Date/Place: 18 Sep 03/Camp Delta (b)(2) GTMO, Cuba

On 18 September 2003, ALI ABDULLAH ((AHMED)), Internment Serial Number (ISN) (b)(2) -00693DP, was interviewed at Camp Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, by (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) Contract linguist (b)(3) (b)(6) provided Arabic/English translation.

AHMED was interviewed regarding his activities and the activities of other associates prior to his capture at the (b)(1). AHMED was not cooperative throughout most of the interview but did provide some information for clarification. AHMED spoke basic English which he learn in Yemen while attending school.

AHMED was asked what nationality he claimed; he stated he was Yemeni and that his family was from Yemen. He was asked if he had any family in Saudi Arabia; he said no. AHMED denied having a cousin from Saudi Arabia; denied ever knowing (b)(6) and denied ever being in Kandahar, AF. AHMED stated he went to Pakistan to study the Koran and was not involved with the Taliban or Al Qaeda. He said he was innocent and was here by mistake. If released, he would go back to Yemen.

Finally, AHMED was asked if he ever stayed at the (b)(1) to which he said no. After numerous attempts to restart a conversation with AHMED utilizing several interrogation techniques, the interview was terminated.
