1. (U) On Tuesday, 16 July 1985, you met with the JCS and were briefed on issues associated with Space-Based Radar and Infrared (SBR/IR) systems. This briefing was in response to your memorandum* requesting JCS validation of Wide Area Surveillance Requirements and an operational utility analysis of the proposed Defense Science Board (DSB) defined SBR/IR demonstration program.
 2. (U) The requirements for Wide Area Surveillance have been validated. The results of the operational utility analysis and the answers to the questions you posed during the briefing are enclosed.

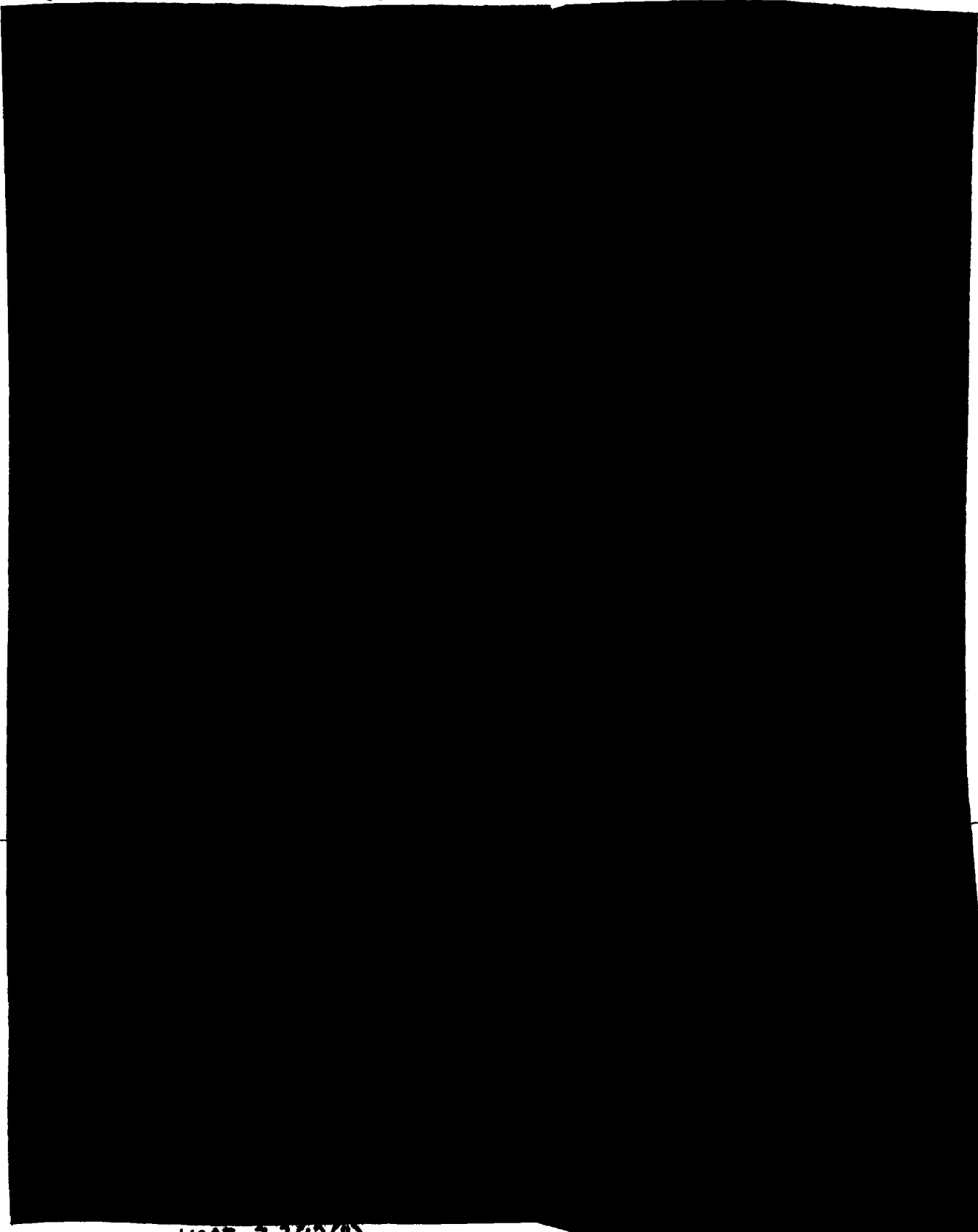

This record includes a broad range of technical disciplines including those related to advanced strategic missile systems and most recently, the small ICBM. Dr. Woodruff understands the total defense picture. He has been called often to serve on Service and Defense Scientific Advisory Boards. Thus, he is thoroughly familiar with the substance and goals of the position to which he would be assigned.

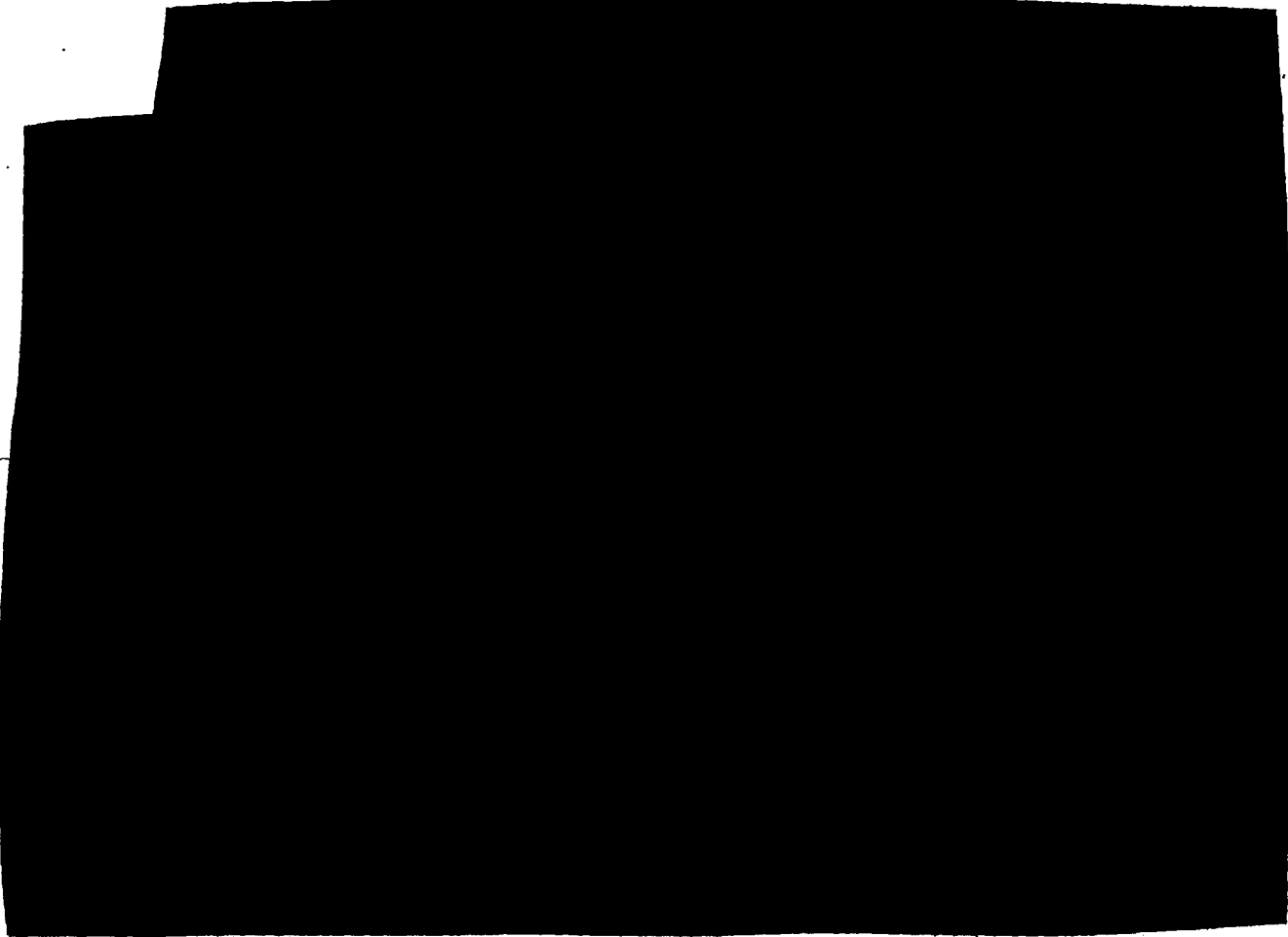

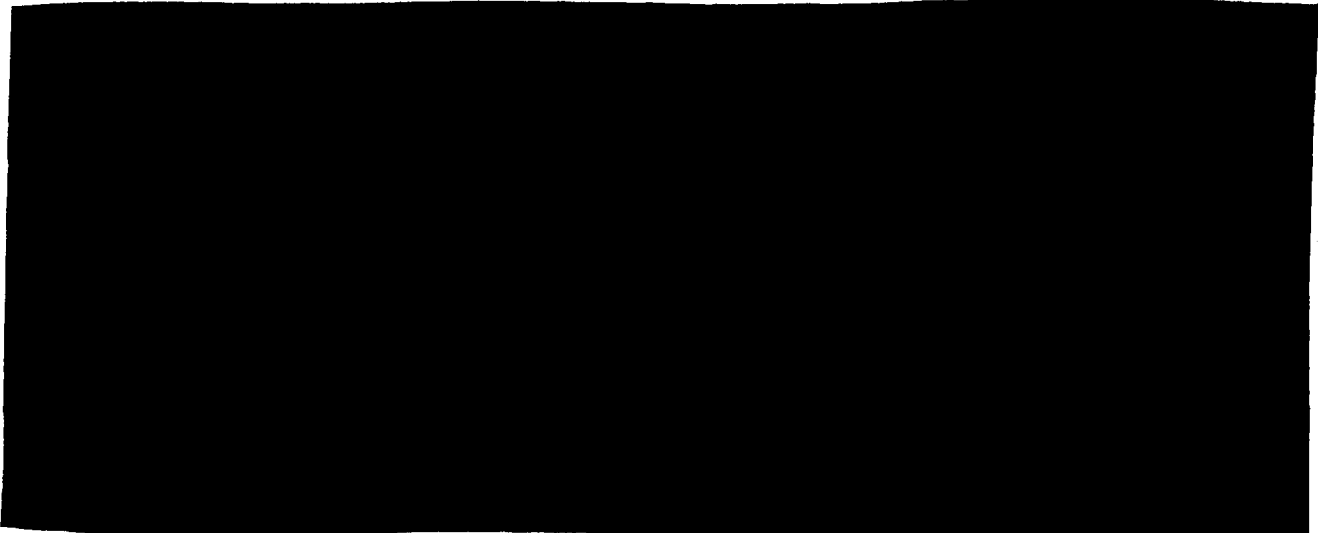
(3) To avoid conflicting interpretation of what constitutes classified and sensitive weapons systems data, you should initiate a review of the security guidelines and attain proper classification across the affected Air Force programs. Inadequate security guidelines or possible savings on system costs/schedules must not be allowed to deter compliance with the requirement for selective encryption of weapons systems information-- and particularly during the initial R&D phase of affected programs when the capability for selective encryption can best be implemented.

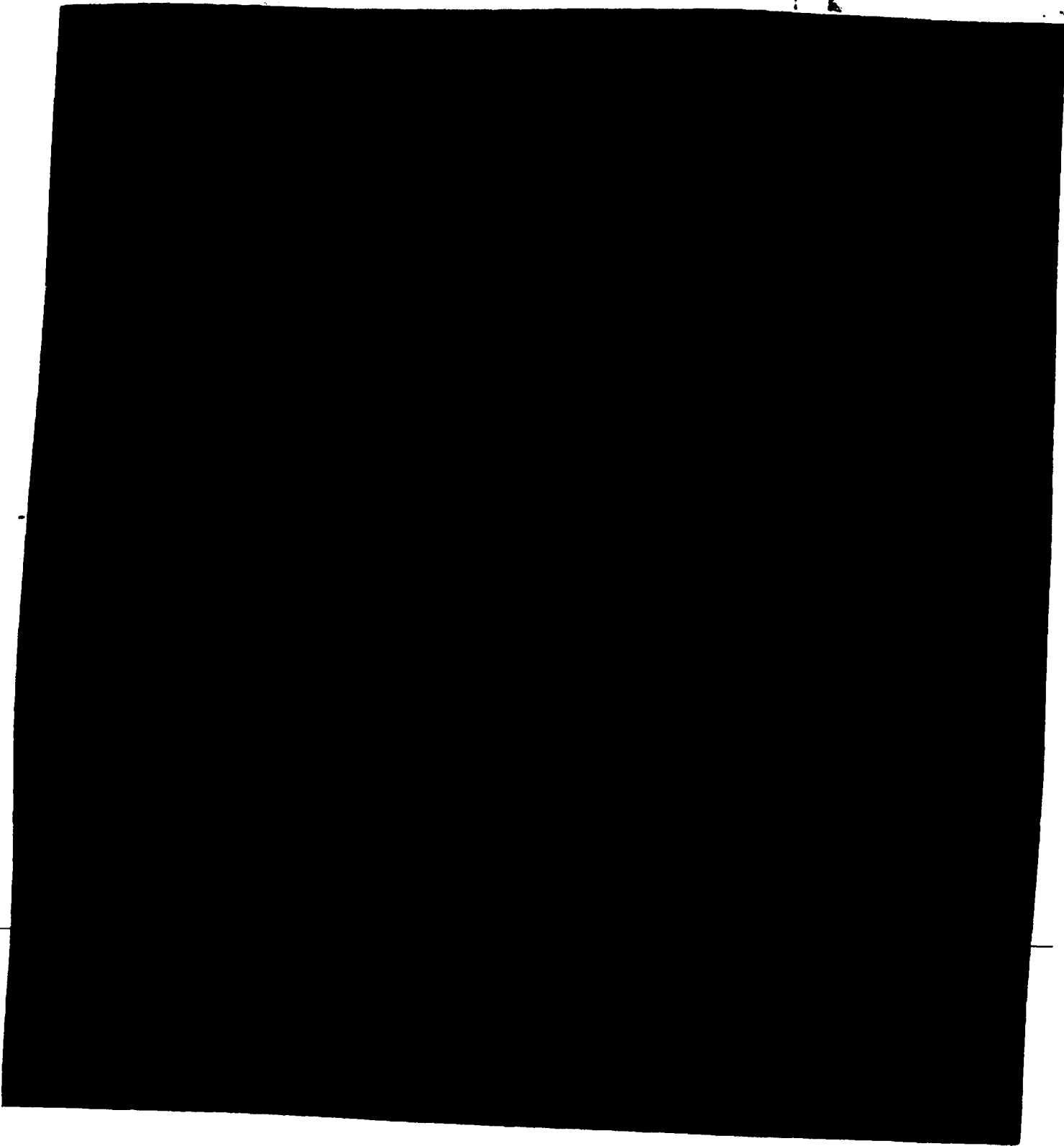
(4) Section One should also include program summaries for missile reentry vehicles.



d. (U) Sections Four and Five: These sections should be updated to include the requirements added to Section One by your 1 March 1985 memorandum. In that regard, I suggest wider distribution of your Implementation Plan within the Air Force--my staff informs me that the Air Force Cryptologic Support Center personnel responsible for carrying out the Implementation Plan were not formally aware of the Plan's existence prior to its submission.

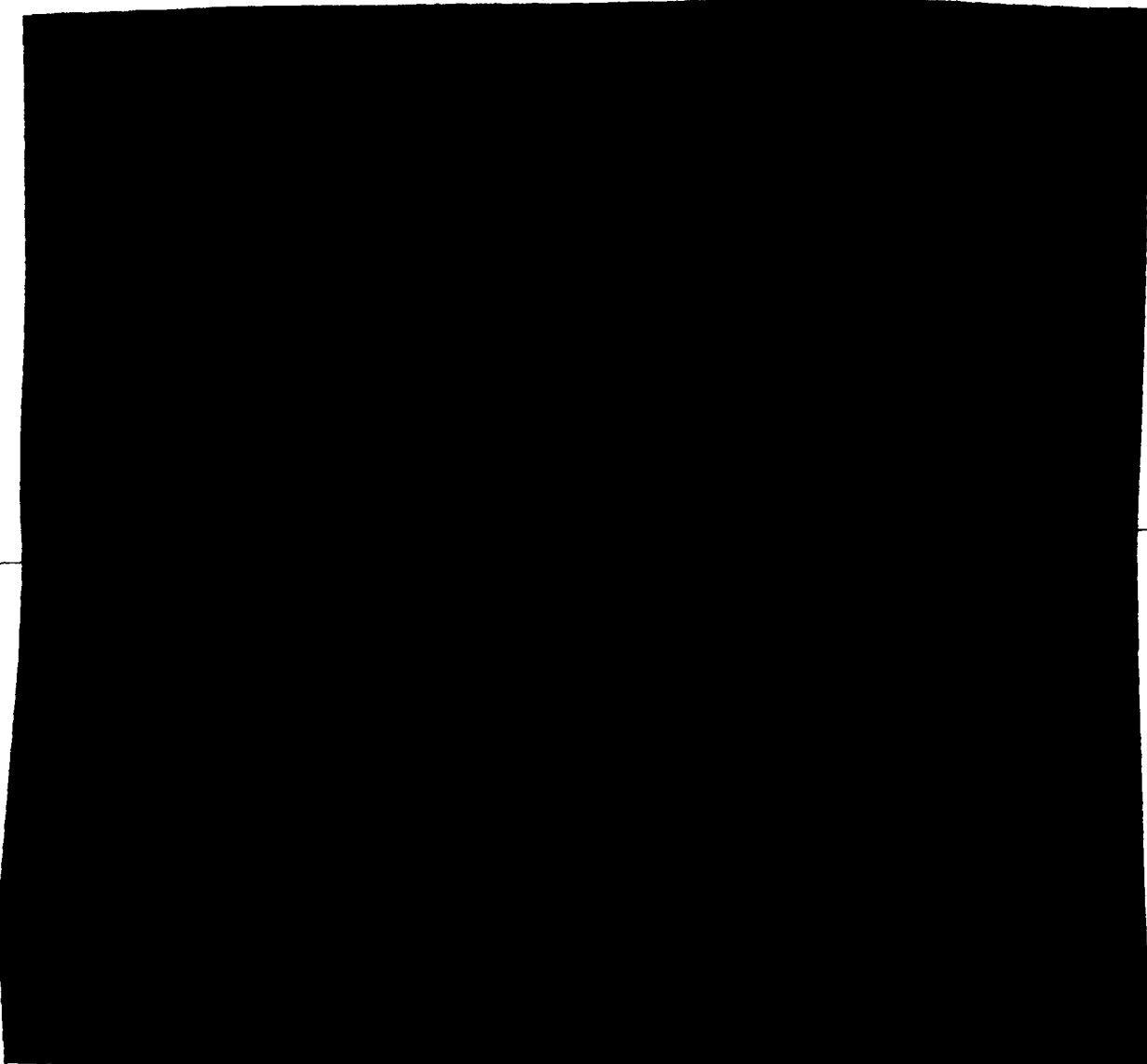


