

The following decisions have been made with respect to the Enhanced Proliferation Control Initiative:

1. The PCC on Nonproliferation shall ensure that the following measures are implemented:
 - a. Legal sanctions, including civil and criminal penalties, shall be extended or (to the extent necessary) proposed through draft legislation, to apply to U.S. citizens who knowingly participate in activities that promote the spread of missile technology and chemical weapons.
 - b. Individually-validated licenses (IVL) from the Department of Commerce shall be required for proposed exports of potentially chemical weapon-related chemical production plants and related designs and technology.
 - c. An IVL shall be required for any export destined for a publicly-listed company, ministry, project, or other entity that is engaged in activities of proliferation concern. The PCC on Nonproliferation shall ensure the publication of such lists in the Federal Register.
 - d. Current regulations shall be supplemented by control lists of (i) dual-use equipment and technology related to chemical weapons, biological weapons, and missiles and (ii) countries to which such equipment and technology shall be controlled.

These measures shall be implemented simultaneously with efforts to obtain multilateral adoption of equivalent measures. U.S. implementation shall not be conditioned upon such multilateral adoption.

2. The PCC on Nonproliferation shall ensure the implementation of regulations requiring an export license for any export the exporter "knows or is informed by" the U.S. Government may be destined for a chemical or biological weapon (CBW) or missile project. The United States shall deny such licenses only for exports that would materially contribute to programs of missile or CBW concern.

3. The United States shall adopt worldwide export license controls on all 50 Australia Group precursor chemicals and shall urge all members of the Australia Group to adopt worldwide license controls on the same list of precursors. U.S. implementation of this decision, however, shall not be conditioned upon such multilateral adoption.

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4. The foregoing measures shall be implemented not later than February 16, 1991 (i.e. within 90 days of the issuance of Executive Order No. 12735). (b)

5. The PCC on Nonproliferation shall be responsible for the implementation of the foregoing decisions, and shall forward a set of milestones for the drafting, publication, and implementation of the controls referred to above to the Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs no later than 10 days from the date of this memorandum.
