Dear Colonel Guenther:

During a recent conversation with Owen Greene of your staff, it was agreed that comments pertaining to the cost principles, which were not received by the comment closing date and therefore not considered by the subcommittee in the formulation of final rule, are to be forwarded for your appropriate action.

The procedures of the FAR Secretariat are to retain comments on proposed and interim rules for two weeks following the comment closing date. This is to allow a sufficient period of time to include comments delayed by mail, and to preclude forwarding several transmittals with additional comments. However, the implementation date of the DOD Authorization Act was April 7, 1986, and the subcommittee had a short timeframe in which to consider public comments and to formulate final rules on several cases. The comments received by the requested closing date were sent immediately.
