Actions Concerning Poland

The President has directed that the following actions, as communicated in his recent letter to General Jaruzelski, be taken against Poland:

- Withhold the remainder of the undelivered amount of the \$71 million worth of dried milk and butter which we agreed to sell Poland last April.
- Suspend the renewal of export insurance for 0 Poland by the Export Import Bank.
- O Polish civil aviation privileges in the United States will be suspended at the earliest practical date.
- There shall be no allocation of United States fisheries stocks to Poland in 1982.
