Dear Dr. Carter:

This is a follow up on a letter that I wrote you a bit over a week ago. I was hoping for some results by now. This matter of the attack on the hospital at Kunduz is not very mysterious. As I told you, My son was employed by Ticom Geomatics. There, he developed software applicable for sea-air rescue. The idea was to quickly find downed planes. He was upset when he learned that the software was sold to the CIA. He left the company and never returned. I explained the error in the previous letter. It lacks sufficient accuracy, and will cause the death of many civilians. I warned the CIA about this weeks before the strike at Kunduz. They did nothing. I then warned Dick Durbin and asked him to alert the president. Nothing happened there either.

I have the impression that the CIA deployed that software without ever testing it. There need to be people fired there, perhaps even the director. As for Ticom Geomatics, my son says "Those people are criminals!"

Another thing: What is the matter with the NSA? They can probably tell you the amount of my last phone bill. Then why do they not ask questions when a case in federal court is posted, in which Bernard E. Henneberger is suing Ticom Geomatics for fraud? After all, Ticom Geomatics is a vendor of software to the CIA. They seem to be overwhelmed by all the information that they have amassed.

I suggest that you interview the people on the ground at Kunduz who were in contact with the pilot. Ask them who produced the software that was used. If it was Ticom Geomatics, there is your smoking gun. But be careful. The CIA is a spy organization. Be sure that you are getting the truth. Would a spy organization lie? Of course, especially when they are protecting their own backsides!

Finally, I am sending this letter by snail mail. Ticom has since been absorbed by a really bad spy agency, which in turn was absorbed by a still bigger one. They proudly assert that they can hack anyone's email. This is no longer the America that I grew up in!

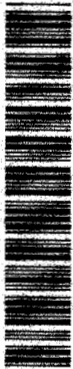
