14. FUTURE OF NAC AD HOC GROUP ON INTEROPERABILITY

LABERGE SAID AD HOC COMMITTEE IS SOLVING A SERIES OF PROBLEMS THAT ARE SUFFICIENTLY DIFFICULT THAT THEY CANNOT BE SOLVED BY ANYONE ELSE. BUT IT CANNOT TAKE REPORTS AND CHANGE THEM BECAUSE IT DUES NOT HAVE EXPERTISE TO OVERRULE. ALLIANCE NEEDS A STILL BETTER MECHANISM. US REP (M/G BOHMAN) POINTED OUT THAT MEMBERS OF AD HOC GROUP ALL ACT ON GUIDANCE FROM CAPITALS. TECHNICAL AS WELL AS POLITICAL EXPERTS MUST CAREFULLY REVIEW REPORTS OF HORKING GROUPS AND PROVIDE SUITABLE GUIDANCE TO AD HOC GROUP. ARMAMENT DIRECTORS SHOULD PLAY PRIMARY ROLE. LABERGE ENDORSED CONTINUATION OF AD HOC GROUPS BUT ALSO ASKED FOR MORE USE OF REGULAR CHAD GROUPS.

EBERHARDT AGREED THAT CHAD HAS HAD FEW RESULTS ON INTEROPERABILITY AND THEREFORE AD HOC GROUP SHOULD CONTINUE AS LONG AS IT IS MAKING PROGRESS. DELPECH SAID EFFECTIVENESS OF NATO FORCES MUST IMPROVE RAPIDLY AND INCHEASED INTEROPERABILITY IS AN IMPORTANT WAY TO CONTRIBUTE TO THAT END. AD MOC GROUP SHOULD CONTINUE
