

I met with the patient on the block in the presence of an interpreter, Senior Medical Officer (SMO) and the Nurse assigned to (b)(2)

He has been identified as a hunger striker and is now receiving optimal nutrition. His reason for hunger strike was because he has been detained for 4 years and he wants to go home.

I explained that it would be better to eat his meals but if he does not eat and drink he may have hunger, nausea, fatigue, malaise, headaches, edema, muscle loss, abdominal pain, chest pain, cardiac dysrhythmias, altered level of consciousness, and coma. Some of these may cause permanent damage to his brain and body. I also explained that my Detention Hospital staff's goal was to provide humane medical care and to preserve life and that this includes the provision of involuntary feeding for those whose health and life is at risk. The intent of the medical staff to safely and effectively maximize nutrition and hydration. The detainee was advised that continued hunger striking is hazardous to his health.

I explained that exercising would help increase range of motion and strengthen muscles. Exercising can be accomplished in the cell or during recreational time.

I explained that recent weight trends for the patient were encouraging. He is highly encouraged to eat. He understands that refusal to eat life-sustaining food or drink water/fluids and to follow medical advice may cause irreparable harm to him self or lead to his death. His weight today was 140.7 pounds (22 BMI).

He spoke clearly and coherently. He admits to drinking water but will continue to refuse food. Detainee appears to be well hydrated. His condition is good.


