/3/ WE WILL CONTINUE TO PUT ALL OUR NUCLEAR-RELATED FACILITIES AND MATERIALS UNIVER FULL-SCOPE INTERNATIONAL INSPECTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVIDING OF THE NUCLEAR NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY (NPT) AND THE SAFEGRARDS AGREEMENT WITH IAEA AND WILL FORSO TO POSSESS NUCLEAR REPROCESSING AND EMPICHMENT FACILITIES UNTIL THE CURRENT STATE OF MILITARY COMPRONTATION IS RESOLVED AND PEACE IS ESTABLISHED ON THE ROBEAN PENISSULA.
