SUBJECT: Greek-Turkish Foreign Assistance (U)

The President has approved an increase of up to \$220 million in FY83 credits for Greece in the context of a successful completion of the base negotiations. He has also authorized approaching the Congress to work out an agreement to pick up to the additional \$220 million in FY83 (1) in the context of a successful agreement and (2) provided our Turkish foreign assistance request is passed unadmitted. Finally, the President has directed that the Budget Review Board be convened to consider the need for a budget amendment or supplement in light of the new Greek and other unclassified requirements. Such a meeting should occur as promptly as possible after the results of our approach to Congress are known.
