SUBJECT: Crisis Coordination Group for the Utah Winter Olympics 2002


Under the provisions of PDD-62, the Attorney General and the Secretary of the Treasury have designated the Utah Winter Olympic Games of 2002 as a National Special Security Event (NSSE). The Counterterrorism Security Group (CSG), as established within PDD-62, will assume lead responsibility for the coordination and deconfliction of federal planning for terrorist incident response and consequence management of any terrorist incident, to include any threats or use of Weapons of Mass Destruction.

The 50th Commemorative Summit of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, last May, was our most recent NSSE. One of the lessons that we learned in our preparations for that event is that the DOD Crisis Coordination Group (CCG), as called for within DODD 3025.15, is an excellent coordination mechanism. Furthermore, our key Federal partners, such as the FBI, Secret Service, and FEMA, are familiar with the CCG and its processes. All now understand that requests for assistance in response to (or contingency preparations for) acts or threats of domestic terrorism must be approved by the Secretary of Defense. With this in mind I would like to convene an initial meeting of the DOD CCG for the 2002 Olympics on October 6, 1999, from 1530 - 1700 in the OSD Conference Room complex (1E801) Room # 4.

I have two fundamental objectives for this kick-off meeting. First and foremost, I want to ensure that all key offices within the Department have a clear understanding of all that has occurred to date regarding our preparations for Olympics support. Much has already occurred, particularly with regards to preliminary planning being conducted by the Army's Directorate of Military Support. With this objective in mind, I ask that the Army be prepared to provide a presentation on all preliminary activities that have occurred to date as well as any conferences, meetings, or visits that are projected. This briefing should also include any requirements that have been identified at this point by either the Olympic Organizing Committee, state or local officials of Utah to include the State Adjutant General, and other federal partners.

Secondly, I desire to achieve consensus on the road ahead. We will establish the legal, fiscal, and public affairs framework by which the Department will approach this effort. As a result of the Atlanta Olympics of 1996, for example, Congress enacted restrictions on the type of support that may be provided by the Department. All of us must clearly understand what is permitted and under what criteria. Additionally, as we enter the FY01 budget process, I believe it important that the Comptroller be integrally involved in order to provide fiscal guidance at the outset of our planning. Lastly, I want to ensure that our public affairs guidance on this matter is developed and approved as soon as possible in order that the Department can speak with one consistent voice throughout the process leading up to the Winter Olympics of 2002 and during their conduct.

The proposed agenda for the meeting is attached for your review and comment. Please send a representative of your staff to the meeting and provide us with any comments regarding the attached agenda. The OASD(SO/LIC) CTP&S point of contact for this action is MAJ(P) at .
