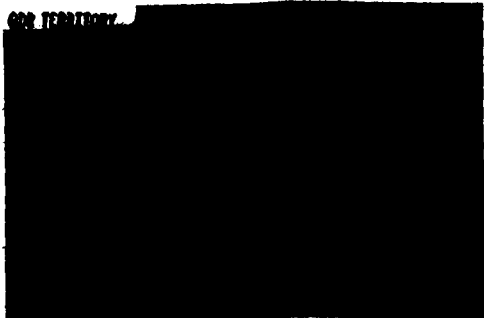

DELEGATION COMMENT AND ANALYSIS

6. IT APPEARS [REDACTED] WERE THAT THE FRG HAS ALREADY GIVEN CONSIDERABLE THOUGHT  
TO THE ISSUE OF FUTURE INSPECTIONS IN GERMANY. THE FRG,  
OF COURSE, HAS CONTINUED NEGOTIATIONS, AS A U.S. BASTION  
COUNTRY, TO BE PREPARED ON RELATIVELY SHORT NOTICE TO  
HOST SOVIET INSPECTIONS. IN ADDITION, THE FRG HAS NOW  
ASSUMED THE ADDITIONAL OBLIGATION TO ASSIST IN THE  
RECEPTION OF U.S. INSPECTORS ON FORMER GDR TERRITORY.  
CLEARLY, THE GERMANS -- AND THE U.S. AS WELL -- MUST  
DEAL WITH PRACTICAL PROBLEMS THAT WILL ARISE BECAUSE OF  
THE NEW SITUATION IMPOSED BY A UNIFIED GERMANY.  
HOWEVER, BEL BELIEVES THE U.S. AND FRG SHOULD CONSULT ON  
U.S. RIGHTS TO INSPECT UNDER THE INF TREATY, INCLUDING  
THE INSPECTION PROTOCOL, BEFORE FURTHER DISCUSSIONS WITH  
THE SOVIETS.

-- FIRST, THERE ARE PRACTICAL QUESTIONS OF CONDUCTING  
INSPECTIONS IN A UNIFIED GERMANY WHICH WERE NOT FORESEEN  
IN TREATY PROVISIONS AND THEREFORE REQUIRE U.S.-SOVIET  
DISCUSSION.



-- THIRD, THERE ARE MORE LARGELY ADMINISTRATIVE  
QUESTIONS RELATING TO HOW THE GERMANS AND SOVIETS WILL  
HANDLE "HOST" RESPONSIBILITY FOR U.S. INSPECTIONS IN  
FORMER GDR TERRITORY. THESE QUESTIONS, WHILE OF  
INTEREST TO US, ARE PRIMARILY MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION  
BETWEEN THE SOVIETS AND THE GERMANS.

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-- POINTS OF ENTRY INTO GERMANY AND THE RELATED QUESTIONS OF PERMITTING "STOPOVERS" AT SPERRENBURG AIR BASE AND WEIN HAIN AIR BASE, HOW THESE STOPOVERS (IF PERMITTED) ARE CHARACTERIZED IN NOTIFICATION OF FLIGHT PLANS, AND WHETHER THE NOTIFICATION PERIOD WOULD INCLUDE TIME SPENT DURING A STOPOVER;

-- AIRCRAFT ROUTING;

-- THE TREATY REQUIREMENT THAT INSPECTORS LEAVE THE TERRITORY OF THE INSPECTED PARTY OR BASING COUNTRY WITHIN 24 HOURS OF ARRIVING AT THE POE FOLLOWING INSPECTION ACTIVITIES; AND

8. AS TO ISSUES IN THE SECOND CATEGORY...

DELEGATION NOTES THAT A U.S. DECISION NOT TO EXERCISE ITS INF INSPECTION RIGHTS AT SOME BASES MIGHT GIVE RISE TO SIMILAR DEMANDS BY U.S. ALLIES TO END SOVIET INSPECTIONS OF FORMER U.S. INF BASES. WE ARE SENSITIVE TO THE FACT THAT MANY OTHER POLITICAL AND POLICY FACTORS NEED TO ENTER INTO ANY DECISION ABOUT THE EXERCISE OF OUR TREATY RIGHTS. IN DEL. VIEW, FOR THE PURPOSES OF A RESPONSE TO THE SOVIETS HERE, WE SHOULD MERELY INDICATE THAT, UNDER THE INF TREATY, WHETHER TO MAKE THOSE INSPECTIONS TO WHICH WE ARE ENTITLED IS A UNILATERAL U.S. DECISION, AND WE DO NOT INTEND TO RENOUNCE OUR TREATY RIGHTS.

9. IN REGARD TO THE THIRD CATEGORY, BOTH THE SOVIETS AND THE GERMANS HAVE RAISED OTHER MATTERS FOR WHICH DEL BELIEVES THE PRIMARY DISCUSSIONS SHOULD BE BETWEEN GERMANY AND THE SOVIET UNION. THESE MATTERS INVOLVE LARGELY ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE GERMANS TO ASSIST THE SOVIETS IN CARRYING OUT SOVIET OBLIGATIONS AS THE INSPECTED PARTY. THESE INCLUDE:

-- THE CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE FRG AND THE SOVIET UNION; AND

-- THE GERMAN ROLE IN HELPING TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTA-

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10. DEL BELIEVES IT WOULD BE USEFUL TO INFORM THE SOVIET SVC DELEGATION THAT USG WILL RESPOND ON THOSE ISSUES (PARA 7 ABOVE) CONCERNING U.S. AND SOVIET INSPECTIONS IN GERMANY THAT DIRECTLY INVOLVE PRACTICAL MATTERS RELATED TO INSPECTION PROTOCOL PROVISIONS. IF

POSSIBLE, DEL WOULD LIKE TO GIVE THE SOVIETS AN INDICATION OF LIKELY TIMING AND CHANNEL FOR RESPONSES ON THESE ISSUES. DEL ALSO BELIEVES -- PER PARA 8 ABOVE --

IF WASHINGTON AGREES, DELEGATION WOULD ALSO LIKE TO INDICATE THAT THE U.S. PREFERENCES NOT TO INVOLVE ITSELF IN FURTHER US.-SOVIET DISCUSSION OF THE LARGELY ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES (PARAGRAPH 9 ABOVE) THAT ARISE BETWEEN THE SOVIETS AND GERMANS AS INSPECTED PARTY AND SOVIET INF BASING COUNTRY.
