MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Policy Statements for AIM-9M & HARM (U)

(S) The National Disclosure Policy Committee (NDPC) agreed on 25 April 1985 to issue the subject Policy Statements. With respect to the HARM Policy Statement, there were conflicting positions as to the advisability of determining the eligibility of New Zealand and Israel to receive the missile at this time. The Policy Statement does not preclude either country from normal case-by-case consideration; however, for New Zealand a change in current national policy would be required before a positive disclosure eligibility decision should be made. In the case of Israel the NDPC agreed to address their eligibility as part of the Policy Statement, once the Middle East Study Group work is completed and guidance issued in NSSD 4-85.
