

Despite the November 3 setback in which approval for JLP funding was removed from the Senate Defense Appropriations Bill, the JLP has been authorized. In consultation with our colleagues in the Department of Defense, we believe the next opportunity to obtain Congressional approval for funding for the JLP will come in the FY84 supplemental when the Congress resumes session in January 1984. In view of your strong endorsement of the JLP in NSDD-111, we propose the following steps to secure its early approval:



-- nurturing the body of knowledgeable supporters for the Administration's position by briefing again the House and Senate appropriations committees members,

-- obtaining an Israeli position of non-opposition to the JLP, and

-- reaffirming to King Hussein the Administration's commitment to see the JLP made a reality (a proposed message from you to King Hussein will be submitted for your consideration within the next few days), and securing his agreement and cooperation to our planned course of action.
