SUBJECT:

Outstanding Security Assistance Issues

With Israel

There are several outstanding defense related issues with Israel that I believe should be resolved during the current visit of Ministers Shamir and Arens. I anticipate that Minister Arens will raise these topics and forthcoming responses will help establish the cooperative relationship with Israel which you approved prior to my April trip to the Middle East. In view of the time constraints involved, I have sent a copy of this memorandum to Secretaries Weinberger and Regan with the suggestion that they may want to provide you their views on these issues. The three questions to be decided and my recommendations are:

-- Use of FMS financing for Research and Development projects in the U.S. for LAVI-related systems. The LAVI fighter aircraft program is of critical importance to Israel and Minister Arens, and the U.S. has already approved considerable financial and technical support for the project. In my view FMS financing should be approved for R&D projects in the U.S. for those systems, and only those systems, that will be produced in the U.S. Although this position falls short of the Israeli request to fund all R&D done here, it is forthcoming and would offer considerable financial resources for the program. It also encourages Israel to produce a significant portion of the LAVI fighter in this country, thereby serving U.S. economic interests.

-- Use of FMS financing for procurement in Israel of one element of Peace Marble II (the second 75 F-16s). This use of FMS financing, involving about \$100 million in Israeli-produced equipment, should be approved. Israel has been the low-bidder on this type of equipment in the past. This procedure would be consistent with those in the 1979 Memorandum of Agreement and the Defense Acquisition Regulations.
