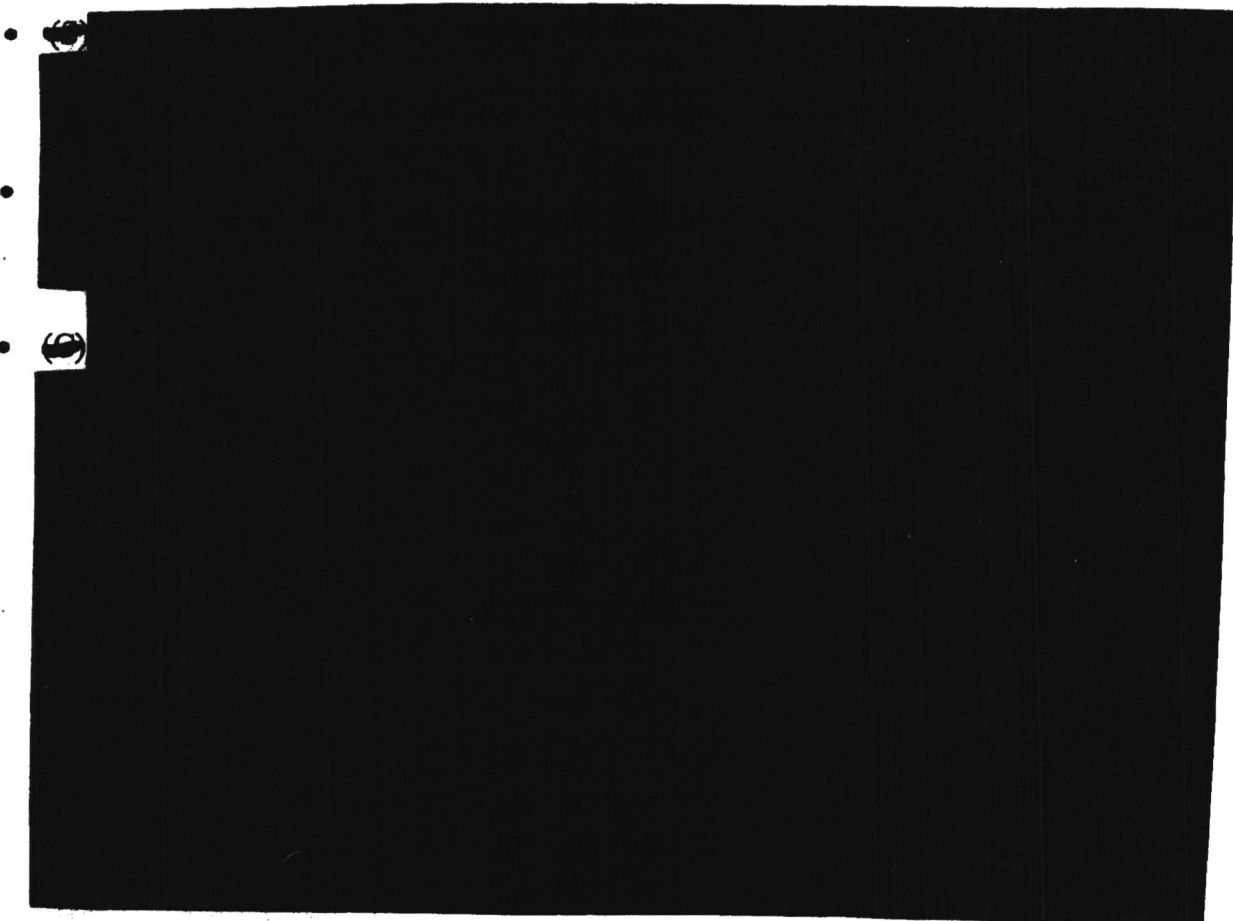

- ~~(S)~~ The Director, Joint Staff and Commander, CENTCOM also have endorsed Kuwait's full anthrax vaccine request.
- (U) Because we do not have an Acquisition and Cross-Servicing Agreement (ACSA) with Kuwait, we are not able to provide the vaccine to Kuwait as aid in kind.

SUBJECT: Allocating Vaccine for Coalition Partners (U)

(2 Decisions)

- (C) This memorandum seeks your approval of a recommended approach for allocating scarce anthrax and smallpox vaccine to key coalition partners for defense purposes.

OSD 1A(xd)

- (U) 100K doses of smallpox vaccine will vaccinate an equal number of personnel, as immunization generally requires only one dose of vaccine.
- (U) 75K doses of anthrax vaccine will provide a high level of protection to 25K personnel by enabling the administration of the initial three doses over a one-month period of this 6-dose, 18-month vaccination regime.

- (U) The United Kingdom (UK) and Israel also have their own vaccine supplies.

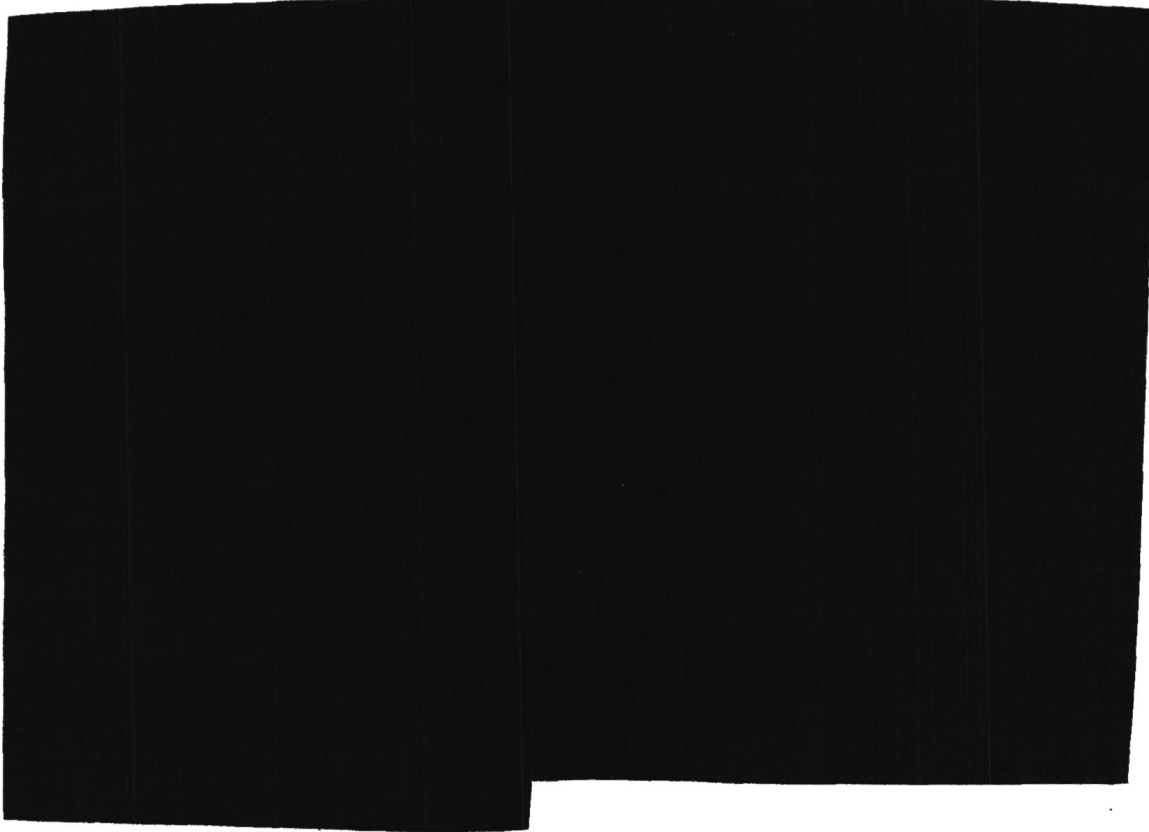
- (U) The following assumptions and principles constitute our recommended approach:

- (U) We may be able to offer countries the ability to dilute their smallpox vaccine by a factor of five. Clinical studies indicate that vaccine so diluted is still effective; however, countries would have to understand that the U.S. is not using diluted vaccine and that the diluted vaccine is not licensed.

- (U) Once we have determined the overall supply situation today, we will make further recommendations to you on 1) how we can work to meet fully the Kuwaiti request for anthrax vaccine; and 2) a refined overall vaccine allocation plan based on our supply assessment that can guide follow-on vaccine discussions with partners.
- (U) All vaccine would be offered to coalition partners on a reimbursable basis under Foreign Military Sales or, if applicable, Acquisition and Cross-Servicing Agreements.

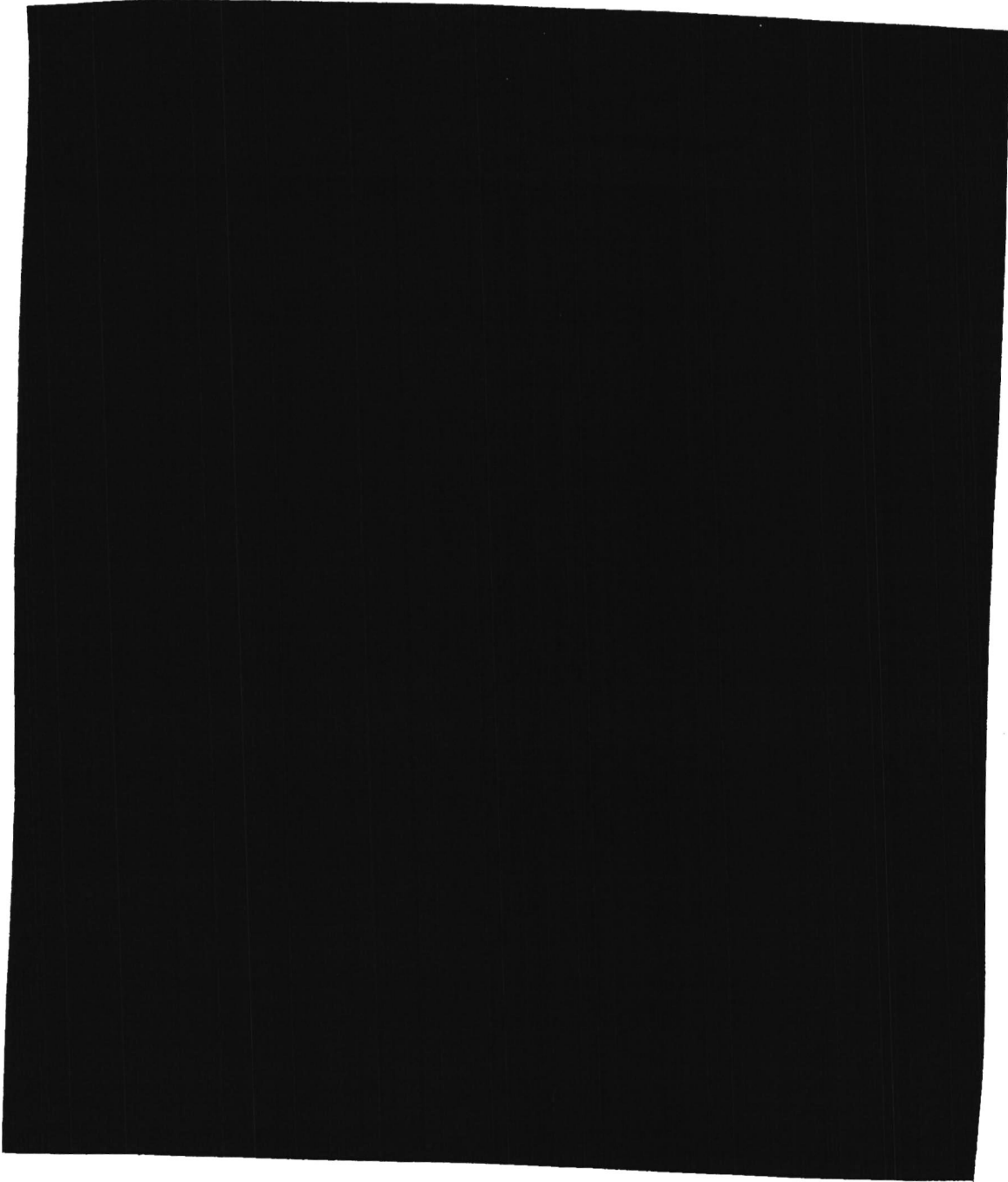

SUBJECT: ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX PROGRAM FOR KUWAITI MILITARY

1. (U) THIS IS AN ACTION REQUEST. SEE PARA 5.

2. (U) THE UNITED STATES AND KUWAIT ARE STANDING SHOULDER TO SHOULDER IN THE INTERNATIONAL EFFORT TO DISARM IRAQ. AS A RESULT OF KUWAIT'S GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION NEXT TO IRAQ, AND THE POLITICAL DECISION BY THE GOK TO SUPPORT VERY LARGE NUMBERS OF US TROOPS IN THE COUNTRY, KUWAIT IS THE FIRST AND MOST LIKELY TARGET OF ANY FUTURE IRAQI BIO-TERROR ATTACK IN THE REGION.

3. (U) ALL US TROOPS ARE FULLY VACCINATED AGAINST BOTH ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX. AS PART OF ITS OWN EFFORTS TO PROVIDE EQUAL PROTECTIONS TO ITS TROOPS WHO WILL BE STANDING IN THE SAME TERRAIN AS THEIR US COUNTERPARTS, THE GOK HAS REQUESTED ENOUGH SMALLPOX AND ANTHRAX VACCINE TO INOCULATE 15,000 OF ITS OWN PERSONNEL. THE US RESPONSE HAS BEEN DISAPPOINTING, AND OUR HOSTS HAVE NEGATIVELY NOTED IT. IN THE LOA WHICH WE HAVE BEEN INSTRUCTED TO PROVIDE TO THE KUWAITIS, THE US HAS OFFERED ONLY ENOUGH ANTHRAX VACCINE FOR 2750 PEOPLE, AND IT HAS OFFERED TO SELL BOTH THE ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX VACCINES, VICE PROVIDE IT AS AID IN KIND. THUS, WE ARE NOT ONLY NOT PROVIDING QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT TO PROTECT THESE COALITION PARTNERS, WE ARE ASKING THEM TO PAY FOR THESE RELATIVELY SMALL AND INSUFFICIENT AMOUNTS.

4. (U) THIS SLAP AT THE KUWAITIS HAS ARRIVED AT EXACTLY THE SAME MOMENT THAT THE EMBASSY IS ENGAGED IN INTENSIVE EFFORTS WITH THE GOK TO SECURE THEIR APPROVAL (NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE CURRENT DCA) TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL MILLIONS OF DOLLARS-WORTH OF JET FUEL, ACCESS TO PORTS, AND VAST AMOUNTS OF OTHER SUPPLIES TO US FORCES AS AID IN KIND FROM THE GOK TO THE COALITION FORCES. EMBASSY VIEWS THIS SITUATION AS

REQUESTS BY THE GOK, AND THAT IT BE PROVIDED AS AID IN KIND  
FROM THE UNITED STATES.
