All,

Since most of us are going to be participating in the World Wide Detainee Policy Conference at the end of November, I thought that we might take the opportunity to also have an extended DMO side-bar while we are all gathered at USSOUTHCOM. I anticipate that our little meeting would run from Thursday afternoon into Friday.

Given the amount of DMO, or more specifically DHRMO, activity in recent months I believe that this is a timely area of focus.

I first wanted to get thoughts on whether or not you believe that such a conference would be helpful, and then to get your input on a possible agenda if you are interested in moving forward with a meeting.

Below are a few possible agenda items, arranged in no particular order. That said, this list is far from exhaustive.

1. Introduce new DMO team members
2. Hot wash DHRMO (b)(6) specifically looking for lessons learned and capabilities necessary to carry out similar missions
3. Draft and review a DHRMO EXORD
4. Review the DMO process and ensure that all players are aware of TTP and responsibilities (I'm not sure what would be the most helpful level for this review. I think that we can do everything from a strategic assessment to rock drill and everything in between)
5. Draft and review a DMO EXORD
6. Review all recourses and capabilities available to conduct DMOs/DHRMOs to ensure that we are building the most efficient plan possible
7. Identify any policy or guidance gaps and possible solutions
