CODE WORD, NICKNAMES, AND EXERCISE TERM (NICKA) SYSTEM

1. <u>Purpose</u>. This manual establishes standard administrative policy for the assignment and management of NICKA data. The NICKA system fulfills the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) requirement for maintenance of NICKA data by the Joint Staff. NICKA maintains records of all reported code words and their statuses. It also maintains all exercise terms and all currently authorized nicknames. The system validates code word and nickname usage with assigned agencies and ensures authorized nicknames and code words are not duplicated. NICKA provides a means to register and maintain the currency of code words, nicknames, and exercise terms. NICKA currently exists on a stand-alone Tep Secret system in the Joint Staff Support Center (JSSC).

2. Cancellation. CJCSM 3150.29D, 15 October 2010, is canceled.

3. Applicability

a. This manual applies to: the Joint Staff, Combatant Commands, Services, National Security Agency/Central Security Service (NSA/CSS), Defense Threat

Reduction Agency (DTRA), Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA), National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA), Defense Security Service (DSS), Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), and other DoD agencies. This manual is sent to the White House and OSD for information purposes only.

b. NICKA does not apply to reconnaissance nicknames. The governing publication for reconnaissance nicknames is CJCSI 3250.01D, "Policy Guidance for Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance, and Sensitive Reconnaissance Operations." The office of primary responsibility (OPR) for the reconnaissance nickname program is the U.S. Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM), Joint Functional Component Command for Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (JFCC-ISR).

4. Definitions. See Glossary.

#### 5. <u>Responsibilities</u>

a. On behalf of the Office of the Department of Defense Chief Information Officer, the Joint Staff is responsible for allocating code words or blocks of code words to the Services, Combatant Commanders, and DoD Components and agencies. DoD Components may request allocation of code words and may reallocate available code words within their organization in accordance with individual policies and procedures, subject to applicable rules set forth herein and in Enclosure 2, paragraph 18, of reference a.

b. Enclosure B identifies authorized NICKA user agencies.

c. Nickname and alphabetical block assignments are listed in Enclosure D. The Joint Staff is responsible for assigning nickname and exercise term letter groups from Enclosure E to DoD Components.

d. DoD Components (the Services, Combatant Commands, and DoD agencies) will establish, maintain, and operate an OPR for NICKA support. NICKA OPRs will:

(1) Submit requests to JSSC NICKA personnel at DSN (312) 225-0671 or jopes@nmcc.smil.mil to activate or cancel code words, nicknames, and exercise terms when appropriate to maintain accuracy of the NICKA database.

(2) Maintain local records of activated code words, nicknames, and exercise terms.

e. Supplemental or implementing procedures will be directed, as necessary, by the DoD Component headquarters.

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f. Additional NICKA support is available from the Joint Staff, J-36/CSOD, the Pentagon, Washington, D.C. 20318-3000.

6. <u>Procedures</u>. See Enclosure A.

7. <u>Additional Copies of Manuals</u>. The DoD Components and all other holders are authorized to reproduce, print, and stock additional copies to meet internal distribution requirements.

8. <u>Summary of Changes</u>. Revised database update procedures and responsibilities for OPRs to reflect the stand-down of Global Command and Control System Tep-Secret (CCCS T), which resulted in cutting off direct access to the database, updated organization name listings and acronyms, and restructured both alphabetical block assignments and code word block assignments resulting from the disestablishment of the U.S. Joint Forces Command.

9. <u>Releasability</u>. Restricted. This directive is not approved for electronic release on the NIPRNET/WWW; electronic release is restricted to Joint Staff activities only through controlled access via the SIPRNET Joint Electronic Library. Approval from the office of primary responsibility is required for further release of this directive in electronic format.

10. Effective Date. This manual is effective upon receipt.

#### NICKA PROCEDURES

#### 1. Code Words

a. A code word is a single word, assigned a classified meaning by appropriate authority to ensure proper security concerning intentions and to safeguard information pertaining to actual, real-world military plans, or operations. It is classified **CONFIDENTIAL** or higher, once activated. Code word block allocations are contained in Enclosure C. Code words are automatically generated and assigned by the system and may not be created or changed by users.

b. The Joint Staff maintains a record of all code words. The Joint Staff is responsible for providing and/or changing the status of a code word from the code word block allocation contained in the NICKA database.

#### 2. Nicknames

a. Nicknames will consist of two separate words, the first of which must begin with one of the combination letters of the alphabet assigned to the DoD Component in Enclosures D and E. Enclosure D assigns block numbers to each component. The block numbers are then used in accordance with Enclosure E to allocate the letter combinations to each component. For example, Enclosure D assigns block numbers 8, 26, 44, 58, and 95 to USSTRATCOM. Then in Enclosure E, each of these block numbers are associated with a range of two-letter combinations that represent USSTRATCOM's allocation of letter ranges. These letter ranges can then be used to form the first two letters of the first word of a nickname. For instance, USSTRATCOM's block number of 26 assigns the two-letter range of "GG" to "GL," which is currently used in naming its global series of exercises.

b. Nicknames are not required, but may be assigned to actual real-world events, projects, the movement of forces, or exercise activities. This can involve elements of information at any security classification level.

**NOTE**: The nickname, the description or meaning it represents, and the relationship of the nickname and its meaning must remain UNCLASSIFIED. A nickname is only an identifier and is not designed to achieve any particular security purpose. (See reference a).

c. Improperly selected nicknames can be counterproductive. Nicknames must be chosen with sufficient care to ensure they do not:

(1) Express a degree of hostile temperament inconsistent with traditional American ideals or current foreign policy.

(2) Convey connotations offensive to good taste or be derogatory to a particular group, sect, or creed.

(3) Convey connotations offensive to U.S. allies or democratic free world nations.

d. The following will NOT be used as nicknames:

(1) Any two-word combination voice call sign found in reference c.

(2) Combination of words using "project," "exercise," or "operation."

(3) Words that may be correctly used as either one word or two, such as "moonlight."

(4) Exotic words, trite expressions, well-known commercial trademarks, or popular cultural references.

(5) Two-word combination including a code word as part of the combination.

(6) Any nickname that has been placed in an "Inactive" status (NI) cannot be re-used. Nicknames meeting this criterion are kept in the NICKA database for historical purposes.

3. Exercise Terms

a. Exercise terms are selected using the same criteria as those for nicknames. See paragraph 2.a. above.

b. Exercise terms may only be assigned to tests, drills, or exercises for the purpose of emphasizing the event is, in fact, just a test, drill, or exercise, and not an actual real-world operation. The exercise term, the description or meaning it represents, and the relationship of the exercise term and its meaning, must remain UNCLASSIFIED.

c. The selection of exercise terms will follow the same guidance provided for nicknames as described in paragraphs 2.c. and 2.d.

d. Exercise terms that are "inactive" (EI) will follow the same guidance as nicknames. See paragraph 2.d.(6).

4. <u>Records and Reporting</u>. DoD Components and the Office of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy will maintain local records on all NICKA terms within their assigned blocks whether active, available, inactive, or canceled. Code words, nicknames, and exercise terms may be deleted from local records 2 years after cancellation, but will not be deleted from the NICKA system and will be preserved for historical purposes. The Joint Staff will maintain permanent records to ensure code words are not reused or re-activated once canceled.

a. DoD Components will review and verify the status of active code words, nicknames, and exercise terms in their portion of the NICKA database, as well as current NICKA OPRs annually. Commands may request a hard copy of their portion of the database from the Joint Staff J-36/CSOD. Any required information changes or updates to the database to include current NICKA OPR, contact phone numbers (DSN and commercial), and e-mail addresses (NIPRNET and SIPRNET) will be reported to Joint Staff J-36/CSOD and the JSSC.

b. Combatant Commands and components requesting NICKA assistance for a code word should contact the JSSC at DSN (312) 225-0671 or jopes@nmcc.smil.mil.

5. <u>Security</u>. NICKA OPRs will assign the appropriate security classification to each term in accordance with the following guidelines:

a. Code Words

(1) During the development of a plan or the planning of an operation, a code word and its meaning will have the same classification. When dissemination of a code word protected plan within DoD Components is required, the using component may downgrade the classification of the code word below the classification assigned to its meaning. This may facilitate implementation or execution by other components or echelons with the approval of the code word owner. To facilitate this planning, the code word

may be downgraded to **CONFIDENTIAL**, but must remain classified while the plan is current or the operation is being executed.

(2) The meaning of a code word may be used in a message or other document together with the code word only when it is essential to do so.

(3) In handling correspondence pertaining to active code words, care will be used to avoid bringing the code words and their meanings together.

(4) The meanings of code words are not normally maintained in the NICKA system. The names of the DoD Components that activate code words, nicknames, and exercise terms will be entered with the terms in the database.

(5) A code word that must be replaced by another code word because of compromise, suspected compromise, or for any other reason will be canceled, declassified, and kept UNCLASSIFIED / /<del>FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY</del>.

(6) When an operation is completed or a plan is discontinued and is not replaced by a similar operation or plan, but the meaning cannot be declassified, the code word assigned to it will be canceled and remain classified at least CONFIDENTIAL

(7) When the meaning of a code word no longer requires a security classification, the using component may declassify the meaning and the code word, keeping the latter UNCLASSIFIED//<del>FOR OFFICIAL USD ONLY</del>.

(8) In every case, when a code word is referred to in written text, the security classification of the code word will be placed in parentheses immediately following the code word itself. For example; "Label (C)".

(9) Code words must not be discussed over UNCLASSIFIED communications media, even when available (inactive) or canceled.

b. <u>Nicknames</u>. Nicknames will remain UNCLASSIFIED.

c. <u>Exercise Terms</u>. Exercise terms will remain UNCLASSIFIED.

d. <u>Cancellation</u>. Code words, nicknames, and exercise terms will be canceled when they no longer serve a useful purpose.

6. NICKA Transactions

a. To request new or update the status of existing Code Words, Nicknames or Exercise Terms, OPRs shall contact JSSC NICKA personnel at DSN (312) 225-0671 or jopes@nmcc.smil.mil.

b. NICKA transactions will normally use routine precedence. Nickname and exercise term reporting will be suspended after declaration of worldwide DEFCON 3 or higher.

c. If a DoD Component becomes aware of a conflict between a non-DoD official term and a DoD nickname, exercise term, or code word, it will endeavor to de-conflict them.

**NOTE**: If a NICKA user is unfamiliar with the NICKA business rules or registration process, please refer to the SIPRNET link in reference b.

(1) The home page will display the following information: What is NICKA, Definitions of a Nickname, Code Word, or Exercise; How to Request a Nickname or Exercise Term and Code Word; Nickname Convention Guidance; Authorized NICKA user agencies; Points of Contact List; and NICKA Officer In Charge (OIC).

(2) Select "Nickname Convention Guidance." Once selected, please read the example listed under the NICKA Nickname and Exercise Term Naming Convention Guidance.
