- e. Letter of non-contagious disease from local health authority
- f. Funeral home letter stating: 1) only remains are inside the casket; 2)Flight itinerary; 3)Consignee's name, address and telephone.
- g. Hermetically sealed casket
- h. All wood outer shipping container

2. Is there an DoD waiver or DOS agreement with Yemen that precludes compliance with the Shipping Requirements/Rules for entry of remains into Yemen?
