SUBJECT: Verdict in Saddam Hussein's Trial

- (27) The Iraqi High Tribunal is expected to announce the verdict in the first trial against Saddam Hussein on Sunday, November 5, 2006. A death sentence is possible.
 - Saddam and his co-defendants are accused of crimes against humanity stemming from retaliation for a failed assassination attempt in the village of Al-Dujayl.
 - At least 148 villagers were executed, others died as a result of torture during their investigation, and hundreds of others were arrested and detained without charge for several years.
- Should the court deliver a death sentence, it is unlikely the order would be carried out quickly. Iraqi law requires execution of sentence within 30 days after the judgment becomes final, but there is a mandatory appeal for all death sentences to a higher court.
 - Saddam is charged or under investigation in a number of other pending cases, including the ongoing trial focused on genocide of the Kurds during 1987-1988.

- In light of these cases, the appeals chamber may take its time in ruling on an appeal, to allow the other trials to proceed.

- 4. Implementation of this sentence (after judgment is final) would not be delayed by other trials
- 5. Saddam's Anfal trial is currently ongoing
- 6. MNF-I published FRAGO 06-412 (9 AUG 06) WRT verdict announcement requirements (MNC-Is listed on next slide)
- 8. Multiple "flashpoints" are associated with trial verdicts based on different announcements (verdict, appeal etc.)
