93, 588, and 693. (b)(6) was not a close associate and had no personal relationship with the victims. (b)(6) provided minimal information during the discussion, offering limited responses.

(FOUO//LES) (b)(6) stated he was sleeping soundly when he was awakened by the sounds of yelling and shouting. He awoke and saw several guards running on the tier. After a minute all was silent. The silence was broken by additional guards entering the tier. (b)(6) does not speak English and was unaware of what the guards were saying.

(FOUO//LES) A female guard was posted outside his cell and watched him for the remainder of the night. (b)(6) was unaware any deaths occurred until he was informed by (b)(7)(C). (b)(6) appeared indifferent about the incident and made no inquiry of the victims' status. (b)(6) denied possessing any prior knowledge of the incident. (b)(6) affirmed he would try and stop any detainee from harming themselves.

(FOUO//LES) (b)(6) provided no additional substantial information. (b)(6) used the remainder of his time as a forum to complain about the general living conditions in Camp Delta.

(S) On 10 Jun 06, (b)(6)

(b)(6) (b)(2) was interviewed by (b)(7)(C) (b)(7)(C) ITF. Contract linguist (b)(3) (b)(6) provided Arabic translation. (b)(7)(C)

(C) BACKGROUND: In the early morning of 10 Jun 06, military guards on Alpha block, Camp Delta, discovered three detainees hanging by the neck in their cells. The detainees were identified as Yasser Tala AL ZAHRANI, (b)(2) -000093DP (ISN 93), cell A8; Mana Shaman Allabard AL TABI, (b)(2) -000588DP (ISN 588), cell A12; and Ali Abdullah AHMED, (b)(2) 693DP (ISN 693), cell A5. (b)(6) occupied (b)(2) and was interviewed as a witness to the events.

(S) (b)(6) stated he was in good health and asked if he could smoke. (b)(7)(C) replied she did not have any cigarettes at this time but would try to make the interview brief. (b)(7)(C) asked (b)(6) if he was willing to answer questions about the night's events. (b)(6) agreed and relayed the following: On Friday, 9 Jun 06, he went to sleep between 2000 and 2030. He woke up around 0030, the morning of Saturday, 10 Jun 06 to hear the Military Police (MP) yelling "Number 12? Number 12?" ISN 128 saw the MPs were looking into the cell (A12). There was a blanket hanging down in the cell. They took a look from the other sides of the cell and couldn't see anything. They went to the back of the cell and must have seen something because they told the other MPs to open the cell door. The MPs opened the cell door and brought out ISN 588. (b)(6) heard the MPs say, "He's dead, he's dead."

(S) (b)(6) also heard the MPs talking about ISN 93 (cell A5) and the MPs said he had died. The MPs went to another cell room which he did not know and they said the detainee in that cell had died. After all the commotion, the MPs came to the detainees and told them to take down everything, all the hangings from the walls. (b)(6) stayed up until about 0300 when he was transferred to (b)(2)

(FOUO/LES) (b)(6) did not hear any unusual chatter or talking before going to bed between 2000 and 2030. Friday night, the group prayed and chanted together, including ISN 588 and ISN 93. (b)(6) combined his sunset and evening prayers and then, feeling tired, he went to sleep. He did not hear any noise to suggest any detainees were moving items around their rooms such as blankets or sheets. He awoke sometime around 0030 and 0045 to "sounds of trouble." (b)(6) originally thought there was some problem between the detainee and the guards and expected riot violence.

(S) (b)(6) said he did not notice anything unusual during the week about ISN 588 and ISN 93. He did not know if the three detainees interacted with one another because their cell rooms were far away from each other. (b)(6) said there was nothing different about the detainees and that everything seemed normal. (b)(6) mentioned that ISN 588 had previously spent time in solitary and upon his return to Alpha block, he was sad although he said nothing was wrong. ISN 588 discussed some of the procedures at (b)(2). He spoke of a line on the ground where detainees had to line up for food. If a detainee crossed the line, the food would be placed down and the IRF team would be called. (b)(6) said he heard of humiliation and cursing and sleep deprivation occurring in (b)(2)

(FOUO/LES) When asked if (b)(6) had heard about this event possibly taking place, he replied "By God, I didn't

hear. (b)(6) was then asked if this event could have been ordered. (b)(6) said he believed "It was the General and the person under him, the guy with the bird." (Agent's note: The "guy with the bird" is probably referring to a Colonel.) (b)(6) believes they, in an indirect way, caused this to happen because of the pressure placed on everyone due to the humiliation of their religion, humiliating the Koran, the inspection of certain areas of the body, the shaving of beards, and the condition of their brothers in solitary and (b)(2). (b)(6) said he was surprised that this event occurred and that it was "truly something strange." He also said he did not believe the detainees would have done such a thing if not for the oppression. (b)(6) said, "They're dead, it's over, case closed."

(FOUO/LES) When asked if similar events may happen in the future, (b)(6) said, "By God, I hadn't heard about such a thing." (b)(7)(C) asked what (b)(6) would do if he heard that events would take place. (b)(6) originally said he would do nothing for them, that he would sleep and not interfere because "it's you who put us like this." (b)(6) then said, in reality, if he saw a brother of his set to hang himself, he would help. (b)(6) said you must think about the reasons why this happened. He said the reasons are well known by the commander and there was no need to send interrogators. (b)(7)(C) responded that the agents present were not interrogators. (b)(6) asked if the agents were FBI or CIA. (b)(7)(C) responded that she and SA Nelson were members of CITF. (b)(6) asked if the agents were investigating the entire camp and (b)(7)(C) replied that for this incident, the agents were instructed to interview the detainees on Alpha block.

(FOUO/LES) (b)(6) asked about the procedures for the bodies of the three detainees. He said according to their religion, there are special ways the bodies need to be washed, prayed upon and how the shrines and grave must be. He said the detainees would want to perform these actions. (b)(7)(C) said the agents were not in charge of this but the people who are in charge were probably aware of the procedures and she would pass along (b)(6) concerns.

(FOUO/LES) (b)(6) asked why the events were being investigated since the detainees were already dead. (b)(7)(C) said it was important to find out what happened to try and make sure no-one is harmed again. (b)(6) asked what would be done with all the information he provided and (b)(7)(C) informed him the information would be passed to superiors about what (b)(6) provided and what his thoughts were. (b)(6) said that even if everyone was interviewed, it all would come down to their religion and that everyone has a right to defend their religion.

(FOUO/LES) (b)(6) said the MPs were preventing the detainees from talking on 10 Jun 06. He did know of two or three brothers who came back and said the detainees were dead and there would be interviews all day. (b)(6) asked (b)(7)(C) if the bodies of the detainees would be buried in Cuba or returned to their homeland. (b)(7)(C) said she did not know but again would pass along his concerns. (b)(6) requested to speak with his regular interrogator (b)(3) with (b)(2). (b)(7)(C) said she would pass along his request. (b)(6)

(FOUO/LES) (Agent's Note: After (b)(7)(C) passed along (b)(6) concerns to the MPs, she returned to the interview room with contract linguist (b)(2). (b)(7)(C) informed (b)(6) that, per the MPs, he would have to contact his block NCO to request to speak with (b)(3). (b)(6) said "very good").

INVESTIGATIVE ACTION: Preliminary Examination of ISN 588's Body

(E) At approximately 0315, 10Jun06, a preliminary examination of Mana Shaman Allabard AL TABI's body was conducted by (b)(7)(C) Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF), Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. AL TABI who is Internment Serial Number (ISN) (b)(2) 00588DP, will be referred to as ISN 588. This examination was conducted at the Camp Delta Medical Clinic, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The purpose of this examination was to recover evidence and to provide photographic coverage of the body. ISN 588's body was found hanging in his cell block at Camp Delta, Camp #1, A12.

(FOUO/LES) ISN 588's body was lying on an orange spinal board which was situated on an examination table. ISN 588's body was covered with a blue sheet. ISN 588 was dressed in a Joint Task Force (JTF) issued beige two piece outfit consisting of pants and shirt. ISN 588's hands were unbound and his arms were resting by his side. There was biological substance noted on ISN 588's beard and right thumb. The IV fluid bag, 0.9 Sodium Solution Chloride was laying on ISN 588's chest. A further examination noted three separate strips of white cloth, believed to have possibly been made from bed linen. These strips consisted of smaller pieces of white cloth (again possibly bed linen), which were tied together. These pieces of cloth were located between ISN 588's legs just below the groin area. The (b)(2),(b)(7)(E) upon initial examination; however, (b)(2),(b)(7)(E)

(FOUO/LES) An examination of the head/neck area noted bruising in the neck area. These bruises are consistent with ligature marks as ISN 588 was found hanging in his cell by JTF Camp Personnel. These suspected ligature marks extend from ISN 588's left ear area to his right ear area. These suspected ligature marks were documented via photographs.

(FOUO/LES) At approximately 0405, a piece of white 8 1/2 X 11 paper, folded in quarters was discovered on the left inside shirt pocket. This piece of paper was removed and protected for possible latent print identification. This paper was opened and revealed Arabic writing. The paper was seized as evidence and photographed. A copy of this paper is appended as enclosure (a). (b)(3) (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) Spiritual Advisor, JTF, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba was at the Camp Delta Medical Clinic and provided the following Arabic interpretation of the letter. The note reads, "I left out of the cage despite of you. You are going to punish me for this? Put me in (b)(2) forever."

(U) The following evidence was seized and entered into the NCISRA Guantanamo Bay, Cuba Evidence Custody System under log #010-06.

RA asked (b)(6) what his country would do if they caught an American on terrorism charges. (b)(6) explained he did not know because i has been a long time since he has been back home. RA state, "I think we can all agree they would kill me correct?" (b)(6) stated, "maybe you should go there and find out".

(C/A) PA asked (b)(6) who was assigned to cell block eight. (b)(6) stated, "he was an Arab guy". PA further asked (b)(6) who was in cell number five and twelve. (b)(6) explained both were Arabs but he did not know them. "they don't talk to me". PA inquired if any other Farsi speakers were on his block (b)(6) explained one other Farsi speaker was on his block but this individual does not talk to (b)(6) (b)(6) explained the deceased detainee's were normal guys and had nothing out of the ordinary.

(FOUO/LES) PA explained to (b)(6) that he had a responsibility to his brothers to do something to prevent these suicides. (b)(6) became agitated and said "what do you want me to do behind bars?". (b)(6) became more agitated and explained how the guards lied to him and told him the detainee's were fine and they are going to the hospital. PA again reiterated (b)(6) had a responsibility to do something about the suicides. (b)(6) stated, "go away, go away, I have no information about them. If you don't want something to happen then you shouldn't oppress us. Those three people were not trouble makers or instigators. (b)(6) explained how the three deaths were not good for the United States image. At approximately 1314 both PA and RA thanked (b)(6) for his cooperation and left the interview room.

Witness Interview of: (UNK) (b)(3) (b)(6) (b)(7)(C)

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(FOUO/LES) (b)(3) (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) Hospital Corpsman, Joint Task Force, Guantanamo Bay (GTMO), Cuba was interviewed by (b)(6) (b)(7)(C) Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF-GTMO), and provided the following information:

(FOUO/LES) At approximately 0043, 10 Jun 06, a radio call was received from an unnamed person that a detainee was coming in without a pulse and that he was coming from Alpha block in Camp 1. He was unaware who the detainee was, but when he arrived, was told to start an IV. While doing this, he was told that two more detainees were coming in and to get the spine board. The second detainee apparently arrived, but he did not see him and then the third body arrived and he went into the examination room (Room 10) and attempted to find a pulse and vital signs. Because he could not find a pulse or vital signs, an unidentified nurse from the detainee hospital told him to perform CPR. He performed chest compressions and an unidentified guard performed rescue breathing and the nurse started an IV. Still no pulse or vital signs could be detected so oxygen was given to the detainee. The nurse took over the chest compressions and he did the rescue breathing. An AED (defibrillator) was connected to the detainee but the read out indicated no shockable rhythm existed. Chest compressions and breathing efforts were continued until the Doctor arrived about five to 10 minutes later. Attempts were made to input a tube down the detainee's throat. (b)(2)

(b)(2) The unidentified Doctor An attempt was again made to insert the tube, but with no success. A nasal airway tube was then inserted and all efforts including chest compressions and CPR were performed for about 20 minutes at which time the AED was again used with the same readout that indicated no shockable rhythm. The Doctor made the determination at about 0116 to terminate efforts and then left the examination room

(FOUO/LES) (b)(3) could not be sure but thought the detainee he was working on had something around or on his chest like a sheet or something similar. He suspected from the time the first detainee came into the clinic, followed by the other two, was about 30 minutes. He had no information about the other two detainees.

(FOUO/LES) In conclusion (b)(3) provided the following information about him and stated he is on a six month TDY to GTMO arriving in Mar 06 and leaving about 11 Sep 06. He is assigned to the Naval Hospital, Pensacola, FL and is presently living in K-7, Camp America. He can be reached on a home telephone number of (b)(2) or his office telephone number is (b)(2)
