

- 1. Briefing by Technology Transfer PCC on COCOM decontrol and nonproliferation.
- 2. Briefing and discussion of missile and CBW proliferation sanctions. (See note below.)
- 3. Discussion of trilateral meeting with MTCR partners on Annex review.

NOTE: Missile and CBW sanctions working groups (SNGs), working under PCC auspices, have drafted preliminary assessments of potentially sanctionable activities which have occurred since the coming into effect of the DOD Authorization Act of 1990 (which contained missile sanctions provisions) and Executive Order 12735 (which contained CBW sanctions provisions).

If PCC Principals wish to identify other potential candidates for sanctions, they are requested to forward these nominations to: PM/PRO. Room 7430. Department of State. Attention: Frederick W. Axelgard, by OOB Thursday, February 21.

They should also indicate which provisions of the legislation or Executive Order they intend to invoke, and provide both a description of the sanctionable activity and the evidence that the activity has taken place. If codeword-level information is involved, please forward it to the Office of Strategic and Proliferation Affairs, Bureau of Intelligence and Research (INR/SPA), but still to Mr. Axelgard's attention.
