**PURPOSE AND ATTENDEES**

- (U) CINCPAC sponsored a 21 January meeting of DoD representatives to establish a prioritized list of US security/military confidence-building measures for the Korean Peninsula. This preliminary list, after higher-level review and approval, would serve as one foundation for our opening Four Party negotiating position.
- (U) Key participants included BrigGen Moseley, Deputy Director for Political-Military Affairs-Asia, J-5, Joint Staff (Chairman); MajGen Hayden, Deputy Chief of Staff, USFK; RADM Wright, Director, Asian and Pacific Affairs, OSD/ISA; BrigGen Hess, Deputy J-5, CINCPAC.




