SUBJECT: Movement of Turkish Naval Forces (S)

REFERENCE: [Redacted] Reconnaissance Flight

(S) The Turkish naval force of 24 ships reported earlier headed toward Cyprus has split into two groups. One group of 19 ships was located at 36-15N, 34-13E (approximately 34 nautical miles northwest of the nearest point of land on Cyprus) headed toward Kyrenia. A second group of five ships is located at 36-05N, 34-45E (approximately 18 nautical miles northeast of the nearest point of land on Cyprus) headed toward Famagusta. One vessel remains unlocated. All vessels are sailing slowly at 2-3 knots and are not expected to reach their estimated destinations before first light tomorrow. It is believed that a landing will not be attempted before first light.
