(U)CLASSIFIED RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS AND BASIS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW BOARD DECISION FOR ISN 015

1. (U) Introduction

(U) The Administrative Review Board (ARB) determined ISN 015 continues to be a threat to the United States and its allies. In reaching this determination, the ARB considered both classified and unclassified information. The following is an account of the proceedings and the factors the ARB used in making its determination.

2. (U) Synspsis of Proceedings

(U) The Enemy Combatant (EC) chose to attend and consequently the board was convened with the Enemy Combatant (EC) present. The Designated Military Officer (DMO) presented the unclassified summary, both in a written form and with an oral summary of the unclassified primary factors.

(U) The Assisting Military Officer (AMO) presented the Enemy Combatant Notification as Exhibit EC-A, identified herein as Enclosure (2). The AMO then presented the Enemy Combatant Election Form as Exhibit EC-B, identified herein as Enclosure (3). Exhibit EC-B indicated that the EC chose to participate. The EC responded verbally to each allegation/statement in the Unclassified Summary. His comments consisted of a line-by-line confirmation or denial of the bullets in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the unclassified summary. The EC answered a series of questions from the ARB, as documented in Enclosure (5), regarding his personal knowledge of known al Qaida members or leaders with whom he is reported to have associated and his participation against United States and allied forces during the hostilities in Afghanistan. The Board also inquired about the circumstances of his arrest.

(U) During the ARB, the EC claimed Pakistani soldiers abused him when he was in Pakistan. The EC's allegations are documented in Enclosure (5) and paragraph 4.h of this report.

(U) The Board queried the DMO on details surrounding the EC's capture, and the AMO concerning the EC's behavior and willingness to cooperate during notification.

(U) The unclassified portion of the proceeding was adjourned. The ARB moved to the classified session and the DMO presented the classified summary. The ARB panel members reviewed the classified exhibits, asked the DMO and AMO several questions that were answered satisfactorily and the session was then closed for deliberation.

(U) The Administrative Review Board (ARB) determined ISN 060 continues to be a threat to the United States and its allies. In reaching this determination, the ARB considered both classified and unclassified information. The following is an account of the proceedings and the factors the ARB used in making its determination.

2. (U) Synopsis of Proceedings

(U) The ARB was convened and began its proceedings with the Enemy Combatant (EC) present. The Designated Military Officer (DMO) presented the unclassified summary, both in written form and with an oral summary of the unclassified primary factors. The Assisting Military Officer (AMO) presented the Enemy Combatant Notification as Exhibit EC-A, the Enemy Combatant Election Form indicating the EC elected to participate, documented as Exhibit EC-B and a written statement submitted by a lawyer on behalf of the EC as Enclosure (4), Exhibit EC-B and a written statement submitted by a lawyer on behalf of the EC as Enclosure (4), Exhibit EC-C. The EC made a verbal statement addressing each of the factors cited in the unclassified summary, repeatedly asserting that he wanted to understand how he could address the factors in the classified summary if he was unable to view them. The EC thoroughly suswared a large number of questions from the AMO, DMO, and ARB members, as documented in Enclosure (6). The unclassified part of the proceeding was adjourned. The ARB moved to the classified portion of the session and the DMO presented the classified summary. The ARB members had no questions during the classified portion of the ARB. The session was then closed for deliberation.
