- Counter threats from (b)(1) in alignment with the NDS and the USD(I) (b)(1) (b)(1) by strengthening intelligence partnerships with (b)(1)
- Gain (b)(1) unique perspectives on the threat from (b)(1) and its (b)(1)
- Obtain the partners' recommendations for how to better cooperate -- using tools such as (b)(1) (b)(1) direct and indirect warfare tactics.
- Understand what is currently working and not working in our cooperation to deter (b)(1) Make needed adjustments.
- Promote the rapid flow of intelligence to support an improved (b)(1) and ensure (b)(1) are prepared to combat the broad scope of (b)(1)
