- And finally, we will brief the most recent War Games and display the results of a Soviet massive attack-- and a U.S. response [REDACTED]

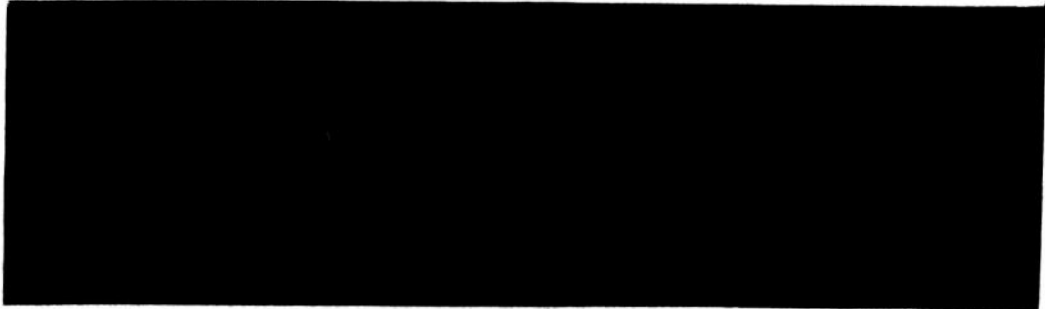

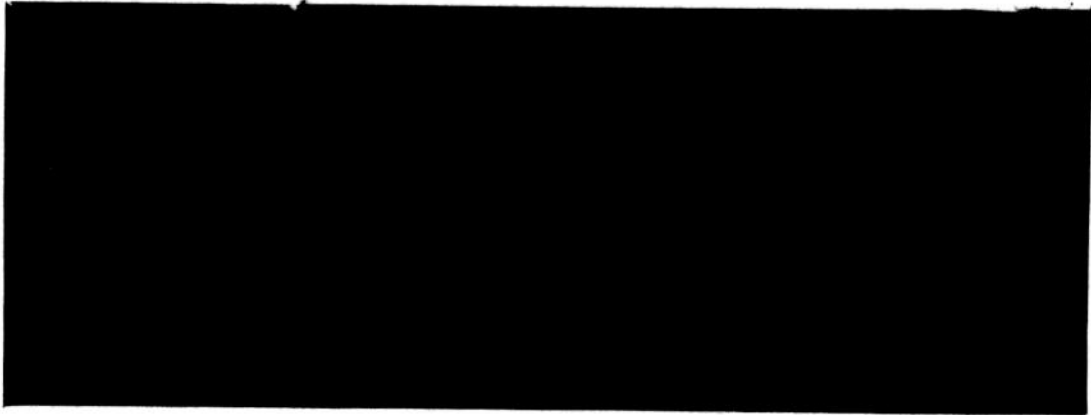

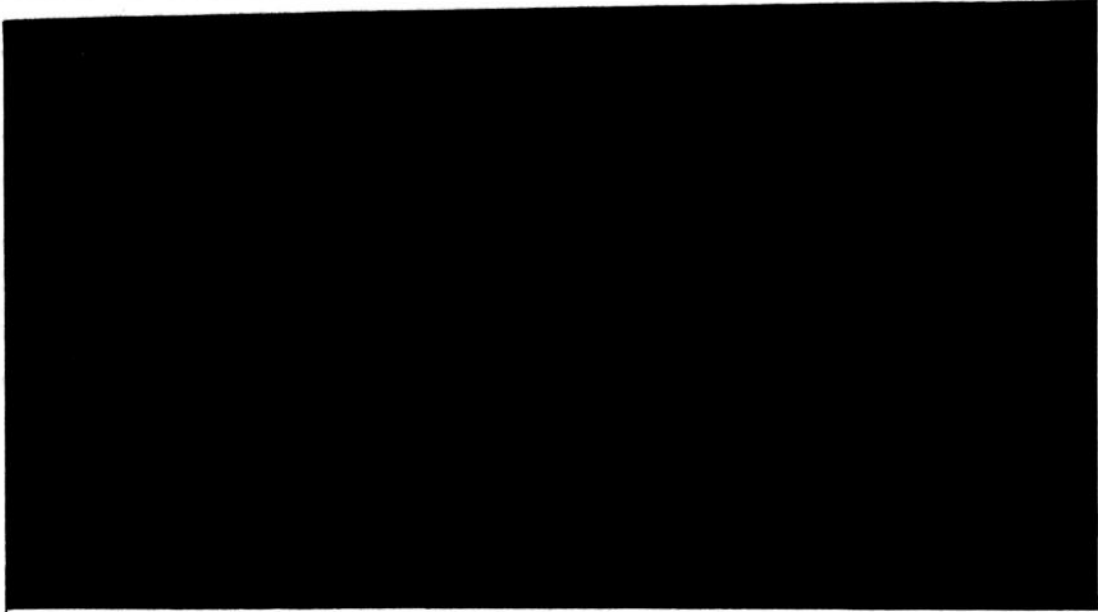

(TRANSITION TO WAR GAMES)
