However, as the complaint involved a member of the U.S. Marine Corps, the complaint was forwarded to the Marine Corps Inspector General. Their review is ongoing. During the course of the investigation by the Air Force Inspector General, it appeared that the investigation might have inappropriately compromised the identity of the complainant in contravention of Inspector General procedures. The DoD Hotline investigated this issue and found no impropriety.


(U) We received a copy of a draft article for publication in the National Guard magazine that highlighted potential violations of Executive Order 12333 and the Posse Comitatus Act. We forwarded the article to the Inspector General, The Joint Staff, for their review and action. On March 27, 2001, the Inspector General, The Joint Staff, reported that the assertions and allegations in the National Guard article were all investigated in a prior investigation that was completed in December 2000. Actions were taken to address deficiencies noted. This issue is considered closed.

The complaint alleged that JWAC personnel may have violated the above referenced directive through the conduct of unauthorized clandestine intelligence collection activities and violations of security procedures. The IG, JFCOM, issued its report on December 21, 2000, and concluded that the allegations were unsubstantiated. The DoD Hotline case is closed.

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




