The term "proprietary information" for purposes of this clause is any information considered so valuable by its owners that it is held secret by them and their licensees. Information furnished voluntarily by the owner without limitations on its use, or which is available without restrictions from other sources, is not considered proprietary.

- (1) Maintenance of Objectivity: The Contractor shall be ineligible to participate in any capacity in contracts, subcontracts, or proposals thereof (solicited or unsolicited) which stem directly from the Contractor's performance of work under this contract. Furthermore, unless so directed in writing by the Contracting Officer, the Contractor shall not perform any services under this contract on any of its own products or services, or the products or services of another firm if the Contractor is, or has been, substantially involved in their development or marketing. In addition, if the Contractor under this contract prepares a complete, or essentially complete, Statement of Work (SOW)/Statement of Objectives (SOO), or other form of technical solutions, functions, requirements or specifications document, to be used, directly or indirectly, in competitive acquisitions, the Contractor shall be ineligible to perform or participate in any capacity in any contractual effort which is based on such SOW/SOO or specifications. Nothing in this subparagraph shall preclude the Contractor from competing for follow-on contracts involving the same or similar services based on such a SOW/SOO or specification. (THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO FOLLOW-ON SBIR/STTR CONTRACTS FOR WORK AWARDED IN PHASE I OR PHASE IL)
- (2) Access To and Use of Government Information: If the Contractor, in the performance of this contract, obtains access to information such as plans, policies, reports, studies, financial plans, or data which has not been released or otherwise made available to the public, the Contractor agrees that without prior written approval of the Contracting Officer, it shall not: (a) use such information for any private purpose; (b) compete for work based on such information for a period of one year after the completion of this contract, or until such information is released or otherwise made available to the public, whichever occurs first; (c) submit an unsolicited proposal to the Government which is based on such information until one (1) year after such information is released or otherwise made available to the public, or (d) release such information.
- (3) Access To and Protection of Proprietary Information: The Contractor agrees that, to the extent it receives or is given access to proprietary data, trade secrets, or other confidential or privileged technical, business, or financial information (hereinafter referred to as "proprietary data") under this contract, it shall treat such information in accordance with any restrictions imposed on such information. The Contractor further agrees to enter into a written agreement for the protection of the proprietary data of others and to exercise diligent effort to protect such proprietary data from unauthorized use or disclosure. In addition, the Contractor shall obtain from each employee who has access to proprietary data under this contract, a written agreement which shall in substance provide that such employee shall not, during his/her employment by the Contractor or thereafter, disclose to others or use for their benefit, proprietary data received in connection with the work under this contract. The Contractor will educate its employees regarding the philosophy of Part 9.505-4 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation so that they will not use or disclose proprietary information or data generated or acquired in the performance of this contract except as provided herein.
- c. Subcontracts: The Contractor shall include this or substantially the same clause, including this paragraph, in consulting agreements and subcontracts of all tiers. The terms "Contract", "Contractor", and "Contracting Officer", will be appropriately modified to preserve the Government's rights.

d. Representations and Disclosures:

- (1) The Contractor represents that it has disclosed to the Contracting Officer, prior to award, all facts relevant to the existence or potential existence of organizational conflicts of interest as that term is used in FAR Subpart 9.5. To facilitate disclosure and Contracting Officer approval, the Contractor shall complete an OCI Analysis/Disclosure Form for each MDA, Ballistic Missile Defense (BMD), and BMD-related contract or subcontract (if there is a potential conflict of interest; form shall be requested from the Procuring Contracting Officer).
- (2) The Contractor represents that if it discovers an organizational conflict of interest or potential conflict of interest after award, a prompt and full disclosure shall be made in writing to the Contracting Officer. This disclosure shall include a description of the action the Contractor has taken or proposes to take in order to avoid or mitigate such conflicts.

e. Remedies and Waiver:

- (1) For breach of any of the above restrictions or for non-disclosure or misrepresentation of any relevant facts required to be disclosed concerning this contract, the Government may terminate this contract for default, disqualify the Contractor from subsequent related contractual efforts, and pursue such other remedies as may be permitted by law or this contract. If, however, in compliance with this clause, the Contractor discovers and promptly reports an organizational conflict of interest (or the potential thereof) subsequent to contract award, the Contracting Officer may terminate this contract for convenience if such termination is deemed to be in the best interest of the Government.
- (2) The parties recognize that this clause has potential effects which will survive the performance of this contract and that it is impossible to foresee each circumstance to which it might be applied in the future. Accordingly, the Contractor may at any time seek a waiver from the Director, MDA, (via the Contracting Officer) by submitting a full written description of the requested waiver and the reasons in support thereof.
- f. Modifications: Prior to contract modification, when the SOW/SOO or specification is changed to add new work or the period of performance is significantly increased, the Contracting Officer will request and the Contractor is required to submit either an organizational conflict of interest disclosure or an update of the previously submitted disclosure(s) or representation(s).

H-10 ENABLING CLAUSE FOR BMD INTERFACE SUPPORT (MAY 2005)

- a. It is anticipated that, during the performance of this contract, the Contractor will be required to support Technical Interface/Integration Meetings (TIMS) with other Ballistic Missile Defense (BMD) Contractors and other Government agencies. Appropriate organizational conflicts of interest clauses and additional costs, if any, will be negotiated as needed to protect the rights of the Contractor and the Government.
- b. Interface support deals with activities associated with the integration of the requirements of this contract into BMD system plans and the support of key Missile Defense Agency (MDA) program reviews.
- c. The Contractor agrees to cooperate with BMD Contractors by providing access to technical matters, provided, however, the Contractor will not be required to provide proprietary information to non-Government entities or personnel in the absence of a non-disclosure agreement between the Contractor and such entities.
- d. The Contractor further agrees to include a clause in each subcontract requiring compliance with paragraph c. above. This agreement does not relieve the Contractor of its responsibility to manage its subcontracts effectively, nor is it intended to establish privity of contract between the Government and such subcontractors.
- e. Personnel from BMD Contractors or other Government agencies or Contractors are not authorized to direct the Contractor in any manner. The Contractor agrees to accept technical direction as follows: Whenever it becomes necessary to modify the contract and redirect the effort, a change order signed by the Contracting Officer, or a supplemental agreement signed by both the Contracting Officer and the Contractor, will be issued.
- f. This clause shall not prejudice the Contractor or its subcontractors from negotiating separate organizational conflict of interest agreements with BMD Contractors; however, these agreements shall not restrict any of the Government's rights established pursuant to this clause or any other contract.

b. The COR is authorized to approve visit requests for the Contracting Officer.

H-12 CONTROL OF ACCESS TO MDA SPACES AND INFORMATION SYSTEMS (MAY 2005)

- a. To maintain the security of the MDA spaces and information systems, the Contractor shall notify the COR in writing whenever a prime or subcontractor employee included on the current Visit Authorization Request/Letter no longer supports this contract. This requirement shall apply to both Contractor and employee initiated termination of services and to temporary suspension of services.
- b. The contractor will cooperate with COR in taking the following actions (facilitating the employee's return of all badges, keycards, and passes). Specifically, upon notification, the COR will work with the Technical Area Security Officer (TASO)/Office Security Manager (OSM) to ensure timely action to:
 - (1) remove the employee from the current Visit Authorization Reguest/Letter;
- (2) cancel the MDA badge, keycard and Pentagon Pass issued pursuant to the Visit Authorization Request/Letter; and
 - (3) terminate the MDA LAN account/access privileges.
- c. The contractor shall identify the reason for and date of termination or expected period of suspension and submit the notification to the COR within five (5) working days prior to service discontinuation. For unplanned termination or suspension of services, notification shall be made on the same working day as the termination/suspension action.

H-13 ACQUISITION OF GENERAL PURPOSE EQUIPMENT

The Contractor agrees to provide all necessary general purpose equipment for the performance of this contract. The term general purpose equipment includes all general purpose office equipment and automated data/information processing equipment and software. Accordingly, the Contractor shall not purchase or lease general purpose equipment for the account of the Government without the express permission of the Contracting Officer. In no case shall the cost to the Government for leased general purpose equipment, acquired under this contract, exceed the constructive cost of ownership. Additionally, acquisition or lease of general purpose equipment, if approved by the Contracting Officer, shall be provided at cost, applicable burdens applied, exclusive of prime Contractor fee/profit of other profit centers or business units of the prime Contractor.

H-14 PERSONNEL CHANGES

- a. The Contractor shall promptly notify the Contracting Officer and Contracting Officer's Representative prior to making any changes involving foreign persons. No foreign person shall be employed on this contract without the approval of the Contracting Officer.
- b. The Contractor shall promptly notify the Contracting Officer and Contracting Officer's Representative prior to making any changes in key staff. If replacing key staff the Contractor shall adhere to the following: (1) replacement person's qualifications are equal to or better than the qualifications of the person being replaced; or (2) the added person's qualifications are equal to or better than the core capabilities of this contract. Key staff positions are defined as: Principle Investigator, Principal Engineer, or equivalent with primary employment by the prime contractor. (They must be with the firm at the time of award and during the conduct of the proposed project, unless replacement is authorized by the Contracting Officer. Primary employment means that more than one half of the principal investigator's time is spent in the employ of the small business. Primary employment with a small business concern precludes full-time employment at another organization.)
- c. All Contractor notifications must provide the name and departure date for the incumbent leaving, a complete resume for the proposed substitute, and any other pertinent information requested by the Contracting Officer. The Government shall be provided the opportunity to review the proposed substitution regarding qualifications, security matters or any other concerns which could, in its opinion, affect performance under this contract.
- d. This clause does not, in any way, abrogate the contractor's authority to hire or assign personnel as it sees fit, or its responsibility to fill key positions with qualified personnel.

PUBLIC LAW 102-564, SEC. 306. SENSE OF THE CONGRESS CONCERNING AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS.

"(a) PURCHASE OF AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT AND PRODUCTS- It is the sense of the Congress that an entity that is awarded a funding agreement under the SBIR program of a Federal agency under section 9 of the

Small Business Act should, when purchasing any equipment or a product with funds provided through the funding agreement, purchase only American-made equipment and products, to the extent possible in keeping with the overall purposes of that program.

"(b) NOTICE TO SBIR AWARDEES- Each Federal agency that awards funding agreements under the SBIR program shall provide to each recipient of such an award a notice describing the sense of the Congress, as set forth in subsection (a)."

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS REGARDING POTENTIAL ACCESS TO EXPORT-CONTROLLED ITEMS

Although the Government has made a determination in accordance with DFARS 204-7304, the number and diversity of Small Business Innovative Research projects is such that the choice of either the DFARS 252.204-7008 "Requirements for Contracts Involving Export-Controlled Items" clause or the DFARS 252.204-7009 "Requirements Regarding Potential Access to Export-Controlled Items" clause is not a definitive indication of whether or not export controlled items are likely to be involved in contract performance. CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

52,216-7 ALLOWABLE COST AND PAYMENT (DEC 2002)

(a) Invoicing.

- (1) The Government will make payments to the Contractor when requested as work progresses, but (except for small business concerns) not more often than once every 2 weeks, in amounts determined to be allowable by the Contracting Officer in accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) subpart 31.2 in effect on the date of this contract and the terms of this contract. The Contractor may submit to an authorized representative of the Contracting Officer, in such form and reasonable detail as the representative may require, an invoice or voucher supported by a statement of the claimed allowable cost for performing this contract.
- (2) Contract financing payments are not subject to the interest penalty provisions of the Prompt Payment Act. Interim payments made prior to the final payment under the contract are contract financing payments, except interim payments if this contract contains Alternate I to the clause at 52,232-25.
- (3) The designated payment office will make interim payments for contract financing on the 30th (Contracting Officer insert day as prescribed by agency head; if not prescribed, insert "30th") day after the designated billing office receives a proper payment request.

In the event that the Government requires an audit or other review of a specific payment request to ensure compliance with the terms and conditions of the contract, the designated payment office is not compelled to make payment by the specified due date.

- (b) Reimbursing costs. (1) For the purpose of reimbursing allowable costs (except as provided in subparagraph (b)(2) of the clause, with respect to pension, deferred profit sharing, and employee stock ownership plan contributions), the term "costs" includes only--
- (i) Those recorded costs that, at the time of the request for reimbursement, the Contractor has paid by cash, check, or other form of actual payment for items or services purchased directly for the contract;
- (ii) When the Contractor is not delinquent in paying costs of contract performance in the ordinary course of business, costs incurred, but not necessarily paid, for-
- (A) Supplies and services purchased directly for the contract and associated financing payments to subcontractors, provided payments determined due will be made-
- (1) In accordance with the terms and conditions of a subcontract or invoice; and
- (2) Ordinarily within 30 days of the submission of the Contractor's payment request to the Government;

- (B) Materials issued from the Contractor's inventory and placed in the production process for use on the contract;
- (C) Direct labor;
- (D) Direct travel;
- (E) Other direct in-house costs; and
- (F) Properly allocable and allowable indirect costs, as shown in the records maintained by the Contractor for purposes of obtaining reimbursement under Government contracts; and
- (iii) The amount of financing payments that have been paid by cash, check, or other forms of payment to subcontractors.
- (2) Accrued costs of Contractor contributions under employee pension plans shall be excluded until actually paid unless-
- (i) The Contractor's practice is to make contributions to the retirement fund quarterly or more frequently; and
- (ii) The contribution does not remain unpaid 30 days after the end of the applicable quarter or shorter payment period (any contribution remaining unpaid shall be excluded from the Contractor's indirect costs for payment purposes).
- (3) Notwithstanding the audit and adjustment of invoices or vouchers under paragraph (g) of this clause, allowable indirect costs under this contract shall be obtained by applying indirect cost rates established in accordance with paragraph (d) of this clause.
- (4) Any statements in specifications or other documents incorporated in this contract by reference designating performance of services or furnishing of materials at the Contractor's expense or at no cost to the Government shall be disregarded for purposes of cost-reimbursement under this clause.
- (c) Small business concerns. A small business concern may receive more frequent payments than every 2 weeks.
- (d) Final indirect cost rates. (1) Final annual indirect cost rates and the appropriate bases shall be established in accordance with Subpart 42.7 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) in effect for the period covered by the indirect cost rate proposal.
- (2)(i) The Contractor shall submit an adequate final indirect cost rate proposal to the Contracting Officer (or cognizant Federal agency official) and auditor within the 6-month period following the expiration of each of its fiscal years. The Contractor shall support its proposal with adequate supporting data.
- (ii) The proposed rates shall be based on the Contractor's actual cost experience for that period. The appropriate Government representative and the Contractor shall establish the final indirect cost rates as promptly as practical after receipt of the Contractor's proposal.
- (3) The Contractor and the appropriate Government representative shall execute a written understanding setting forth the final indirect cost rates. The understanding shall specify (i) the agreed-upon final annual indirect cost rates, (ii) the bases to which the rates apply, (iii) the periods for which the rates apply, (iv) any specific indirect cost items treated as direct costs in the settlement, and (v) the affected contract and/or subcontract, identifying any with advance agreements or special terms and the applicable rates. The understanding shall not change any monetary ceiling, contract obligation, or specific cost allowance or disallowance provided for in this contract. The understanding is incorporated into this contract upon execution.

- (4) Failure by the parties to agree on a final annual indirect cost rate shall be a dispute within the meaning of the Disputes clause.
- (5) Within 120 days (or longer period if approved in writing by the Contracting Officer) after settlement of the final annual indirect cost rates for all years of a physically complete contract, the Contractor shall submit a completion invoice or voucher to reflect the settled amounts and rates.
- (6)(i) If the Contractor fails to submit a completion invoice or voucher within the time specified in paragraph (d)(5) of this clause, the Contracting Officer may—
- (A) Determine the amounts due to the Contractor under the contract; and
- (B) Record this determination in a unilateral modification to the contract.
- (ii) This determination constitutes the final decision of the Contracting Officer in accordance with the Disputes clause.
- (e) Billing rates. Until final annual indirect cost rates are established for any period, the Government shall reimburse the Contractor at billing rates established by the Contracting Officer or by an authorized representative (the cognizant auditor), subject to adjustment when the final rates are established. These billing rates—
- (1) Shall be the anticipated final rates; and
- (2) May be prospectively or retroactively revised by mutual agreement, at either party's request, to prevent substantial overpayment or underpayment.
