During his recent trip east, Bob Krueger talked with Admiral Gallery about our missile activities. During the conversation Admiral Gallery asked if RAND would be willing to undertake missile studies for the Navy. Bob answered by saying he didn't know. In view of our present budget problems it might be worth your while to find out what Admiral Gallery had in mind. There may be some advantages in dealing at his level that we could not realize by taking a contract with the ONR. Of all the divisions in RAND mine is most apt to be tied to the military establishment, and any broadening of our financial base will probably have to come from the Army or Navy. With each cutback in budget we come closer to "saving a leg off" the Missiles Division, and I should at least like to know all of the possible sources of additional funds.

Will you, with due discretion, find out if Admiral Gallery was serious with his question, and if so, what sort of studies he may have had in mind?
