### INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

On 2 Aug 04, this office received Request for Information (RFI) 0367-04-CID001 from the United States Army Criminal Investigation Command, 6010 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Belvoir, VA 22060 (USACIDC), which requested this office investigate allegations Mr. was assaulted by a black, male soldier.

Investigation determined there was insufficient evidence to prove or disprove Mr. allegations that he was abused by U.S. Forces during his interrogation. Mr. alleged a black male wearing a desert combat uniform (DCU) (NFI) who interrogated him, stepped and ground his foot on a previous gunshot wound to his left thigh.

Coordination with MAJ 800<sup>th</sup> Military Police Brigade, Sugar Notch United States Army Reserve Center, 140 Stewart Road, Asley, PA 18706,

revealed if Mr. Man and been initially in processed at Camp Cropper, IZ, the assigned Internment Serial Number (ISN), would be different or linked to the current ISN. A query of Mr. Man and detainee file revealed no additional ISN for Mr.

Coordination with 3/505<sup>th</sup> Parachute Infantry Regiment (PIR) and 1/505<sup>th</sup> PIR revealed Iraqi detainees were never interrogated at the Forward Operating Base (FOB), but were instead sent to the Baghdad Central Confinement Facility for intelligence exploitation.

Coordination with the 313<sup>th</sup> Military Intelligence Battalion revealed only biographical questioning was conducted on detainees while they were in the custody of the 1/505<sup>th</sup> and 3/505<sup>th</sup> PIR. They stated no interrogations were conducted at the unknown facility alleged by Mr.

Further investigation revealed there was insufficient evidence to prove or disprove Mr. allegations as previously documented. Mr. was released from confinement before the allegations were reported to USACIDC, therefore an interview by USACIDC of Mr. was never conducted. Further, no medical records pertaining to Mr. were located in Iraq or the detainee medical records archives in Fort Sam Houston, Texas. No witnesses or possible suspects were able to be identified as a result of poor detainee file documentation. Due to the danger in locating and interviewing Mr. and other possible Iraqi witnesses, the interviews were not conducted. The investigation did not diminish the integrity or credibility of Mr. allegation.
