SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority Pursuant to Executive Order 10621

(b) Executive Order 10621, "Delegation of Certain Functions of the President to

the Secretary of Defense," July 1, 1955, as amended

1. REISSUANCE AND PURPOSE

1.1. This Directive reissues Reference (a).

1.2. Pursuant to Section 1 of Reference (b), I designate the Secretary of the Navy and, in accordance with the assignment of their respective duties and responsibilities, the Under Secretary or the Navy and the Assistant Secretaries of the Navy, to perform with respect to the Department of the Navy the functions of the President described in Sections 1(a), 1(c), 1(g), and 1(h) of Executive Order 10621, without the approval, ratification, or other action of the President.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Directive is effective immediately.
