SUBJECT: Reclama to White House on Jordan FY84 Funding Level

Next under is a proposed memorandum to Judge Clark, explaining DoD's belief that the FY84 FMS credit level for Jordan must be \$300 million, not the \$115 million level recommended by State. Foremost in our thinking is the need to plan for Jordan's upcoming aircraft purchases. Without some funding assistance on these major equipment buys, the Jordanians may not be able to handle the purchases, and we will not derive full credit for the assistance.
