EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report is presented by the Department of Defense (DoD) in accordance with title 10 of the United States Code, section 2249c (10 U.S.C. 2249c). The Regional Defense Combating Terrorism Fellowship Program (CTFP) was established to meet an emerging and urgent defense requirement to build partnerships in the struggle against violent extremism through targeted, non-lethal, combating terrorism (CbT) education and training. The CTFP directly supports the DoD's efforts by providing CbT education and training for mid- to senior-level international military officers, ministry of defense civilians, and security officials.

The CTFP's goals are:

- Develop and strengthen human and intellectual capital that understands the ideologies and mechanisms of terrorism and the ways and means of countering them;
- Build the CbT capabilities and capacities of partner nations;
- Build and strengthen a global network of CbT experts and practitioners committed to participation in support of U.S. efforts against terrorists and terrorist organizations;
- Counter ideological support for terrorism and violent extremism;
- Harmonize views about the threat of terrorism and its evolution; and
- Develop CbT and Counter Insurgency (COIN) mutual understandings.

CTFP programs are designed to address key CbT challenges globally, regionally, and in specific countries through a tailored program of educational and training activities. The CTFP provides a unique and flexible tool that can focus efforts toward building partner capacity to meet a specific Combatant Command objective.

The Assistant Secretary of Defense for Special Operations/Low Intensity Conflict (SO/LIC) provides policy oversight. The Defense Security Cooperation Agency (DSCA) provides program and financial management. The CTFP requires approval from the appropriate U.S. Embassy Chief of Mission and human rights vetting (in accordance with the Leahy Amendment) prior to any event or engagement.

As detailed in the remainder of this report and the table below, the CTFP sponsored multiple CbT educational events in fiscal year 2013 (FY 2013). These events involved approximately 3,098 security personnel from 131 countries, all with the goal of meeting the needs identified by the regional combatant commanders.

This report accounts for the expenditure of appropriated funds during FY 2013 for the CTFP, including the countries that received CTFP funding, the total amount of funding provided for each country, and the educational courses attended by the foreign officers and officials. The report also includes an assessment of the effectiveness of the program and a review of efforts to improve it.

The contents of this report are unclassified and reflect data gathered from multiple sources, including security assistance officers, Combatant Commands, and other DoD entities.

I. CTFP CONTRIBUTIONS

A. OVERVIEW

Created in 2002, the Combating Terrorism Fellowship Program (CTFP) was established to meet Department of Defense (DoD) requirements to build partnerships in the struggle against violent extremism through targeted, non-lethal, combating terrorism (CbT) education and training. The CTFP directly supports DoD efforts by providing CbT education and training for mid- to senior-level international military officers, ministry of defense civilians, and security officials. The CTFP provides unique relationship and capacity-building opportunities that enable partner countries to address threats of terrorism within their borders and regions and strengthens collaboration with and support for U.S. and partner efforts to defeat terrorism.

The CTFP's goals are to:

- Develop and strengthen human and intellectual capital that understands the ideologies and mechanisms of terrorism and the ways and means of countering them;
- Build the CbT capabilities and capacities of partner nations;
- Build and strengthen a global network of CbT experts and practitioners committed to participation in support of U.S. efforts against terrorists and terrorist organizations;
- Counter ideological support for terrorism and violent extremism;
- Harmonize views about the threat of terrorism and its evolution; and
- Develop CbT and Counter Insurgency (COIN) mutual understandings.

CTFP programs are designed to address key CbT challenges globally, regionally, and in specific countries through tailored education programs. The CTFP is a flexible tool that can focus efforts toward building partner capacity to meet a specific Combatant Command objective.

The CTFP works hand-in-hand with the Combatant Commands to identify candidates for programs and to develop CbT programs specifically tailored to partner nations and their regional and global relationships. Combatant Commands recommend participants to the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) for approval. Potential candidates include senior and mid-level military officials, ministry of defense civilians, and other foreign government security officials who could have an impact on their country's ability and willingness to cooperate with the United States in the struggle against violent extremism. The CTFP funds these participants to attend DoD programs in the United States and abroad. All candidates are verified and vetted for human rights abuses as required by annual DoD appropriations acts (in a provision also referred to as the Leahy Amendment).

The CTFP builds interagency cooperation among partners by training a broad range of foreign CbT military officers and government security officials, and provides specialized programs to address individual country needs. CTFP programs engage military, national police, gendarmerie, internal security, border security, and other security officials. The program enables DoD to implement the President's National Strategy for CbT more effectively by providing resources that can be targeted toward integrating instruments of national power, traditionally expressed as diplomatic, economic, informational, and military. In addition, the

CTFP seeks to integrate military instruments with other security-sector elements, such as financial, intelligence, and law enforcement.

In FY 2013 3,117 foreign military, and security officials attended CTFP-funded programs throughout the six regional Combatant Commands. This included CbT education and training support to emerging regional and sub-regional organizations and alliances. Regional training events are particularly effective in developing personal and professional relationships among security officials from many countries within a given geographic area, and are extremely cost effective. Additionally, the CTFP provides a series of globally oriented courses that enhance mutual understanding, and facilitates cooperation across the globe.

Regional and global events are crucial in building a robust network of CbT officials who share a common understanding of CbT issues, and are able to reach out to other organizations and countries to coordinate effectively. However, in helping to build this network, the CTFP recognizes that 10 U.S.C. 2249c restricts payment of costs only to those associated with the education and training of individuals who are currently foreign military officers, ministry of defense officials, and security officials. Therefore, all foreign participants in CTFP events are screened to ensure their current eligibility under the law. In most classrooms, U.S. personnel are learning alongside CTFP-funded participants, developing and reinforcing relationships between partner countries and the United States. Only an empowered network of CbT practitioners will defeat the networks of our adversaries. The CTFP catalyzes networks and actively sustains and facilitates these connections through continuing education and training activities that reinforce relationships. The network, as it grows, will become increasingly self-reinforcing and less reliant on the United States for support.

B. REPORT REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to 10 U.S.C. 2249c, “not later than December 1 of each year, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to Congress a report on the administration of this section during the fiscal year ended in such year.”

This report is submitted by DoD in accordance with 10 U.S.C. 2249c and provides:

- A complete accounting of the expenditure of appropriated funds for authorized purposes, including:
 - The countries of the foreign officers and officials for whom costs were paid; and
 - For each such country, the total amount of the costs paid.
- The training courses attended by the foreign officers and officials, including a specification of which, if any, courses were conducted in foreign countries.
- An assessment of the effectiveness of the CTFP in increasing the cooperation of the governments of foreign countries with the United States National Counterterrorism Strategy.
- A discussion of any actions being taken to improve the program.

C. PROGRAM ASSESSMENT

Since CTFP's creation in 2002, graduates of the program have continued to advance professionally, and in many cases have entered into senior-level positions in their respective countries. The CTFP works with eleven institutions to provide resident courses of various lengths and CbT focus. The five Regional Centers under DSCA are: the Near East South Asia Center for Strategic Studies (NESA), the William Perry Center for Hemispheric Defense Studies (CHDS), the Asia-Pacific Center for Security Studies (APCSS), the Africa Center for Strategic Studies (ACSS), and the George C. Marshall European Center for Security Studies (GCMC). The Defense Institute for International Legal Studies (DIILS) is an academic institution also under DSCA. The remaining five are the following academic institutions: The Defense Intelligence Agency/National Defense Intelligence University (DIA/NIU), the Naval Post Graduate School/Defense Analysis Department (NPS/DA), the National Defense University/College of International Security Affairs (NDU/CISA), the Joint Special Operations University (JSOU), and the Center for Civil Military Relations (CCMR).



D. KEY PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In FY 2013, the CTFP continued to build individual and institutional capacity in key countries to combat terrorism. Highlighted below are a few of the major accomplishments:

- **U.S. Africa Command (USAFRICOM):** The CTFP was very active in the USAFRICOM Area of Responsibility (AOR) in FY 2013. South Sudan sent its first officer to the Homeland Defense Course conducted at NDU. The attendance of a South Sudanese officer illustrates the significant leadership development occurring within African's newest country in a very short amount of time. It also signifies the impact long-term engagement has in places such as South Sudan.

Though programs offered by the CTFP, the program manager at DSCA established relationships within the territorial government in the southern part of Sudan prior to the

vote for independence. Through these relationships, security officials from South Sudan have been able to attend courses that address strategic issues such as border security and countering insurgency that confront this fledgling African nation.

- **U.S. Central Command (USCENTCOM):** USCENTCOM CTFP events for FY 2013 covered a range of activities that included individual training conducted at a variety of training sites in the United States, attendance at seminars and conferences hosted by the regional centers (GCMC, CCMR, NESA, and APCSS), and Mobile Education Teams working in the USCENTCOM AOR. Students from the USCENTCOM AOR provided a significant number of students for the pilot course for Countering Violent Extremism (CVE) conducted by JSOU.

In the Levant sub-region, Egypt, Lebanon, and Jordan continued their strong participation in the program, focusing on intelligence, special operations, and seminars hosted by the GCMC. In addition to sending 36 students to CTFP-funded training, Lebanon hosted a Combating Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) seminar conducted by CCMR in Beirut for 41 participants from the Ministry of Defense and other relevant ministries. Jordan sent a total of 40 students to various CTFP events, including regional center programs, intelligence training at the Defense Intelligence Agency, and special operations and WMD seminars conducted by the JSOU and the GCMC.

Pakistan, a vital partner in our efforts to counter violent extremists, sent more than 40 students to CTFP events. Activities included tactical and strategic intelligence programs, combating WMD, and basic and advanced special operations courses taught by JSOU.

Yemen's FY 2013 CTFP focused on improving their intelligence analysis and dissemination, stream lining its new special-operations organization, and improving civilian control of the military.

- **U.S. European Command (USEUCOM):** The CTFP sponsored 597 security professionals from the European theater in FY 2013. Nine students earned master's degrees and two students attended the Homeland Defense Short Course at NDU.

Bosnia hosted two regional events in FY 2013. In March, JSOU conducted a mobile program training whole-of-government responses to emerging threats. In September, DIILS conducted its Legal Aspects of Combating Terrorism course.

- **U.S. Pacific Command (USPACOM):** The largest single program of FY 2013 was held in the USPACOM AOR. The CTFP, working with ASD SO/LIC, and the Government of Indonesia co-sponsored the first annual Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Counter Terrorism Forum. Eighteen ASEAN Plus nations, including Myanmar, China, and Russia, attended the four and one-half day program, which consisted of simultaneous strategic and operational-level presentations, with corresponding table-top exercises. The focus of this event was to encourage international cooperation in dealing with regional terrorism threats. The participating nations identified the following focus areas for international collaboration: unity of effort, improved understanding of the threat environment, and enhanced strategic

communications and public affairs. Participants also identified potential follow-on programs for FY 2014 as important future work.

USPACOM sent 653 students to attend various CTFP-sponsored educational programs, with 11 earning master's degrees, and three attending the Homeland Defense Short Course.

Also of note, JSOU and APCSS co-hosted the September Pacific Area Security Sector Working Group in Hawaii. This event brought together ten Pacific Rim countries to discuss crisis action planning and responses to non-traditional security threats.

- **U.S. Southern Command (USSOUTHCOM):** 974 security professionals attended CTFP-sponsored programs from USSOUTHCOM in FY 2013. Of these, 10 earned master's degrees and one attended the Homeland Defense Short Course. Additionally, DIILS conducted its Law of Armed Conflict training for 17 security officials deploying to Afghanistan. JSOU also held a Countering Violent Extremism Seminar in Colombia. Fourteen countries took part in this program designed to strengthen cooperation among regional allies in the Western Hemisphere.
- **U.S. Northern Command (USNORTHCOM):** USNORTHCOM sent 84 students to various CTFP-sponsored events in FY 2013, two of which earned master's degrees from the CISA. Additionally, JSOU, in conjunction with the Office of Defense Cooperation, conducted an operational planning course for 29 Mexican officers. The course taught critical thinking skills necessary to overcome irregular threats.

E. CONTINUING ENGAGEMENT STRATEGY

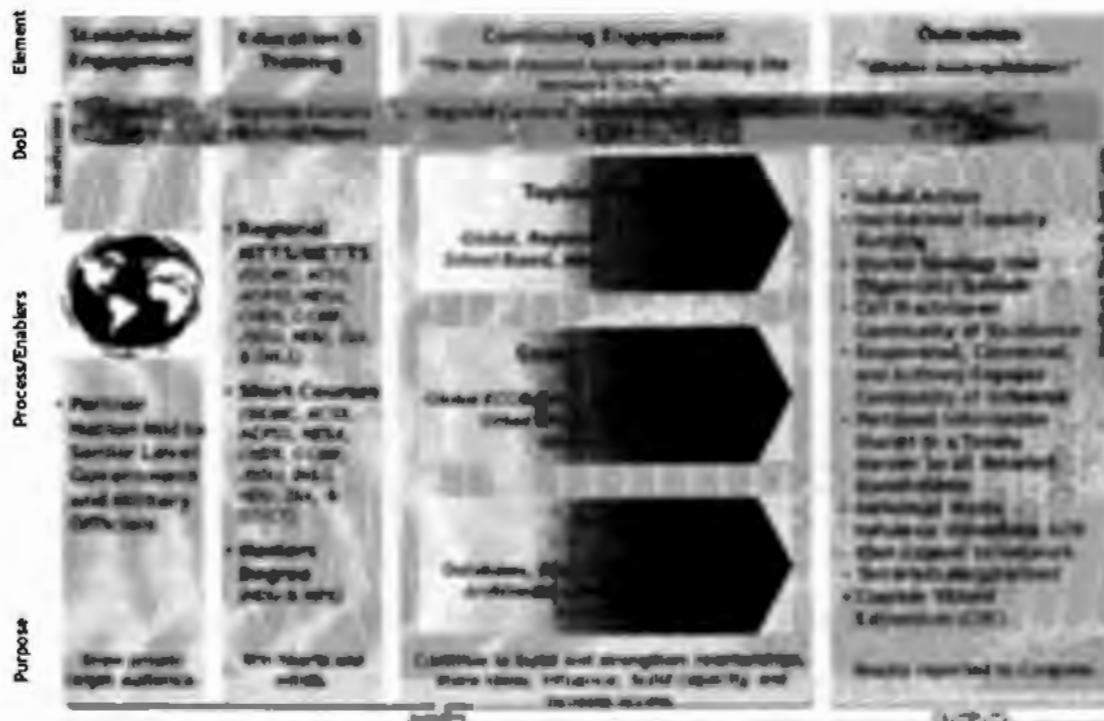
In FY 2013, the CTFP continued efforts to expand individual and institutional capacity-building programs to develop a networked, global CbT capacity. Since its establishment in 2002, the CTFP has educated more than 25,000 people (see Exhibit A below). As explained in previous annual reports, "phase one" of the program focused on building a comprehensive strategic-level CbT education curriculum. This was accomplished through a combination of short, certificate programs at specialized DoD academic institutions and full-scale masters degree programs at NDU and NPS. Each of these courses and/or degrees was designed to address relevant and emerging CbT issues proactively. Starting in FY 2008, NDU and NPS had the opportunity to reengage alumni through short symposiums, which set the tone for a formalized CTFP continuing engagement strategy.

Building on the success of phase one, the department has been able to develop a continuing engagement strategy that provides resources to enable partner institutions to maintain and grow their educational relationships with past participants. This “phase two” of the CTFP allows DoD to realize the value of its investment more fully. The graphic below (Exhibit B) outlines how the Continuing Engagement strategy builds on the first nine years of the program. Continuing Engagement has three main facets: events, communication, and tools. Each of these lines of effort is aimed at accomplishing the program intent of creating a global network of CbT practitioners working together to counter violent extremism.

As a result of the Continuing Engagement program's success, many U.S. Government departments and agencies have begun to request access to the network, including: U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA), Department of State (DOS), U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC), and DIA. Additionally, the reputation of CTFP symposiums has become so strong that beginning in FY 2011 some countries requested out-of-sector invitations and funded participation themselves. As indicated in Exhibit C below, Continuing Engagement events, expenditures, and participation have grown significantly since 2008.

The following sections provide a summary of the events and past participant accomplishments.

F. Global Engagement

The CTFP works with the five Regional Centers (NESA, CHDS, APCSS, ACSS, and GCMC), as well as six academic institutions (NPS/DA, DIA/NIU, NDU/CISA, JSOU, CCMR, and DIILS) to hold resident CbT courses. The academic institutions, by curriculum design and mission, educate students from all regions of the world (as opposed to the more limited focus of the Regional Centers). Each institution's program is unique based on its expertise and area of focus (e.g., special operations, intelligence, civil military relations, and legal). This global classroom design provides the mechanism to cultivate global network activities. In FY 2013, most of the Continuing Engagement funding was allotted to global or multi-regional initiatives, which are summarized below.

Global Conference on Crime and Terrorism partnered with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) (Bangkok, Thailand)

USPACOM, the Joint Interagency Task Force-West (JIATF-W), and FBI representatives organized the training curriculum for "Challenging Global Terrorism: An Asian Perspective on International Counter Terrorism Investigations, Terrorism Financing, and the Emerging Threat of Cyber Crime and Money Laundering." The objective of the course was to provide participants from more than 24 countries with knowledge and skills grounded in theory and practice relevant to the ever-changing challenges in the Asia-Pacific region. This continued support enables the whole of U.S. Government to extend capacity building to our partner

nations, as well as create and sustain valuable working relationships to work collaboratively on combating terrorism challenges with military and law enforcement officials throughout the Asia region.

The five-day event brought together security professionals and law enforcement leaders from various ministries of all governments of the Asia-Pacific region (from India to Oceania) for three common goals:

- 1) Identify emerging trends and forces that impact global security;
- 2) Advance cooperation and collaboration among security departments (i.e., DoD) and law enforcement agencies in addressing security challenges associated with counter threat financing; and
- 3) Affirm leaders' commitment towards a shared advocacy for peace and security in the Asia-Pacific region and across the globe to combat transnational threats and their support networks.

NIU and USPACOM co-host International Intelligence Fellows Program

For the past two years, the CTFP partnered with the NIU and USPACOM to fund the USPACOM International Intelligence Fellows Program (IIFP). The theme of the 2013 USPACOM IIFP was "Intelligence Support to Maritime Security." NIU conducted this two-week program to provide an academic examination of maritime security issues and create a network of Asia-Pacific maritime security intelligence professionals. Students from 18 nations identified maritime security challenges and opportunities after receiving lectures from senior government, academia, think-tank intelligence leaders, and maritime security experts. Upon completion of the course, the students recommended the following future actions to improve international cooperation:

- 1) Leverage the annual Asia-Pacific Intelligence Chiefs Conference (APICC) to promote maritime intelligence sharing initiatives,
- 2) Create a shared interoperable database to bring various information sharing tools together under one domain,
- 3) Use the 2014 IIFP to sponsor a Table Top Exercise at APICC 2014 to identify issues for follow-up by a standing O6-level working group, and
- 4) Develop a concept of operations for multinational maritime information sharing.

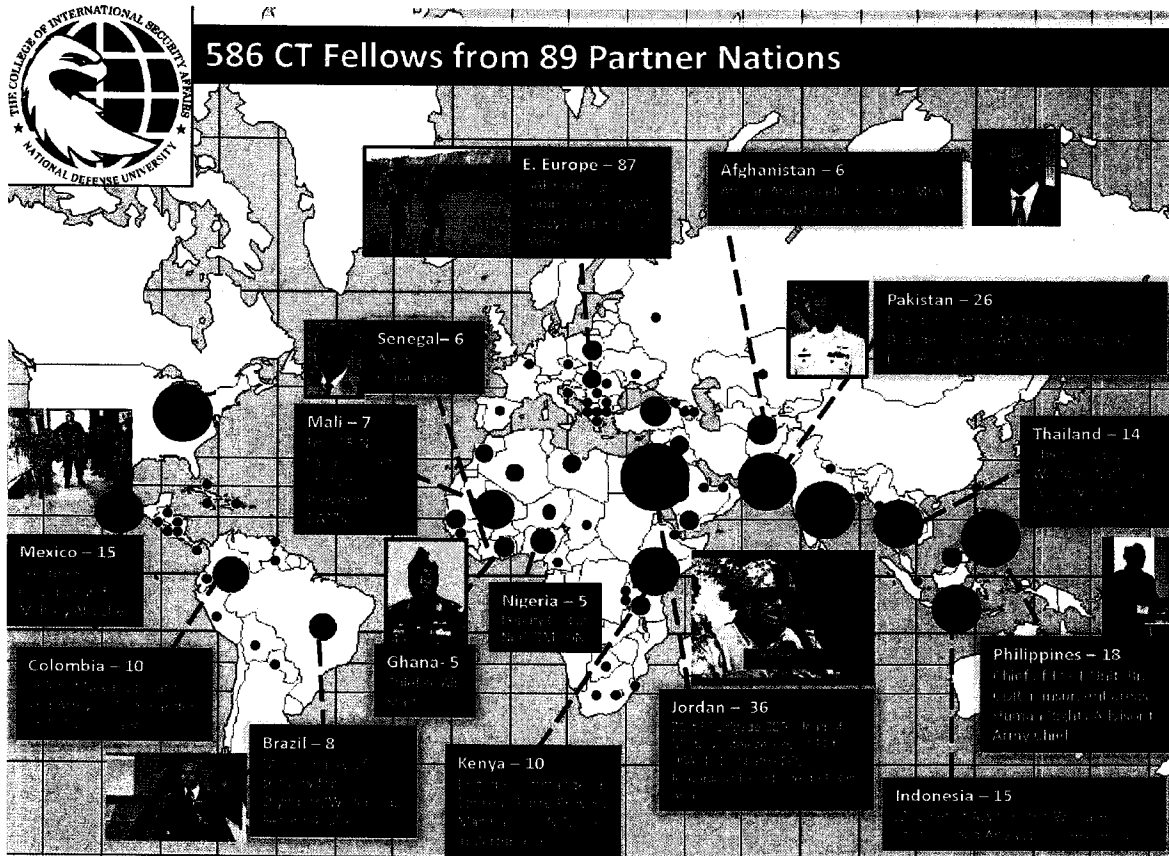
The Common Operational Research Environment (CORE) Lab partnered with U.S. Army Pacific to train the Royal Thai Army and Police Force in the application of social network analysis and countering improvised explosives. CORE Lab methodologies were used to enhance intelligence analysis by focusing on the physical components of IEDs.



George C. Marshall Center Community of Interest
 The Marshall Center led two community of interest workshops in FY 2013 bringing more than 90 security professionals from 65 countries back to the Center. The two separate programs covered a wide range of topics, such as the changing face of global terrorism, the role of critical thinking in confronting transnational issues, and the fundamental causes of international threats.

G. Individual Alumni Accomplishments

Many of the CTFP alumni are now in prominent positions within their countries and regions. Frequently, they are asked to speak on panels and provide insight into regional and global issues. Below is a summary of all the alumni from the CISA by region, highlighting some of the more prominent graduates.



Although all of these graduates have distinguished themselves in their own countries as well as in the United States, several are of particular note.



One of the few female officers in Mali, and the only female combat soldier, is a 2012 graduate of CISA. She has become a role model and mentor for many young Malian women. Other notable Malian graduates of CISA include the current Defense Attaché to the United States, and the senior military advisor to the Malian President.

In 2013, several CTFP alumni were named to the top posts in their country's militaries. Senegal's Army Chief of Staff, Colombia's Chief of Naval Operations, the Commandant of the Colombian Military, and the Chief of Defense Forces of Trinidad and Tobago are all recent graduates of CISA.



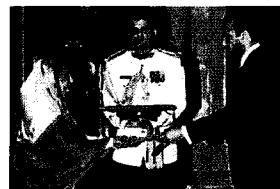
Ugandan CISA graduate with a captured LRA fighter.

In Africa, Ugandan and South Sudanese alumni work closely with U.S. Special Forces in the pursuit of the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA). The ability of African forces to operate with U.S. forces is due in large part to the time spent studying irregular warfare and U.S. doctrinal responses at the various CTFP institutions.

Also in 2013, Afghan President Karzai appointed a 2009 CISA graduate as Ambassador to India. The newly appointed Ambassador previously served as the Deputy National Security Advisor, and had been one of President Karzai's close advisors.

President Hamid Karzai has appointed close aide Shaida M. Abdali as Afghan ambassador to India.

Abdali, a former deputy national security advisor and Karzai's special assistant, presented his credentials to President Pratibha Patil on Monday.

In his previous assignments, he has closely worked with the high civilian and military representatives of many contributing nations and international organizations to help address Afghanistan's security and development needs, an Afghan embassy press release said.



One of CTFP's Jordanian alumni received the USSOCOM Medal for his invaluable role in furthering cooperation between Jordanian Special Forces and their U.S. counterparts. The officer is now the director of the Jordanian Special Warfare Center.

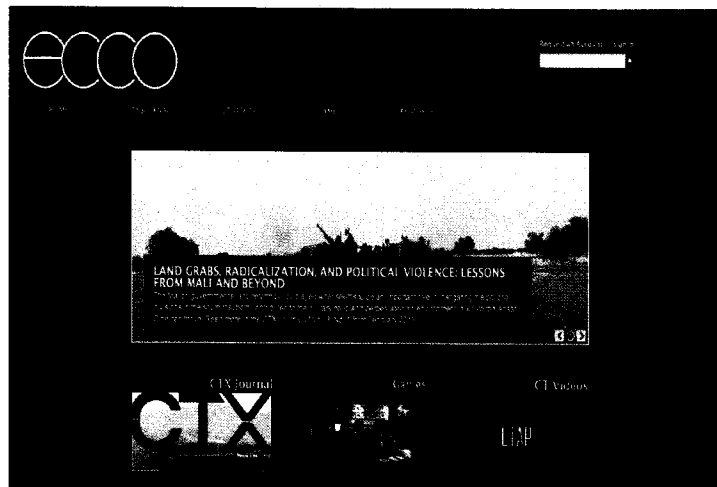
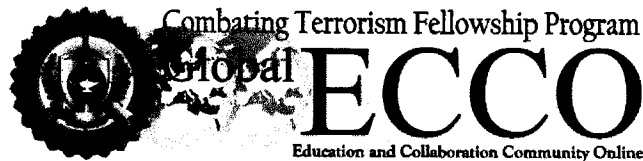
In addition to serving in increasingly more demanding positions, many of the CTFP alumni published scholarly articles in 2013 on various security related topics. A Pakistani officer published a book on human security. He offered specific recommendations that his country could adopt in order to improve individual security while not sacrificing civil liberties.

An Indian alumna from NPS published a detailed account of Maoist Insurgencies in Asia. He is now considered one of the leading experts in this type of insurgent movements, and is advising the Indian Home Minister on the best approaches for countering insurgent movements.

A Hungarian Special Forces officer's thesis written while at NPS is receiving high-level attention in his country. His thesis illustrated how to enhance national defense in difficult economic times by using innovative conceptual thinking derived from principles of irregular warfare.

H. PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVES

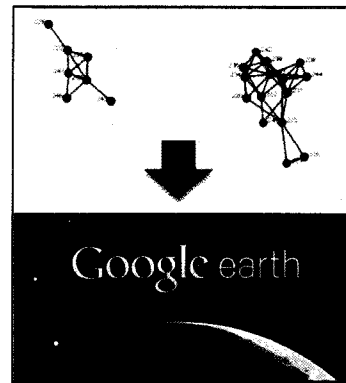
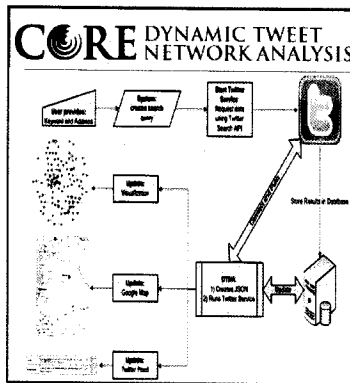
Updates on FY 2013 Initiatives



CTFP Global Education and Collaboration Community Online (ECCO): In FY 2013, the Global ECCO project launched its web-based platform as a tool for alumni to use to communicate about global security concerns. The current platform maintains electronic copies of the CTX Journal, as well as video testimonials of counter terrorism experiences of some of the CTFP alumni. Beta versions of several strategy learning games were also brought on line in FY 2013. These online strategy games provide tools for alumni to use to train themselves and their staffs in various counter terrorism disciplines, such as information operations and strategic counter terrorism planning.

NPS CORE Lab

The Common Operational Research Environment (CORE) Lab continued to provide invaluable analytical training to the international counter-terrorism community. The CORE Lab combines geospatial information with social network analysis giving analysts the ability to conduct predictive intelligence in areas many counter-terrorism areas. In FY 2013, the CORE Lab conducted 19 studies on counter-terrorism issues. Of particular note are two studies dealing with the ongoing violence in Syria, and a detailed study illustrating how to incorporate social network and link analysis to help counter-terrorism experts identify information gaps and key nodes in the human terrain.



I. SUMMARY

The CTFP is a valuable tool in the global fight against terrorism, and fills a crucial void in U.S. efforts to provide targeted international CbT education and training. The close relationship between OSD and the Combatant Commands has turned the program into a strategic tool in the struggle against violent extremism that effectively supports the efforts of the Combatant Commands in achieving their objectives through flexible, targeted international partner education and training. Building on previous efforts, the CTFP made significant strides during FY 2013 to develop and reinforce the CbT capabilities of partner nations, and to strengthen a global network of CbT experts committed to the fight against violent extremism and their proponents. Senior DoD and DOS officials consistently note the value of a global CTFP network and derive benefit through active participation in CTFP activities or by accessing the network to gain a better understanding of partner perceptions and best practices. The CTFP's continued efforts in operationalizing the global network, through a combination of targeted education and virtual communication, will help to ensure that the United States has a vast resource of CbT capability from which to draw in the years to come.

II. COUNTRY TRAINING ACTIVITIES

The following tables present a breakout of individual CTFP-funded education and training activities.

Reading the Data

- All data in this report is current as of October 1, 2013.
- The training activities and dollar amounts include funds expended to support all course costs, travel and living allowances, and medical expenditures. The FY 2013 dollars and training reported do not reflect the FY 2013 CTFP allocation level for each country because CTFP funds were re-allocated throughout the year, based on changing priorities and evolving requirements.
