Section 1 INTRODUCTION

1.0 Background

WHS is a Department of Defense (DoD) Field Activity and is comprised of eleven Directorates. ITMD is the Directorate responsible for providing IT services to WHS and other Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) offices. In an effort to ensure business continuity and protection of mission critical data, WHS requires an offsite data storage and transportation solution for disaster recovery tapes.

1.1 Purpose

To transport WHS's disaster recovery tapes to a secure offsite data storage area to ensure protection of mission critical data required during a disaster recovery.

1.2 Requirement

The services required are the transport of Washington Headquarters Services' disaster recovery tapes to a secure off-site data storage facility, ensuring the overall protection of mission critical data, and transport to a government emergency remote location when requested.

Section 2 SCOPE OF WORK

- **2.** All functions must be performed to the standards set forth in this contract. The contractor shall execute activities and tasks consistent with the performance description station in section V "Performance Requirement Summary" of the Performance Work Statement.
- **2.1** The objective is to implement a solution that reduces the level of effort required by WHS system administrators in offsite data storage and transportation. Improve the access control levels and media tracking to ensure that data's integrity is maintained. Provide secure, timely and reliable offsite data storage and transportation while achieving maximum cost-effectiveness.

Section 3 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

- 3.1 Capable of storing and transporting classified information.
- **3.2** Transport and storage of approximately three hundred fifty (350) SDLT, twenty (20) AIT-3, and five hundred (500) 3490E/3590 tapes total for five (5) locations. The quantity of tapes is an estimated; accual number of tapes will increase or decrease based on the data and capacity of tapes being used by the government.

3.3 Weekly pickup and delivery off of disaster recovery tapes from the following mailing addresses during normal business hours (0800-1600).

- **3.4** Provide unscheduled, emergency pickup, and/or delivery at the client's request 24 hours a day, 365 days a year within a two (2) hour period.
- 3.5 Contractor shall provide an unmarked driver, vehicle, and storage facility.
- **3.6** Contractor is required to sign a Nondisclosure Agreement (NDA) and return to client prior to task starting date.
- 3.7 Contractor must have data reconstruction insurance to cover potential data loss or damage during transit and storage.
- **3.8** Photo identification badges, issued to client, to ensure only authorized personnel have access to send and or receive tapes.
- **3.9** Multiple levels of authorized access controls that grant specific access or rights to tapes and services for client personnel based on functions and need identified by client.
- 3.10 A remote interface tool to manage and track tapes during storage and transport.
- **3.11** Barcode scanning software and equipment compatible with Windows 2000/XP operating systems.
- **3.12** Classified information must be stored in a GSA approved container meeting the requirements of Federal Specification AA-V-2737 (See 12.2 Reference Documents item 5).

- **3.13** Environmental controls and fire suppression must be provided during transport and while stored in vault.

10.0 Quality Control

- **10.1** The contractor shall implement a comprehensive quality control plan to be submitted with proposal to ensure timely and effective accomplishment of tasks required by this PWS, and that deliverables are acceptable.
- **10.2** The government's quality assurnace and inspection plans are described in Sectin 5.1, in the performance requirements matrix. The government shall randomly inspect contractor's transport vechilcle and place of storage.
- **10.3** Acceptance of data tapes shall be at a government location.

12.0 The period of performance shall be one (1) base year, starting from the award date with four (4) option years, to be exercised at the Government's discretion.

Section 13 STAFFING

13.0 The contractor shall provide all qualified personnel necessary to accomplish the tasks required in the work performance for a fixed price per month.


