

SUBJECT: (U) Afghanistan: Positive Impact of Provincial Reconstruction Teams

(2) Our evaluation of Provincial Reconstruction Team (PRT) success in Afghanistan is based upon anecdotal evidence, US Embassy reporting, and limited polling, all of which indicate public support for PRTs is very strong. Based upon reporting, the 19 PRTs have improved security by providing patrols, advancing the Demobilization, Disarmament, and Reintegration (DDR) program, and improving local government and police capabilities. PRTs enabled local and international aid groups to improve health, education, road, water, agricultural, and electric power.

ຕ (U) Success Stories

(U) The PRT in Jalalabad (Nangarhar Province) enabled local security while taking a hands-on approach to reconstruction. Projects were identified through interaction with local leaders, providing Afghans with a stake in development.

- (U) According to the US Embassy, the team completed 51 projects totaling \$296,293 since January and is implementing another 66 projects worth \$3,421,100. Projects include construction of district buildings, and improvements in health care, education, water supply, roads, bridges, and power generation.
- (U) The PRT improved emergency response to security incidents, boosted police credibility, and resolved several local conflicts. It also promoted the election process, and is participating in renovation of parks and providing services for women.
- (U) The Parwan PRT, which serves Kabul, Kapisa, Panjshir, and Parwan provinces, is helping create a sustainable economic and agricultural infrastructure. We assess the projects will facilitate DDR and provide a model for agricultural revitalization.
- (U) The PRT is assisting industrial projects expected to employ 3,800 people. Other focuses include school reconstruction, transportation, and training local police.



- (U) The PRT is developing an agricultural testing center for Parwan, Kapisa, and Panjshir. The center will serve 1.2 million people and support students in agricultural or veterinary studies.
- (U) According to the PRT commander, although many groups in the area do not support the current government, they are 95 percent supportive of the PRT.
- (U) The Kandahar PRT facilitated an Afghan-led regional development planning effort, a unified Afghan-Coalition-UN DDR plan for the region, and joint plans for Afghan-Coalition-UN election security, according to CFC-A.




(U) Challenges, Yet Producing Results

• (U) According to CFC-A, the US-led Tarin Khowt PRT (Oruzgan Province) has been slow to establish itself in one of the country's most backward areas. Few international organizations feel safe in this area, the site of major combat operations
