

EUROPEAN DEALS ON IRAQI OIL

Question: What can you tell us about French involvement in handling Iraq's oil?

Answer:

- We are not aware of any signed contracts between any French companies and the Iraqi government to develop Iraqi oil fields.
- We do understand that Total--as the conglomerate is now known--had conducted preliminary negotiations with Saddam's Iraq and had signed agreements in principle to develop two large Iraqi oil fields, Nahr Umar and Majnoon. However, to the best of my knowledge, these understandings, like all such preliminary understanding in the oil industry, are not legally binding.
- Since these understandings were preliminary, they did not require UN approval and they did not have UN approval. During the UN sanctions regime, final deals with Iraq must have UN Sanctions Committee approval to carry any legal weight.

Question: What can you tell us about German involvement in handling Iraq's oil?
