Mr. Paul A. Weinstein, Assistant Professor of Economics, Columbia University, has obtained a Ford Foundation grant to study the effect of the formal educational and vocational training received in the Army and Air Force on the civilian employment of a selected group of ex-servicemen.

The Department of Defense has agreed to furnish Mr. Weinstein rosters, with serial numbers, of men certified competent for assignment to the specialties for specific periods designated by him. Additionally, Defense will provide assistance regarding course evaluation, selection procedures, and access to personnel records.

The Ford Foundation has agreed to reimburse the Department of Defense for costs incurred in conjunction with Mr. Weinstein's study, and statements of such costs should be forwarded to him.

Mr. Weinstein has been granted a Confidential Security Clearance by the New York office of Naval Research.

Cooperation by members of the Department of Defense in this research project with Mr. Weinstein is requested.
