**SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:**

The Bayt Al Hikma/House of Knowledge is an independent academic institution housed in the former Iraq Parliament building. The present management team has requested access to their bank account for the purpose of paying half of a six month lease on rental space so they can move the stored materials out and save the remaining three month rent.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Bayt Al Hikma/House of Knowledge is under the Ministry of Culture for administrative purposes due to the historic nature of the buildings they control. We have supported them with Emergency Payment and Salary procedures.

During recent discussions about returning to normal institute operations, the two most active managers (b)(6) and (b)(6) raised the issue of storage space rented by the institute. They had some paper that was to be used for publishing and wanted to ensure the paper survived the hostilities. The rental agreement was for six months, but now that the security situation in their neighborhood is improving, they wish to move the paper back to the building and save the remaining three months rent at the storage facility.

[REDACTED] owner of an antiques shop called "Abu Ghasswan Antiques", close to Abu Is'far al Mansour's monument and a petrol station, is a partner with [REDACTED]. The latter was a close aid, a bodyguard and a brother in law of Saddam. [REDACTED] is an intermediary between big dealers of antiquities on the one hand and [REDACTED] on the other. He sponsors a group of sculptors to replace the stolen pieces with ones made by them. One major dealer living abroad is [REDACTED] of Baghdad, once imprisoned by Saddam Hussein in the 1970s, and now a major partner with [REDACTED] and an "advisor" to the Emir of Qatar!! (who appeared on al Jazeera immediately after the outbreak of the news of the looting of the Iraqi Museum to "denounce the US' complicity")

[REDACTED] has been awarded \$ 19,000 by the US administration!!!

Established in the early 1990s as a think tank composed of the very privileged Ba'athists with higher degrees in social and humanitarian fields who have special connections to the Mukhabarat (Intelligence), and/or to the ruling family. The five departments of al Hikma and its board of trustees are staffed with such individuals. Among the well-known services are testifying against independent professors (I have evidence of at least three such cases), writing dissertations to be presented by members of the ruling family or highly placed officials to obtain Ph.D.s. Example of the latter "doctors": Uday Saddam Hussein (2 Ph.D.s !!), Sab'awi Ibrahim and Barzan Ibrahim (Saddam's half brothers), Ammar Laif Hussain Jassim (son of ex-minister of information and member of the RCC), etc. Main figures are [REDACTED]

"Studies" in the al Hikma publications rarely escape mentioning the "theories" and teachings of Saddam Hussein, or to use the various reports of the Ba'ath Party as "academic references". The statute of this indoctrination organization explicitly contains such fascist statements: "Our objective is to invoke the spirit of the Nation", "giving special attention to the National Socialist thought", etc...

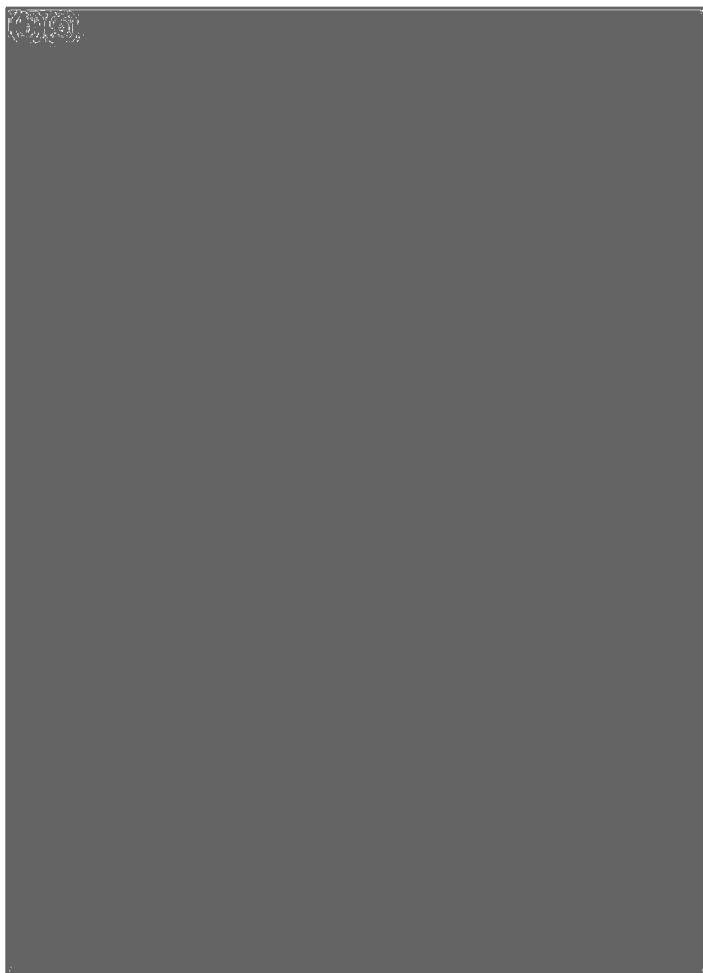

#### 4. Conclusions:

While it is true the recent past of the Bayt Al Hikma does have a Ba'athist connection, it is a past that should not be overstated or be allowed to blind us to potential value of the organization and the symbolic value of the building. These connections cover a mere ten year or less period and must be seen in perspective to a history spanning nearly a millennium. The building is an iconic symbol of democracy and debate and by helping to restore it for that purpose I believe we are sending out a confident and highly positive message to the outside world. In short, the Bayt Al Hikma has the potential to become a central focal point in the regeneration of academic and cultural life in Baghdad, to be a key component in a new cultural quarter within the city, and to forge a role for itself in Iraq similar to that of the Smithsonian Institute.

I am confident the people I deal with do are educated professional people who are driven by academic excellence and themselves with very reputable academic credentials. I believe that continued support for Bayt Al Hikma is not only a positive thing to do but it presents a very strong message and symbol to the Iraq people and other nations that the Coalition and Provisional Authority are serious about restoring debate and democracy to Iraqi cultural life despite past short lived Ba'athist connections. Moreover, the rapid progress that Bayt Al Hikma is making on the restoration programme means this is a message we can promote very soon.

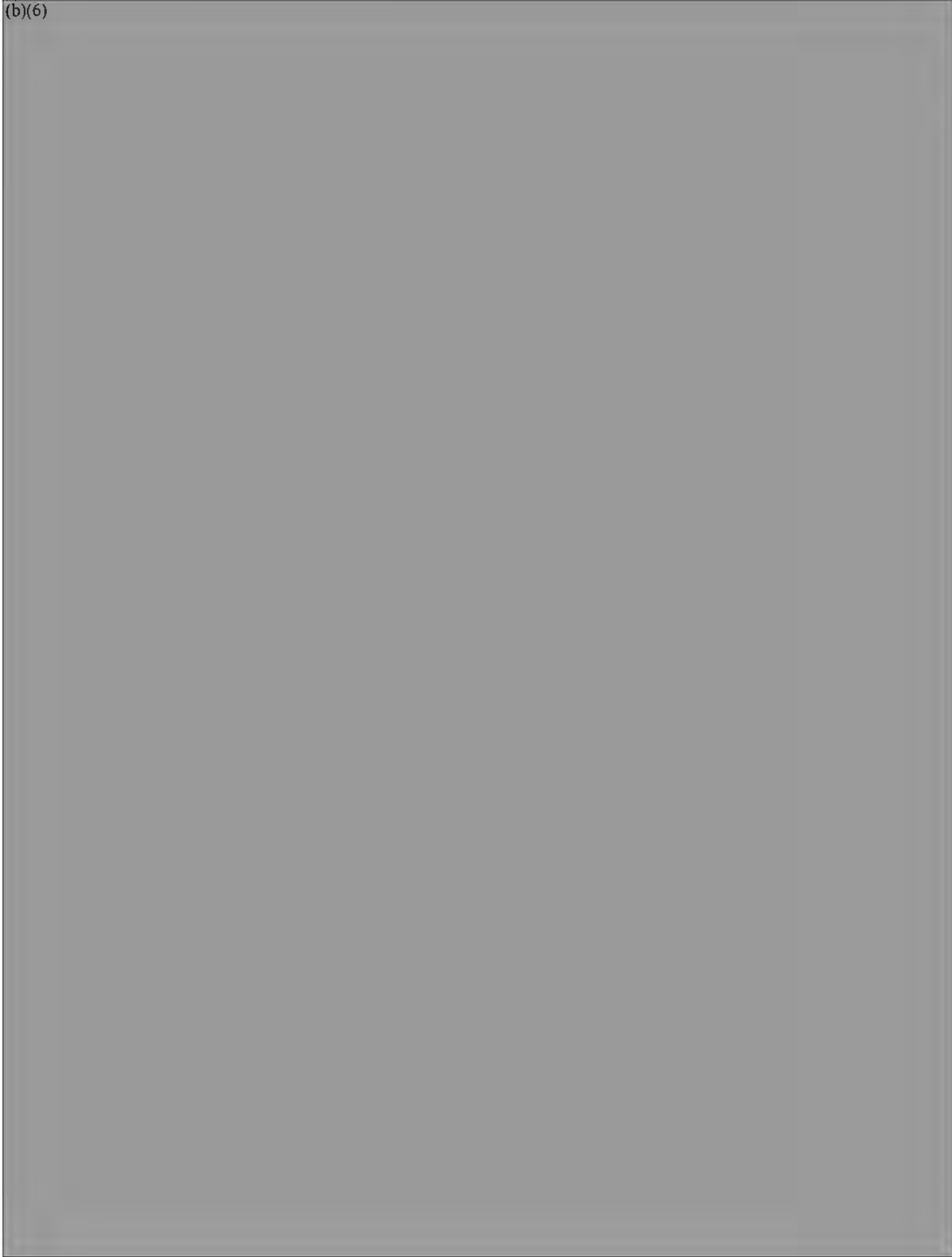

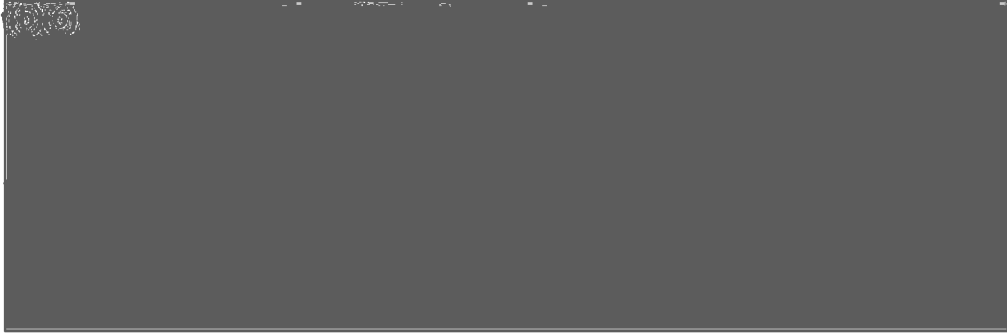

The issue of non party members who were fired by the previous regime and have petitioned for their jobs back as early as April or May affects every company in the MIM portfolio (48) at virtually every plant location (130). This goes as far back as 91. The MIM has represented that this figure is a minimum of 15,000 persons and upwards of 20,000 persons.

Many DG's did not act because they could not absorb the expense... (Some may have acted politically). With the 24 July proclamation of a hiring freeze the aggrieved party perceives that the DGs stalled on their April/may petition until this "out" relieved them from making the decision.

I agree Iraq should not be the employer of last resort. However this has been the reality (The MIM has turned away tens of thousands of persons who have come demanding a position because their private sector job no longer exists).

These seeking petitions are financially desperate... as well as perceiving a grave injustice from the previous regime and the current (acting under CPA guidance).

I concur with Mr. [Redacted] recommendation that a commission review their cases - which I understand is documented - and provided with one of the following

- 1) a stipend (but not their job).
- 2) or their job with sonority.

Returning them to the company will only result in false expectations... (If I have learned anything about 10 years in economic development it's managing expectations).

1. Attached are two claims for overtime submitted by Col. [Redacted] on behalf of staff working in the Conference House. These claims are for the following reasons:
  - a. 27<sup>th</sup> June - The Ministry of Culture hosted a concert of the Iraqi Symphony Orchestra. The event fell on a Friday and therefore overtime needs to be paid. 75 members of staff (listed in attachment A) worked at this event.
  - b. 16<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> June - Ambassador Bremer hosted two Economic Forum meetings at the Iraq Forum. These events fell in the late afternoon and early evening so staff had to stay late. 10 members of staff (listed in attachment B) worked at these events.
2. The agreed overtime rate is \$10 per day.
3. I agree with Col. [Redacted] that these payments are justified as they met CPA needs.
4. I have discussed with the Ministry of Finance on how these payments are to be made and from which budget head. You will not be surprised to learn that there is no central policy on overtime payments at present. For the moment, I have agreed with the Ministry of Finance that the payments should be made from the operating expenses budget. The total payments for the above claims amounts to \$850.
5. If you are content, I will pass this memo along with the lists of names to [Redacted] to ensure that these staff receive payment.
