1. ~~(S/REL)~~ DOS HAS REQUESTED THAT THE DOD PROVIDE EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO TRANSPORT
TCNS FROM TUNISIA TO EGYPT. MORE THAN 90,000 PEOPLE HAVE CROSSED THE TUNISIAN BORDER
SINCE 19 FEBRUARY, INCLUDING AT LEAST 25,000 EGYPTIAN NATIONALS. THE RATE OF OUTFLOW

4.A. (U) AIRLIFT MOVEMENT PRIORITY IS 1A3.

4.B. (U) KNOWN LOGISTICS CONSTRAINTS. SUPPORTING COMBATANT COMMANDERS WILL IDENTIFY CONSTRAINTS TO THE JOINT STAFF.

4.C. ~~(S/REL)~~ CLASSIFICATION AND GUIDANCE. SECRET//REL TO USA, AUS, CAN, FRA, DEU, ITA AND GBR. OPSEC SHOULD BE OBSERVED DURING EXECUTION TO PREVENT DISCLOSURE OF CAPABILITIES AND INTENT.

4.D. (U) PUBLIC AFFAIRS (PA). PUBLIC AFFAIRS POSTURE IS ACTIVE UPON PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT OF EVACUATION MISSION. THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT IS APPROVED FOR RELEASE IN RESPONSE TO QUERY. (QUOTE) AS PART OF AN INTERNATIONAL EFFORT TO ASSIST IN THE EVACUATION OF PERSONS FLEEING LIBYA, THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE HAS BEEN DIRECTED BY THE PRESIDENT TO USE U.S. MILITARY AIRCRAFT AS NEEDED TO HELP MOVE EGYPTIANS WHO HAVE FLED TO THE TUNISIAN BORDER GET BACK HOME TO EGYPT. THE DEPARTMENT WILL CONTINUE TO WORK IN CLOSE COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE AND OTHER AGENCIES AS NEEDED.(END QUOTE)

4.D.3. (U) EMBEDDED MEDIA COVERAGE IS ENCOURAGED.//

4.E. (U) FUNDING:

4.E.1. (U) IN ACCORDANCE WITH REF G, SECDEF AUTHORIZED AN INITIAL ALLOCATION OF \$37.6M IN ODHACA FUNDING TO THE CDRUSAFRICOM, OR HIS DESIGNEES. ADDITIONAL ALLOCATIONS OF ODHACA FUNDING WILL BE PROVIDED SEPCOR. USAFRICOM WILL MONITOR EXPENDITURES CAREFULLY TO AVOID EXCEEDING THE AMOUNT AUTHORIZED AND WILL REPORT COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE HA AND FOREIGN DISASTER REPOSE (FDR) MISSION TO THE DSCA COMPTROLLER AND OUSD(C) ON A DAILY BASIS. THE DSCA COMPTROLLER WILL NOTIFY USAFRICOM WHEN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS CHANGE. APPROVAL TO USE OHDACA FUNDING FOR HA AND FDR TERMINATES WHEN THE RELIEF PHASE OF A USG RESPONSE ENDS. CDRUSAFRICOM WILL REQUEST ADDITIONAL OHDACA FUNDING IF REQUIRED, WHICH WILL BE VALIDATED BY THE JOINT STAFF, DSCA, AND OSD WITH RESPECT TO FUNDING AVAILABILITY PRIOR TO APPROVAL OF THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING.

4.E.2. EXCEPT WHEN PROVIDING REIMBURSABLE SUPPORT TO USAFRICOM, SUPPORTING DOD COMPONENTS WILL NOT FUND INCREMENTAL HA AND FDR EXPENSES USING OTHER APPROPRIATION CHANNELS.

4.E.3. DOD COMPONENTS WILL CAPTURE AND REPORT INCREMENTAL COSTS IAW DOD FMR 7000.14R, VOLUME 12, CHAPTER 23.

4.E.4. MILITARY DEPARTMENTS AND DEFENSE AGENCIES WILL REQUEST OHDACA FUNDS TO COVER INCREMENTAL COSTS.

4.E.5. APPROPRIATE MANAGEMENT CONTROLS AND LEGAL REVIEWS MUST BE ADHERED TO IAW DOD FMR 7100.14R TO ENSURE PROPER USE OF FUNDS, MITIGATE FUNDING SHORTFALLS, AND SAFEGUARD AGAINST LOSS OF FUNDS.

4.E.6. TRANSPORTATION OF NON-DOD RELIEF SUPPLIES AND PERSONNEL MAY BE ON A NON-REIMBURSABLE BASIS IF THE DOD TRANSPORTATION IS: 1) FUNDED WITH OHDACA APPROPRIATIONS; 2) PROVIDED PURSUANT TO DRAWDOWN AUTHORITY; OR 3) ALREADY SCHEDULED AND THE TRANSPORTATION IS ON A SPACE-AVAILABLE, NON-INTERFERENCE BASIS AT NO INCREASED COST TO THE DEPARTMENT. FOR AUDIT PURPOSES, THE SUPPORTED COMMANDER IS REQUIRED TO KEEP RECORDS OF ALL TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO THIS AUTHORITY.

4.E.7. USTRANSCOM WILL WORK WITH THE DSCA TO COORDINATE AND MONITOR STRATEGIC LIFT ASSETS AND FUNDING AS REQUIRED BY USAFRICOM. TRANSPORTATION ACCOUNTING CODE HDGQ

(AIR) AND HDGR (SURFACE) SHOULD BE APPLIED.

5.A. (U) COMMUNICATIONS GUIDANCE. USAFRICOM WILL PUBLISH COMSEC AND SPECTRUM GUIDANCE TO ALCON. WHERE RESOURCES ARE NOT SATISFIED BY AUGMENTING OR SUPPORTING UNITS, VALIDATE AND FORWARD REQUIREMENTS FOR CJCS-CONTROLLED ASSETS, AND ANY ADDITIONAL SATELLITE CAPACITY NEEDED BEYOND CURRENT APPORTIONMENT, TO THE JOINT STAFF.

5.B. (U) COMMAND RELATIONSHIPS. USAFRICOM IS THE SUPPORTED COMBATANT COMMANDER. ALL OTHER COMBATANT COMMANDS ARE DESIGNATED AS SUPPORTING. ALL DOD AGENCIES AND THE MILITARY DEPARTMENTS ARE SUPPORTING AGENCIES AND DEPARTMENTS.
