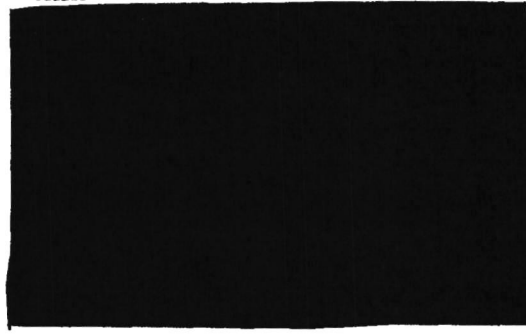

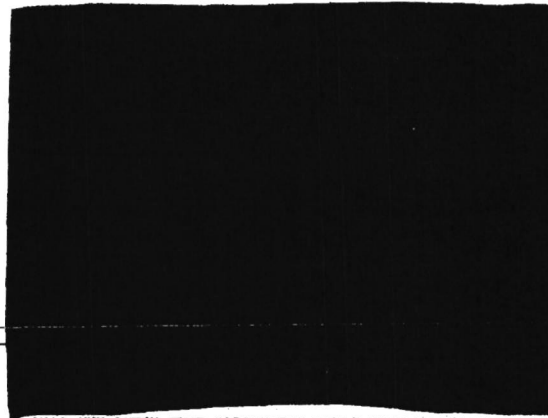

2. SUMMARY. THIS CABLE TRANSMITS INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM VARIOUS NATO EMBASSIES HERE ABOUT RECENT VISITS TO UKRAINE. UKRAINIAN LEADERS MADE CLEAR THAT UKRAINE VIEWS THE LOOSE COMMONWEALTH ARRANGEMENT AS ITS BOTTOM LINE. THEY SEE NO NEED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW CENTRAL STRUCTURES AND WANT THE MINSK PROCESS TO BE FLEXIBLE ENOUGH TO PERMIT REPUBLICS TO DEFINE INDIVIDUALLY THE PRECISE TERMS OF THEIR PARTICIPATION. THE UKRAINIANS HAVE MADE ALL THE RIGHT NOISES ABOUT COMPLIANCE WITH START PROVISIONS BUT SAID UKRAINE WOULD NOT RETURN STRATEGIC WEAPONS NOT COVERED BY START TO RUSSIAN TERRITORY. DUTCH OFFICIALS WERE TOLD UKRAINIAN DEFENSE OUTLAYS WOULD TOTAL THREE TO FOUR PERCENT OF GNP, WHICH THE UKRAINIANS SAY WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO SUPPORT AN ARMY OF ABOUT 100,000 MEN AND A NATIONAL GUARD OF 30,000. UKRAINIANS ARE FEARFUL OF THE EFFECTS OF MASSIVE UNEMPLOYMENT IN THE MILITARY AND DEFENSE SECTORS. END SUMMARY.

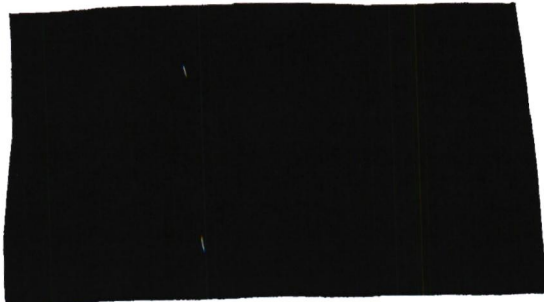

9. COMMENT: WE HAVE NOT YET SEEN A COPY OF THE FINAL UKRAINIAN TEXT OF THE COMMONWEALTH DOCUMENT BUT UNDERSTAND THAT THE UKRAINIAN PARLIAMENT ADOPTED THE AGREEMENTS WITH SEVERAL SIGNIFICANT CHANGES. THE UKRAINIAN VERSION WAS AMENDED TO ALLOW FOR CREATION OF INDEPENDENT UKRAINIAN ARMED FORCES AND TO PERMIT UKRAINE TO WITHDRAW FROM THE "COMMON STRATEGIC SPACE" ONCE ALL NUCLEAR WEAPONS BASED ON UKRAINIAN TERRITORY HAVE BEEN DESTROYED. SECOND, WHERE THE COMMONWEALTH DOCUMENTS SIGNED IN MINSK CALL FOR COORDINATION OF FOREIGN POLICIES, THE UKRAINIANS SUBSTITUTED "CONSULTATION" FOR COORDINATION. THE UKRAINIAN PARLIAMENT ALSO EXPRESSED CONCERN OVER MINSK LANGUAGE ON FREE FLOW OF TRAFFIC ACROSS NATIONAL BORDERS AND INCLUDED A CLAUSE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO LIMIT PERMANENT SETTLEMENT IN UKRAINE BY MIGRANTS FROM OTHER REPUBLICS. UKRAINIAN OFFICIALS HAVE NOTED THAT THEY VIEW THE MINSK ACCORDS AS A FLEXIBLE AGREEMENT, NOT A TREATY, TO WHICH EACH STATE IN THE COMMONWEALTH CAN FREELY JOIN WHILE DECIDING FOR ITSELF THE PRECISE TERMS OF ITS OWN PARTICIPATION. END COMMENT.
