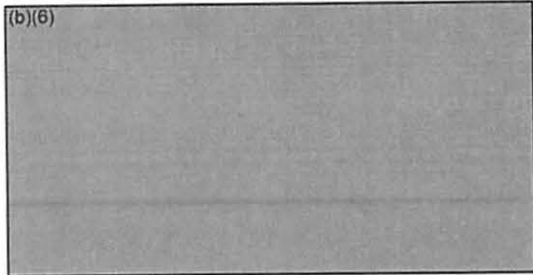
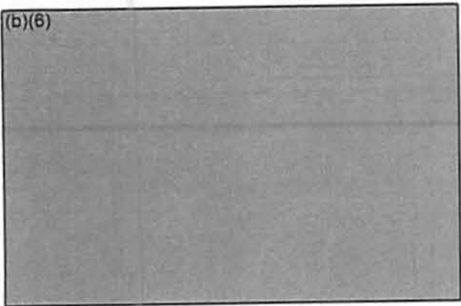

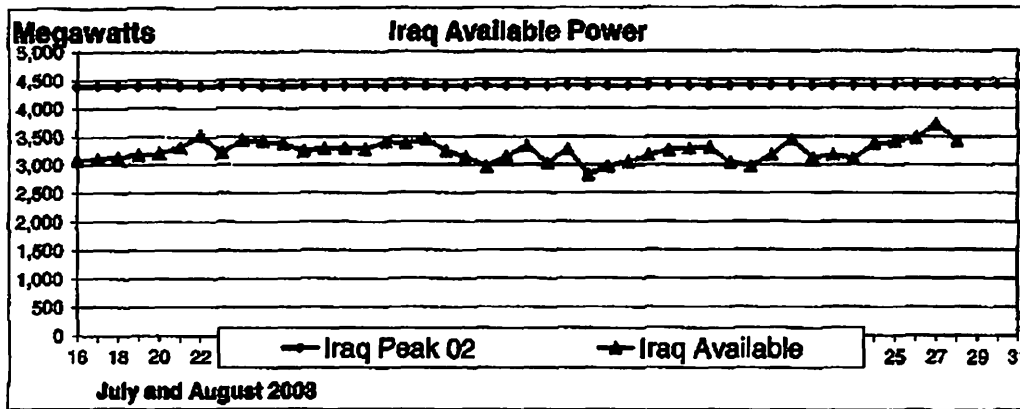

Electricity



- According to UNDP, from 1991 through 2001 average daily power production was 3300 Megawatts.
- As part of an uneven upward trend, electrical power reached a post-war peak of 3724 megawatts. Power station unreliability due to obsolete and worn-out equipment means progress will be uneven, although we have posted project managers at every power station.
- Repairs to transmission lines are still slow. A recent survey shows that about 620 transmission towers are down.
- The Oil-Power Fuel Task Force is working to ensure adequate fuel is available for increased generation. Collaboration and results are positive. Shortage of diesel is a limiting factor and other fuel sources are being sought.
- Signed an agreement with Turkey to import 50MW growing to a potential of 100MW of power in exchange for dollars and #6 fuel oil.

Oil Production

- Loading of crude oil tankers at MABOT, averages 600,000-700,000 bbl/d.
- Export pipeline to Turkey sabotaged on 15 August is repaired, but has nothing to export until crude oil pipeline sabotaged on 29 August between Kirkuk and Baiji is repaired.
- Basra Refinery on independent power and producing all products.
- LPG and Benzene will be imported until spring 2004.

School Status

- School year starts 15 September in the North and 1 October elsewhere.
- Textbook issuance set back by contract and Iraqi printer problems and death of the UNICEF lead.
- Additionally, the military has completed 1,180 school projects (not all are construction) under CERP.

Irrigation

- Major clearance problem is invasive weeds that diminish water flows.
- Project generates employment for unskilled workers, 2.5 million man-days to date.
- Over \$6.5 USD injected into the rural economy.
- Banking procedures hamper the payment of workers.

Health Care

- No evidence of epidemics.
- Disease rates reflected above are not higher than pre-war disease rates.
- MOH has graduated two classes of 76 Iraqi Emergency Medical Service students who now serve as First Responders in Iraq.
- Results negative for radiation effects for all 2,600 (from a universe of 4,000) potentially affected by radiation at the Al Tuwaith nuclear research site.
