The Army has re-evaluated its position and decided to raise the average flying hours for tactical units to 17.0 hours per crew per month in FT 87, 17.9 hours in FT 88, 19.0 hours in FY 89, and 20+ hours in FY 90-91. The offset is realized from cost reductions achieved during the revised costing of the ARMG's Active Guard/Reserve and military technician programs. USAR paid end strength, and mavings in the PON's current flying hour program realized from the July 1985 revised fuel and repair parts cost factors.

(U) Reductions in Army POW fiscal guidance in April 1985 forced the Army to lower manning of the Reserve Component (RC) below the Defense Guidance minimum of 90% trained strength in units measured against the Programmed Manpower Structure. The overall low readiness condition of CSS units is a primary concern of the CINCs in the Program Review. This agreement uses funds identified by the Army during recosting of BC manpower after POH submission to fix the manning shortfall. An additional 17,000 paid drill strength (PDS) will be provided to the US Army Reserve and 23,000 additional PDS to the Army Mational Guard to be used primarily for improving the manning of early deploying CSS units. 
