## Islamic Radical Groups on Margarita Island, Venezuela

09 December 2003



(S#NF) Margarita Island (MI), Venezuela (VEN) is home to a well-established Muslim community. Most are reportedly



legitimate Shi'a businessmen; however, a significant Hizballah presence exists. Several Sunni Islamic Radical Groups (IRGs) are there as well but more reporting is needed to ascertain the extent of their presence. Hizballah activities on MI appear to be part of a larger logistics network that links MI, Curaçao, Maicao, Colombia, Panama's Colon Free Trade Zone (CFTZ), the Triborder Area (TBA), and Lebanon. This network generates revenue on behalf of known Middle-Eastern terrorist groups, such as Hizballah in Lebanon. To date, none of the individuals discussed herein have been credibly linked to terrorist planning.
