

### Section C - Descriptions and Specifications

## CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY FULL TEXT

### C-1 General

This contract is for "Unclassified" Information Technology (IT) Support and Services in support of the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA). The focus of the work requirements is to provide DARPA with the required information technology support services that will allow DARPA to focus on its mission of technology research and development. This will include, but not be limited to: hardware and software deployments, reliable network and security, anytime/anyplace computing, and efficient and knowledgeable help desk resources.

## C-2 Scope of Work

- (a) The Contractor shall furnish the necessary personnel, materials, facilities services and supplies, as may be specifically ordered by the Government via the issuance of individual Task Orders under this contract, in accordance with the general Statement of Work, Attachment 1 hereto, and the contractor's proposal received in response to solicitation HR0011-05-R-0001 dated 31 OCT 2005, copies of which are in possession of the parties. Specific instructions, as may be necessary, will be included in any such Task Order issued under this contract.
- (b) In addition to the requirements delineated in the government's solicitation and corresponding Statement of Work (SOW), included as Attachment 1 to the contract herein, the contractor has agreed to provide and the government agrees to accept, at no additional cost to this contract, the following additional offerings, which are specifically reiterated herein and emphasized for point of reference:
- 1. The contractor will open its existing Information Technology (IT) testbed environment to DARPA, fund its initial expansion, and continually finance pilot projects and infrastructure modernization efforts by investing 10% of the program's total award fee. This could equate to an investment of over \$1,000,000.
- 2. The contractor will provide monitoring, maintenance, and support for network devices, including routers, switches and firewalls on the HPC.ORG network within the managed services model.
- 3. Upon DARPA's approval, the contractor will fund any extensions to the currently identified DARPA enclave, via secure VPN, and provide direct support to and from any additional leased space funded by the contractor.
- 4. The contractor will provide all required software/hardware to pilot test and deploy SEM/SIM, Enterprise Project Management, Network Management Solution, Quarantine, Unified Messaging, and/or Tower Trim Context Solution. No additional funding will be required from DARPA via any of the Expert Assistance CLINS delineated in the contract.
- 5. The contractor will proactively communicate with its customers any time that there is a change to their IT services. The contractor will implement an on-line Voice of the Customer (VOC) tool to introduce a new forum for DARPA staff to convey their issues, concerns, and recommendations as well as develop a defined process in order to identify and address customer concerns and requests before they escalate into larger issues. The Remedy Information Technology Services Management (ITSM) tool will be leveraged to implement, track, and address an action plan for each concern from the initial request through resolution to the customer's satisfaction. The VOC database will integrate with an online dashboard to easily identify pending issues, due dates, trends, closure, and updates, and will provide DARPA with real-time data-feed on customer issues.

- 6. The contractors server approach ensure a reliable and secure enterprise infrastructure, including the following benefits:
  - a) Introduction of email performance monitoring tools will address Exhange issues before or as they occur and will provide a live data feed into the network dashboard for immediate visibility by DARPA's Information Resources Directorate (IRD).
  - b) Introduction of a Web-enabled password management tool will enable customers to change passwords via a Web page and provide a database backend to manage and track changes.
  - c) Building on SMS 2003 for remote software distribution, to include security patches and software upgrades; 1e.com's SMS Patch Management Pack tool increases the success of critical patch rollouts to almost 100% (for direct connect systems).
  - d) Deployment of Live Communications Server 2005 will deliver Internal Instant Messaging.
- The contractors help desk/desk-side support focuses on customer care and customer confidence, including the following benefits:
  - a) The Help Desk analyst to customer ratio is 1:34 which exceeds the industry standard of 1:75.
  - b) Introduction of a Service Delivery Manager provides management oversight, trend analysis, and ongoing improvement of the customer delivery process.
  - c) Implementing remote monitoring tools for Conference Room and Printer Seats from the Help Desk and Network Operation Center (NOC) ensures proactive service maintenance.
- 8. The contractors toolset and innovative services will enhance user productivity, which include the following benefits:
  - a) Configuration Management Database (CMDB) tool to identify, control, maintain, and verify configuration items (CIs) within within the DARPA environment.
  - b) Configuration Management Tracking Tool (CMTT) for automated CM voting and status.
  - c) Security Information/Event Manager for security event recording, correlation, and network dashboard display.
- 9. Based on an analysis and understanding of DARPA's needs, the contractor will further expand the Service Delivery Point (SDP) hardware and software services. These include MS Front Page for Web authoring, Adobe Acrobat Professional for .PDF creation and editing, MS Project Standard for project management, StorActive solution for live backups on all DARPA data seats, Google Desktop Enterprise for enhanced desktop and email search capabilities, new TabletPC and 17" LCD desktop replacement offerings, two Wireless PDA model alternatives, and a digital printing press PSDP option as a high-end graphics printing solution.
- 10. The contractor will integrate ITIL-compliant Remedy ITSM sutie with Atrium BMC Configuration Management Database (CMDB) as an intelligent repository that creates and maintains a single, consistent model across the DARPA IT environment shared across the ITSM applications. In addition, the CMDB provides real-time audited inventory reporting to the Government for strategic, financial, and management insight into the disposition of SDPs.

- 11. The contractors Portable and Fixed Data Seat suites will support end user productivity by including the following:
  - a) Encrypted hard drives on PC portable workstations for data protection
  - b) SmartCard technology on portable and fixed data seats
  - c) Integration of latest network security technologies (anti-virus, spyware, Microsoft Bulletins, Active X)
  - d) Enterprise implementation of StorActive to include all DARPA contractors
  - e) USB Hubs/optical mice/port replicators for computing requirements
  - f) Portable Data Seat biometrics (fingerprint reader), with evaluation of biometrics on a fixed data seat
  - g) Built-in wireless technology on PC laptops for external DARPA use
  - h) Portable seat options to desktop replacement with 17" LCD screen and TabletPCs
  - i) 24 X 7 X 365 On-site and remote access to all DARPA network services
  - i) MacIntosh platforms are supported and maintained
  - k) Integration of latest network security technologies (anti-virus, spy-ware, Microsoft Bulletins, Active X)
  - 1) Contractor provided USB Hubs/optical mice/port replicators for computing requirements
  - m) Kiosk systems for shared usage; process to manage multiple user accounts
  - n) Dual PC and MacIntosh platforms are integrated and supported securely
- 12. The contractor will provide DARPA full continuity of conference room seat services by including the following:
  - a) Enhanced VTC and Conference Room support for senior DARPA Management to include Directors and Deputy Directors
  - b) Ceiling-mounted digital multimedia projector support
  - c) HPC.org network connections are installed and labeled in conference rooms to support external user demonstrations and performer operations
  - d) DMSS network connections labeled for security
  - e) Loaner portable digital multimedia projectors on request
  - f) Conference Room/VTC instructions
  - g) Contractor-provided Operator Services to include off hour support
  - h) User training on VTC set up
  - i) Installation and maintenance of IT equipment to include projector, video recorder, DVD, stereo sound

system, and network connectivity

- 13. Proposed new offerings to the conference room seats include large plasma screen monitor technology; interactive whiteboard; VTC Single Bridge; and remote monitoring of Conference Room technologies, projector and VTC units, and use of diagnostic tools.
- 14. The contractor will integrate monitoring of the HPC.org network with the network dashboard.
- 15. The contractor will improve upon the existing DARPA Intranet by transitioning into an Enterprise Portal environment that provides tighter integration with the Microsoft Office Suite and greater collaboration capabilities. The contractor will also improve upon the base implementation to deploy improved search, Web crawling, and workflow management capabilities as well as custom developed Web parts to extend functionality of SharePoint and address DARPA specific requirements. An updated Web services enabled development environment will also be provided to the DARPA Web Development Team to reduce the time to market for Web development efforts and facilitate improved integration of applications.
- 16. The contractor will build upon the extranet infrastructure and harden authentication to the extranet environment through use of Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) and will provide a secure environment for the development and implementation of custom Web Applications. In addition, the contractor will provide increased support for DARPA external partners facilitating greater collaboration and improved productivity.
- 17. The contractor will deploy 1e.com's SMS Patch Management Pack tool. The SMS Patch Management Pack increases the success of critical patch rollouts to almost 100% (for systems directly connected to the DMSS). The contractors software distribution trending reflects that approximately 25% of DARPA machines are in a powered-off state at the time critical patches are deployed. With approval from DARPA, the contractor will leverage SMSWakeUp to remotely power-on DMSS fixed data seats to receive the incoming critical patch.
- 18. The innovative online training system, Thomson Netg INTERACTIVE-Distance Learning, a fully Section 508C-compliant application, is available 24X7 from any Internet connection with an established DARPA account.
- The contractor will replace the existing shared file services solution with a Network Appliance FAS3020 clustered Network Attached Storage (NAS) device.
- 20. Effective analysis of trending data on file server disk utilization has permitted the contractor to provide disk capacity that has always stayed ahead of customer demands. The contractor will continue this practice and make file utilization statistics continuously available on the Executive Dashboard.
- 21. The contractor is fully prepared to support and exceed expectations with respect to retention of DARPA electronic records by facilitating an enterprise implementation of the TRIM Context tool currently used by the DARPA/Facilities Administration Directorate (FAD) Records Management and Comptroller organizations. DARPA will be able to leverage TRIM as a preferred tool for secure electronic maintenance and tracking of critical DARPA data.
- 22. The contractor will upgrade the Remedy ITSM to version 6.0. Integration of real-time customer support data feeds into the Executive Dashboard will dramatically enhance DARPAs insight into customer service trends, issues, and resolution.
- 23. The contractor recognizes the critical significance of a secure, stable, and highly functional network communications infrastructure. The contractors successful deployment of latest generation access and collapsed core switch infrastruture supports a secure media converged infrastructure for Voice-over-IP

ready capability, Unified Messaging, and VTC improvements. This deployment places DARPA at a point to take advantage of Ipv6 (Internet Protocol Version 6) security, including data integrity and privacy features.

- 24. The contractor will deploy network management solution, AI Metrix NeuralStar, which overlays a common logical layer across the DMSS network's many devices providing a single point of monitoring and control for the entire network. An additional component of our network management solution is network health product, CA eHealth Monitor, which will allow the contractor to proactively maintain critical SLOs. These Commercial-off-the-Shelf (COTS) tools entail trending solutions that will convert existing customized legacyy solutions to provide enhanced data correlation points. Furthermore, the contractor will integrate the network monitoring components of the Security Information Manager/Security Event Manager (SIM/SEM) to provide pre-correlation of events and near real-time feeds for government awareness and oversight. The contractor is dedicated to successfully deploying this solution with a concise, agreed-upon end-state.
- 25. The contractor will implement an innovative backup methodology to replace the current tape backup structure. This is a fundmentally different approach to backing up data by executing a backup directly to an off-site location over an encrypted link. Backup of only changed data will directly result in less impact on server platforms and enable increased flexibility for data backup during the business day. Physical delivery of off-site tapes are no longer required and can be executed directly by the Help Desk correlating to an increased responsiveness to customer data restoration needs.
- 26. The contractor will continue to manage the DARPA network address space and will provide redundant DNS resolution services on the unclassified network for both internal and external customers.
- 27. The contractor agrees to provide additional custom reports within each functional area, other than those listed in the contractor's Technical Proposal, Exhibit 3-23, as required by DARPA.
- 28. The contractor will implement a Quarantine Solution to defend against network attacks. Network attacks take advantage of systems that are vulnerable and without defense. Any system without the latest patches or virus signatures poses a greater risk to DARPA. Through the deployment of a quarantine solution, the contractor will drastically reduce computing threats in the DARPA enclave. A quarantine solution has the ability to check for current patches and virus signatures prior to connection to the DARPA network. Systems that do not meet the minimum requirement for connectivity can be quarantined until the system is successfully remedied.
- 29. In the event of a network security threat or attack, the contractor will proactively support DARPA's threat response activities by providing the data, forensic analysis, and subject matter expertise to adquately prevent and mitigate the incident.

The contractor will leverage its proven methodology to transition Expert Assistance services to basic services.
- 36. The contractor will introduce Atrium BMC Configuration Management Database (CMDB) as the intelligent repository to create and maintain a single, consistent model across the DARPA IT environment and shared across the ITSM applications.
- 37. The contractor will deploy an integrated CMDM/ITSM toolset. Integration of an automated Configuration Management Tracking Took (CMTT) to facilitate the voting and real-time approval status of CI within the CCBWG, GWG and CCB is a critical element to increase the productivity and collaboration during the CM review and approval process.
- 38. The contractor will work with DARPA to capture and define the requirements and to streamline the IT Governance voting process via the automated CMTT resulting in increased efficiencies in approval time and rapid delivery to the end user. The contractor will incorporate the IT Governance group in the CMTT product development and pilot testing process to ensure the right technical solution is provided to DARPA. User training and Web-based FAQs will be provided to ensure that the CMTT is used to its fullest extent.

- 39. The contractor will ensure that customer trend analyses will also be fed into its Quality Assurance (QA) process and organization. The contractors QA manager, will seek to identify root causes, mitigate, and subsequently eliminate any negative customer service trends, while ensuring that the contractor adheres to all baseline SLO target values.
- 40. The contractor agrees to adhere to the initial contract transition Service Level Objectives identified in Section 3.8.3.3 of its Technical Proposal.

Request for such travel must be submitted to the Contracting Officer at least forty-five (45) days in advance of traveler's anticipated departure date, and shall include traveler's itinerary of United States Flag Air Carriers.
- H-9 Government Furnished Property/Facilities and Services
  - (a) The Government will provide floor space to the Contractor as detailed in the Statement of Work Section 1.1 Background.
  - (b) The Government will furnish each individual assigned to tasks under the contract proper identification (access badge) to allow entry to and departure from Government facilities.
  - (c) The Government will furnish workspace and equipment (e.g., furniture, equipment, and telephone services) suitable for the performance of the contract to Government on-site Contractor personnel.
  - (d) The Government will not be responsible for providing the Contractor with cellular phones and/or Blackberry devices, nor for providing those devices subscription services. The Contractor shall provide its personnel with communication systems that provide seamless interface with the systems at DARPA.
  - (e) The Government will provide the Contractor with all existing engineering drawings and configuration documentation as Government-Furnished Information (GFI). The Government will retain ownership of all GFI provided to the Contractor, and will assume ownership of all documentation and deliverables submitted to the Government by the Contractor in performance of the contract.
- H-10 Proprietary Technical Data and Computer Software
  - (a) Any deliverable technical data or computer software developed or generated at private expense and considered to be proprietary by the Contractor or Subcontractors in the performance of this contract shall be delivered in accordance with DFARS 252.227-7013 and 252.227-7014.
- H-11 Accommodation / Accessibility For The Disabled
  - (a) The Contractor shall comply with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended 29 U.S.C. § 794 (d) and the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 48 CFR Parts 2, 7, 10, 11, 12, and 39 [FAC 97-27; FAR Case 1999-607].
- H-12 Earned Value Management
  - (a) The Contractor shall use an Earned Value Management System and process for Cost Plus and Cost Plus Award Fee (time and materials project-based) work in accordance with OMB, ANSI / EIA-748-A and other applicable regulations throughout the life of the contract. This process shall result in monthly reports by project reflecting expenditures for the Budget Cost of Work Performed, Actual Cost of Work Performed and Actual Cost of Work Scheduled. The Contractor shall provide a plan to implement an Earned Value Management System five (5) days after award and must implement the system within 90 days after award.
- H-13 Security Requirements
  - (a) All Contractor employees must be U.S. citizens with a minimum of an interim SECRET clearance. DARPA will perform a local background check on all Contractor employees. Compliance with

- Department of Defense (DoD) personnel security provisions (most notably DoD 5200.2-R and DoD Directive 8500.1) concerning clearance actions prior to commencing work, is required.
- (b) The Contractor shall safeguard classified project material in accordance with GSA ADM P 1025.2C, Information Security Program. Additionally, the Contractor shall safeguard all data and information in accordance with all applicable DARPA and DoD policies and Instructions. Refer to the attached (Section J Attachment 4) DD Form 254 for additional guidance.
- (c) Contractor personnel may become aware of data pertaining to contractors or services relating to or residing on systems utilized by DARPA. Contractor personnel shall not obtain, divulge, or use this data for any purposes other than to support DARPA. Under no circumstances shall Contractor personnel use this information for personal or Contractor gain. Data the Contractor produces as a result of this effort shall become the property of the Government and the Contractor shall protect this data at the appropriate security level and sensitivity identified.

# H-14 Termination - Supplemental Provision

- (a) Upon contract cancellation or expiration, contractors shall provide a written transition-out / exit plan ninety (90) days prior to the anticipated ending date. The Contractor shall work with the successor Contractor in developing a project plan for transferring all Contractor performance services; Government owned assets, documentation, information and data.
- (b) The Contractor shall continue to update this plan as necessary until all services have been successfully transitioned to the new service provider.

# H-15 Removal From Project Access

- (a) When employees are removed from positions, for any reason, the Contractor shall:
  - (1) Revoke all access authorizations
  - (2) Retrieve all specific keys and badges
  - (3) Change the combinations on all locks to which the employee had access
  - (4) Review the employee's obligations to the organization
  - (5) Notify appropriate DARPA security officials of the removal action.
- (b) For all access terminations, the Contractor shall:
  - (1) Follow the Checklist for Employee Termination
  - (2) Assure that the departing employee either completes all assigned tasks or briefs the replacement on the requirements and status of ongoing tasks
  - (3) Determine the employee's access termination date
  - (4) Immediately notify the assigned SID Systems Manager(s) if access termination is for cause and request an immediate revocation of access
  - (5) Complete the Manager's Checklist for Employee Termination and forward the checklist to the Project Manager
  - (6) Review with employee their obligation to protect related data
  - (7) Assure that the employee completes the Access Termination Statement.
- (c) The Project Manager shall:
  - (1) Notify DARPA [with emphasis on notifying the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) first] of the access termination action on the employee
  - (2) Notify the assigned SID Systems Managers of the access termination date.

## 52.216-18 ORDERING. (OCT 1995)

- (a) Any supplies and services to be furnished under this contract shall be ordered by issuance of delivery orders or task orders by the individuals or activities designated in the Schedule. Such orders may be issued from April 3, 2006 through March 31 2011, if and to the extent that any such options delineated in the contract are exercised by the Government.
- (b) All delivery orders or task orders are subject to the terms and conditions of this contract. In the event of conflict between a delivery order or task order and this contract, the contract shall control.
- (c) If mailed, a delivery order or task order is considered "issued" when the Government deposits the order in the mail. Orders may be issued orally, by facsimile, or by electronic commerce methods only if authorized in the Schedule.
