I am writing to advise you that I have authorized Congressman Cass Ballenger (R-NC), a Member of the House Committee on International Relations, to lead a congressional delegation on official business to Nicaragua, Honduras and Colombia, from February 14-24, 2003. For purposes of protocol, Members' spouses will be authorized to accompany the delegation at no additional expense to the U.S. Government. The purpose of this trip is to discuss with leaders of these nations issues related to drug trafficking, trade, immigration and other issues of regional significance.
