SUMMARY

1. (U) DR. HUSSEIN AL-JIBBOURI, CHAIRMAN OF THE IRAQI NATIONAL GATHERING PARTY TOLD AN AUDIENCE OF 500 FROM HIS HOME TOWN OF AL-ALAM THAT HIS PARTY WELCOMED IRAQIS FROM ALL ETHNIC AND RELIGIOUS COMMUNITIES, FAVORED THE PRIVATE SECTOR AS THE BASIS FOR THE IRAQI ECONOMY AND WOULD PURSUE A FOREIGN POLICY FOCUSED ON STRENGTHENING TIES WITH THE ADVANCED COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD SUCH AS THE UNITED STATES AND THE UK. HE CALLED FOR THE RECONSTITUTION OF THE IRAQI ARMY, A RE-EXAMINATION OF THE DE-BAQATHIFICATION PROCESS, ELECTIONS UNDER INTERNATIONAL SUPERVISION AND EXPANDED CONTACTS BETWEEN CPA AND PARTIES NOT REPRESENTED ON THE IRAQ GOVERNING COUNCIL (IGC). HE AVOIDED DIRECTLY ANSWERING QUESTIONS CONCERNING HIS EVALUATION OF THE IGC, THE KURDISH ATTITUDE TOWARD KIRKUK AND HIS PARTY'S ROLE IN OBTAINING THE RELEASE OF IRAQIS DETAINED BY THE U.S. MILITARY, BUT HE EXPRESSED CLEAR SUPPORT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF U.S. MILITARY BASES IN IRAQ AND SAID THE U.S. POSITION ON THE UNITY OF IRAQ HAS BEEN CONSISTENT AND CLEAR SINCE THE FIRST GULF WAR. END SUMMARY.

## POLITICS BEGINS AT HOME

2. (U) DR. HUSSEIN AL-JIBBOURI, CHAIRMAN OF THE IRAQI NATIONAL GATHERING (ING) PARTY KICKED OFF THE FIRST IN A SERIES OF PUBLIC MEETINGS TO PROMOTE HIS PARTY ON FEBRUARY 26, IN HIS HOME VILLAGE OF AL-ALAM, JUST ACROSS THE TIGRIS RIVER FROM THE CITY OF TIKRIT. HE TOLD IRAQI GOVERNING COUNCIL (IGC) BEFORE THE SESSION THAT HE INTENDED TO HOLD SIMILAR MEETINGS IN THE NEAR FUTURE IN MOSUL, KIRKUK, DIYALA, BAGHDAD, RAMADI AND OTHER CITIES WHERE HIS PARTY HAS, OR WILL SOON ESTABLISH, OFFICES. OVER 500 SHEIKHS AND OTHER LOCAL LEADERS, AND ORDINARY CITIZENS, INCLUDING A LARGE NUMBER OF YOUNG PEOPLE -- AND EVEN A FEW WOMEN -- CROWDED THE AL-ALAM YOUTH CENTER TO HEAR THE INGQS MESSAGE.

3. (U) DR. HUSSEIN REVIEWED THE BIRTH OF HIS PARTY IN 1991 AND HIS FLIGHT TO NORTHERN IRAQ FOLLOWING THE FAILED COUP CARRIED OUT BY SEVERAL OF HIS RELATIVES IN THE REPUBLICAN PALACE FOLLOWING THE FIRST GULF WAR. HE SAID HIS CONTACTS WITH KURDISH PARTIES HAD TAUGHT HIM MUCH ABOUT POLITICAL LIFE, BUT THAT HE HAD DECIDED TO BUILD HIS PARTY ON AN INCLUSIVE PLATFORM. NOTING THAT MANY IRAQI PARTIES HAD FORMED ON ETHNIC, RELIGIOUS, OR SECTARIAN BASES, HE STRESSED THAT HE WANTED TO ATTRACT ALL IRAQIS -- SUNNI, SHIQA, CHRISTIAN, SUFI, ARAB, KURD, TURKMAN -- TO WORK TOGETHER ON THE BASIS OF BUILDING THE IRAQI NATION. HE CALLED THE ING A BIG TENT WHERE THERE WOULD BE ROOM FOR ALL.

### THE ING PLATFORM

4. (U) FOLLOWING DR. HUSSEINQS SPEECH, HIS POLITICAL ADVISOR, RAQAD KHATAB, OUTLINED THE INGQS POLITICAL PLATFORM. HE LISTED SIX GOALS:

- ESTABLISHMENT OF A BROAD-BASED DEMOCRACY OF THE PEOPLE;
- ENSURING THE UNITY OF IRAQQS LAND AND PEOPLE;
- BUILDING THE ECONOMY ON THE BASIS OF THE PRIMACY OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR;
- ESTABLISHING STRONG, BALANCED RELATIONS WITH ALL NATIONS, WITH PRIMACY GIVEN TO THE ADVANCED COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD LIKE THE UNITED STATES AND THE UK;
- BUILDING A NEW INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY FREE FROM

TERRORISM; AND

-- BROAD PARTICIPATION IN THE INTERNATIONAL ECONOMY.

KHATAB ALSO SET FORTH EIGHT PROPOSALS:

-- EXPAND THE BASE OF POPULAR PARTICIPATION IN POLITICAL PARTIES;

-- CONDUCT GREATER DIALOGUE BETWEEN CPA AND PARTIES NOT REPRESENTED ON THE IGC;

-- HOLD COMING ELECTIONS ON THE BASIS OF A NATIONAL CENSUS UNDER INTERNATIONAL SUPERVISION;

-- ACCELERATE THE REBUILDING OF IRAQ IN ORDER TO PROVIDE

(U) DR. 4. (U) FOLLOWING DR. HUSSEINQS SPEECH, HIS POLITICAL ADVISOR, RAQAD KHATAB, OUTLINED THE INGQS POLITICAL PLATFORM. HE LISTED SIX GOALS:

- ESTABLISHMENT OF A BROAD-BASED DEMOCRACY OF THE PEOPLE;
- ENSURING THE UNITY OF IRAQQS LAND AND PEOPLE;
- BUILDING THE ECONOMY ON THE BASIS OF THE PRIMACY OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR;
- ESTABLISHING STRONG, BALANCED RELATIONS WITH ALL NATIONS, WITH PRIMACY GIVEN TO THE ADVANCED COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD LIKE THE UNITED STATES AND THE UK;

KHATAB ALSO SET FORTH EIGHT PROPOSALS:

DODGING SOME QUESTIONS, FACING SOME HARD ISSUES

5. (U) FOLLOWING KHATABQS PRESENTATION, DR. HUSSEIN TOOK QUESTIONS FOR NEARLY ONE HOUR. HE DODGED SOME ISSUES, BUT WAS FORTHRIGHT IN THE FACE OF OTHERS. ASKED ABOUT THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE IGC, HE TOLD THE CROWD HE HAD KNOWN MANY OF ITS MEMBERS FOR YEARS, HAVING LIVED AMONG THEM IN SAUDI ARABIA AND SYRIA. IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION ABOUT HIS PARTYQS ROLE IN OBTAINING THE RELEASE OF DETAINEES, HE REPLIED THAT THE U.S. MILITARY HAD RELEASED MANY DETAINEES PRIOR TO THE EID. ASKED FOR HIS EVALUATION OF JALAL TALABANIQS POSITION REGARDING KIRKUK, HE ONLY REPLIED, QKIRKUK IS A CITY FOR ALL, A CITY OF PEACE.Q HOWEVER, WHEN SOMEONE ASKED WHETHER THE U.S. SUPPORTED TALABANIQS KURDISH NATIONALISM, HE POINTED OUT THAT THE U.S. HAD FORCEFULLY AND CONSISTENTLY SUPPORTED THE UNITY AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF IRAQ, AND HAD OFTEN REPEATED ITS STANCE SINCE 1991. ON THE ISSUE OF U.S. MILITARY BASES, HE SAID HE UNDERSTOOD SOME BASES WOULD BE BUILT IN THE SOUTH. HE ADDED THAT HE STRONGLY SUPPORTED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF U.S. BASES SINCE THE U.S. HAD BASES IN SEVERAL ADVANCED COUNTRIES LIKE THE UK, JAPAN AND KOREA. HE ADDED THAT HE DID NOT UNDERSTAND WHY PEOPLE SHOULD REGARD THE ISSUE AS A SENSITIVE ONE.

6. (U) REGARDING THE COMING TRANSITION TO IRAQI SOVEREIGNTY, HUSSEIN REVIEWED THE PROPOSAL TO USE CAUCUSES TO ELECT A TRANSITIONAL NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, NOTING THAT THE PROPOSAL HAD NOT RECEIVED SUFFICIENT SUPPORT AND THEREFORE

THE WAY AHEAD WAS UNCLEAR. IN RESPONSE TO A QUERY ABOUT THE PRESENCE OR ABSENCE OF REFERENCES TO ISLAM IN THE TRANSITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE LAW (TAL), HE SAID CPA ADMINISTRATOR BREMER HAD SAID THE TAL WOULD BE BASED ON ISLAM. DODGING SOME QUESTIONS, FACING SOME HARD ISSUES

5. (U) FOLLOWING KHATABQS PRESENTATION, DR. HUSSEIN TOOK QUESTIONS FOR NEARLY ONE HOUR. HE DODGED SOME ISSUES, BUT WAS FORTHRIGHT IN THE FACE OF OTHERS. ASKED ABOUT THE

EFFECTIVENESS OF THE IGC, HE TOLD THE CROWD HE HAD KNOWN MANY OF ITS MEMBERS FOR YEARS, HAVING LIVED AMONG THEM IN SAUDI ARABIA AND SYRIA. IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION ABOUT HIS PARTY'S ROLE IN OBTAINING THE RELEASE OF DETAINEES, HE REPLIED THAT THE U.S. MILITARY HAD RELEASED MANY DETAINEES PRIOR TO THE BID. ASKED FOR HIS EVALUATION OF JALAL TALABANI'S POSITION REGARDING KIRKUK, HE ONLY REPLIED, "KIRKUK IS A CITY FOR ALL, A CITY OF PEACE." HOWEVER, WHEN SOMEONE ASKED WHETHER THE U.S. SUPPORTED TALABANI'S KURDISH NATIONALISM, HE POINTED OUT THAT THE U.S. HAD FORCEFULLY AND CONSISTENTLY SUPPORTED THE UNITY AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF IRAQ, AND HAD OFTEN REPEATED ITS STANCE SINCE 1991. ON THE ISSUE OF U.S. MILITARY BASES, HE SAID HE UNDERSTOOD SOME BASES WOULD BE BUILT IN THE SOUTH. HE ADDED THAT HE STRONGLY SUPPORTED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF U.S.

(U) REGARDING THE COMING TRANSITION TO IRAQI SOVEREIGNTY, HUSSEIN REVIEWED THE PROPOSAL TO USE CAUCUSES TO ELECT A TRANSITIONAL NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, NOTING THAT THE PROPOSAL HAD NOT RECEIVED SUFFICIENT SUPPORT AND THEREFORE THE WAY AHEAD WAS UNCLEAR. IN RESPONSE TO A QUERY ABOUT THE PRESENCE OR ABSENCE OF REFERENCES TO ISLAM IN THE TRANSITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE LAW (TAL), HE SAID CPA ADMINISTRATOR BREMER HAD SAID THE TAL WOULD BE BASED ON ISLAM.
