Using on-site government furnished support equipment (e.g., ladders, scaffolding, etc, as needed for equipment access) the contractor shall manage Operation and Maintenance (O&M) facilities support systems associated with (b)(3):10 U.S.C. § 130;(b)(7)(E)

The Contractor shall ensure all correspondence, reports, plans, processes and contract related data are in electronic format. The Contractor shall ensure that plans and processes generated do not contain Contractor's logo or name and shall not be Contractor specific unless specifically required by regulations and shall be suitable for follow-on contract use. All data and documents generated by the Contractor under this contract are Customer property. The Contractor shall archive electronic copies of all plans and processes. The Contractor shall ensure all requisite hard copy (signatures etc.) are followed with an electronic copy.

The Contractor shall ensure facility preventive/predictive maintenance are scheduled and tracked through completion. Schedule periodic inspection, servicing and repair to fire sprinkler and standpipe systems, gas suppressions systems, fire detection alarm and related systems and inspection, service repair or replacement of portable fire extinguishers.

The Contractor shall submit service requests (332) for any facility maintenance requirements in (b)(3):10 U.S.C. § 130;(b)(7)(E) This includes submission, maintaining a complete listing of all open and closed service requests, and maintaining the status of all open service requests.
