



- 3. Its night time in Yemen currently, so it's likely that we will not have a decision until sometime tomorrow.
- 4. I am leaving the Pentagon and heading home since I don't think that I can do anything constructive at this point. If the Yemenis change their minds about accepting the body, I will notify the OSD LNO in the NMCC. I trust that they will disseminate the information to the appropriate parties.
